### FROM THE DOG HOUSE

**BATTLE FOR FIRST:** While the calendar may still read June, the intensity at Joseph P. Riley, Jr. Park this week feels far more like September. The Charleston RiverDogs and Hickory Crawdads enter their six-game series tied atop the Carolina League South Division standings with just nine games remaining in the first half. The first-half race concludes after the completion of all games on June 18, with the division leader earning an automatic berth in the Carolina League postseason. Due to two canceled games earlier this season, Hickory will finish the first half having played 64 games compared to Charleston's 66, meaning the champion will be determined by winning percentage. The two clubs last met three weeks ago in Winston-Salem, where Hickory took five of six meetings and currently leads the season series 5-1. If the teams finish tied atop the standings, head-to-head record would serve as the first tiebreaker.

**EIGHT STRAIGHT:** Charleston has surged into contention with some of its strongest play of the season. Entering May 30, the RiverDogs trailed first place by five games. Since then, Charleston has gone 8-0 while Hickory has gone 3-5, erasing the deficit entirely. The RiverDogs' recent success has been fueled by dominant performances on both sides of the ball. During the eight-game winning streak, Charleston's pitching staff has posted a 2.96 ERA, the third-best mark in Single-A, while recording 96 strikeouts, the most in the level and tied for second-most in Minor League Baseball over that span. Offensively, the RiverDogs are averaging 6.4 runs per game and reaching base at a .373 clip, a top-10 mark in Single-A during the streak. The winning streak has also brought Charleston within reach of franchise history. Two more victories to open the week would match the longest winning streak by a RiverDogs team since at least 2005. The club's longest run since then remains a 10-game streak from April 14-25, 2012.

**A STORMS A BREWIN':** Right hander **Ethan Storm** takes the ball for Charleston in the series opener versus Hickory. Across 10 outings and eight starts, he has posted a 6.49 ERA and has fanned 42 hitters. Last week versus Myrtle Beach, Storm delivered six innings to match a career high, and fanned a career-best seven hitters. Tonight marks his second start of the year against the Crawdads (5/27 - 4 IP, 2 ER, 5 K). The 2025 13th-round pick mixes in a four seamer, changeup, cutter and sweeper

**SWEEPING HIGHWAY-17:** Charleston enters the series coming off a dramatic homestand against Myrtle Beach, highlighted by a series sweep and multiple comeback wins. Three of the club's six victories came in come-from-behind fashion, including Tuesday night's 10th-inning rally capped by **Brady Marget's** RBI double and the winning run scoring on a wild pitch. The sweep marked the RiverDogs' first in six games since June of last year versus Kannapolis. It was their first six-game sweep of the Pelicans since 2024 when dominated a home-and-home series July 1-6.

**ABOUT FRIDAY NIGHT:** On Friday night, the RiverDogs provided their most thrilling win of the season in front of 4,721 fans at The Joe. The evening was highlighted by a **J.D. Gonzalez** two-strike, two-run single to center that tied the game. **Derek Datil** followed with a walk-off single to earn Charleston its sixth walk-off win of the year amongst their 16 total home wins (37%). The RiverDogs erased two massive deficits by delivering a five-run sixth and a four-run ninth. All four of their runs scored in the ninth came down to final out, and final strike twice.
