## LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox lost in walk-off fashion for the first time this season in a 2-1 defeat to Somerset yesterday afternoon. Spencer Jones lined an RBI single off Keagan Gillies to plate home the winning run for the Patriots to even up the series. Bowie scored the game's first run on a Dylan Beavers RBI single in the first inning. However, the offense struggled mightily throughout the game, batting just 2-for-18 with runners in scoring position, leaving 12 men on base, and striking out a season-high 18 times.

## STRUGGLES IN MAY

After batting a league-best .256 in the month of April, Bowie has batted a leagueworst .212 in the month of May. Bowie scored the most runs in the league in the month of April (118) but has scored the third-fewest runs (99) in the month of May. The Baysox have also struck out the most times this month (250).

## BASALLO IS HOT

Over his last 10 games, C Samuel Basallo is batting .436 (17-for-39) with two homers, a double and seven RBI and an OPS of 1.103. The Orioles No. 2 prospect collected a game-high three hits yesterday, his third three hit game and team-leading 15th multihit game of the season. Basallo is on a seven-game hit streak and an eight-game on-base streak. The 19-year-old is batting .306 in the month of May and after posting an OBP of .276 in April, his OBP in the month of May is at .379.

## TT HITS TATERS

1B TT Bowens smacked his fifth homer of the season on Tuesday with a towering two-run homer in the ninth off the top of the sponsorship signage in left-center. Bowens, who turned 26 on Monday, is tied with Samuel Basallo for the longest active hit streak on the team at seven consecutive games and has reached base in eight consecutive games. His 29 RBI on the season is tied for fourth in the Eastern League.

## SERVIN' IT UP

After enduring an 0-for-33 slump from May 9 - May 24, IF Anthony Servideo is 6-for-12 at the plate over his last three games. The 25-year-old infielder snapped out of his slump with a solo homer on Sunday against Richmond. Servideo has recorded multi-hit performances in three consecutive games while playing solid defense up the middle and at third.

## YOU GOOD PHAM

RHP Alex Pham makes his 10th start of the season for the Baysox. The Orioles No. 24 prospect is coming off a rough outing last Friday against Richmond where he went four innings and gave up a career-high nine runs over a season-high seven hits in a no decision. The 24-year old has fared better on the road than at home with a 3.95 ERA in three road starts. In his last start on the road, Pham struck out a season-high seven in 4.2 innings at Binghamton on May 18. This will be Pham's third career start against Somerset.

## PREVIEWING THE PATRIOTS

Entering this week, the Somerset Patriots are fourth in the Northeast Division at 22-23. The Double-A affiliate of the Yankees most recently took three of seven at New Hampshire but have won two of their last three. Nine of the Yankees' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, are on the active roster- OF Spencer Jones (No. 2), LHP Brock Selvidge (No. 10), C/1B Ben Rice (No. 12), C Agustin Ramirez (No. 20), RHP Zach Messinger (No. 21), RHP Trystan Vrieling (No. 22), RHP Jack Neely (No. 24), RHP Danny Watson (No. 27), and IF Benjamin Cowles (No. 29).

## TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Bailey Dees makes his 10th start of the season for the Patriots. The 6'8", 252 pound right-hander is coming off a five inning start at New Hampshire where he allowed three runs on six hits over two walks and six strikeouts in a no decision last Friday. Dees has pitched well in the month of May with an ERA of just 2.29. Dees pitched in 16 games with Somerset last year exclusively out of the bullpen. The 25-year-old was drafted in the 18th round of the 2021 Draft out of Penn State.

2024: Named to Bowie Opening Day roster and was named Opening Night starter. In most recent start, gave up a career-high 9 R on season-high 7 H in 4.0 IP in a no-decision on 5/24 vs RIC. Prior to start, had owned a 1.88 ERA in month of May, which was 7th-lowest in the league. Third career start against Somerset. Has a 2.70 ERA in 10.0 IP against Patriots. Has struck out 5+ batters in five of nine starts. Collected first Double-A win on 5/7 vs AKR after dealing 5.0 IP with 6 K, matching season-high.

**2023:** Began the season with High-A Aberdeen, going 3-3 with a 2.45 ERA in 12 outings. Won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month award in May, posting a 1.54 ERA and 34 K in 23.1 IP. 163 opposing average was the lowest in the South Atlantic League at the time of his promotion. Five of 10 starts with Aberdeen were 5+ IP with one run or fewer allowed. Promoted to Bowie on 6/2. Began Double-A career with nine scoreless frames across two starts. Surrendered fewer than 3 ER in 11 of his 14 Double-A outings, including six outings of 5 IP or more. Had a 1.80 ERA for Bowie in July. Was named an Orioles' Organizational All-Star in 2023.

**2022:** Spent the first portion of 2022 on the injured list, being activated by Single-A Delmarva on April 26. Pitched in six games for the Shorebirds, allowing two earned runs through 11.1 innings, before promotion to High-A Aberdeen on May 24. Only allowed a single run through his first three appearances for Aberdeen (8 IP) before allowing six runs across four innings in back-to-back rough outings, soon finding himself on the injured list for the second time in the season in late June. Spent a brief rehab stint with the FCL Orioles after being activated August 5, before finishing the season with Aberdeen. In total, pitched to a 5.66 ERA with the IronBirds across 20.2 innings in the regular season. Allowed one run in 2.1 innings of postseason action for Aberdeen.

**2021:** Pitched 6.2 innings for the FCL Orioles in 2021, surrendering six runs before throwing five scoreless innings across three appearances in Delmarva to end the season.

**Personal:** Pitched for four seasons at the University of San Francisco, finishing seventh in program history with 215 strikeouts and fourth with 11 saves.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet activation Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

## **CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX**

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stencilized outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince Geroge's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

## **BOWIE PIT BEEF**

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



## **COACHING STAFF**

## ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticute He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

## AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

## JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

## CHASE SEBBY

Fundamentals Coach

Sebby joins the Baysox staff as the Fun damentals Coach in 2024. Sebby was the fundamentals coach in Aberdeen last season and was a development coach within the Orioles' organization in 2022. Sebby played collegiately as a catcher at Cypress College and Ball State.

## BILLY FACTEAU

Development Coach

A familiar face in Bowie, Facteau rejoins the Baysox staff in 2024. Facteau was the development coach in Aberdeen last season, but began his professional coaching career as a development coach on the Baysox staff in 2022. Prior to his first stint with Bowie, Facteau first served in the Orioles' organization as a technology intern.
