Today: Following a rainout yesterday, the Lugnuts and Dragons play a doubleheader to open their six-game series in Dayton. Lansing is 3-3 this season at Day Air Ballpark, splitting a series in the second week of May, and are 8-10 overall this year against the Dragons. This is the Nuts' fourth doubleheader of the year, with an overall record of 3-3 in twinbill games.

Last Game, Sunday: Whitecaps 5, Lugnuts 4 (10 innings). The Caps clinched a six-game series split -- the Lugnuts' tenth series split of the year -- on a two-run tie-breaking home run by Colt Keith in the top of the 10th at Jackson Field. The Nuts had erased a 3-0 deficit with two runs in the eighth and a Shane Selman game-tying RBI double in the ninth.

On Deck: Following this series in Dayton, the Lugnuts continue their 12-game, 13-day road trip with a six-game set at Fort Wayne before wrapping up 2021 at home vs. West Michigan.

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, Lansing moved up to the High-A Central and the ballclub accepted an invitation to affiliate with the A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Royals (1996-98), Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

Lug. Notes: Headlines and Points of Interest

Winning Tight: Each of the last four Lugs victories and six of the last seven have come by one run. Lansing is 13-7 in one-run games this season.

Big Red: First baseman/catcher William Simoneit, who attended Cornell University before grad-transferring to Wake Forest and signing as an undrafted free agent in 2020, enjoyed an outstanding series against West Michigan, winning the opener with a walk-off home run, 2-1 (the Lugnuts' first base hit of the game), drilling a go-ahead three-run homer in the fifth game, and finishing 4-for-4 with three singles and a double in the Sunday finale. Simoneit is slashing .286/.375/.473 with an .848 OPS in August.

Turning Things Around: Outfielder Austin Beck, the Athletics' 1st-round pick in 2017 and the sixth overall selection in the draft, was hitting just .138 (9-for-65) in his first 20 games of the year when he was promoted to Triple-A Las Vegas in late June. Since returning, he's batted .269 (35-for-130) in 33 games.

The Strike Zone is That Way: Lugnuts batters were hit by pitches four times on Friday and three times Sunday by West Michigan. Both days included Cobie Vance, who was plunked in four separate games in the series. Brett Harris, who was hit 25 times in 53 games this year at Gonzaga, was struck twice on Sunday. The Nuts have been hit 85 times this year, third most in the High-A Central and two behind league-leading Great Lakes and Peoria.

Getting Healthier: Lansing's series with the Whitecaps saw three different Nuts return from extended stays on the Injured List in David Leal (had not played since July 25), Shane Selman (had not played since July 22) and Jeff Criswell (had not played since May 8).

Welcome Back: Speaking of Criswell, he returned from the Injured List on Sunday with two hitless innings and four strikeouts. The 22-year-old right-hander, rated MLB.com's No. 3 pitching prospect in the Athletics' organization and No. 14 overall prospect, had been placed on the Injured List May 12 after making his professional debut on May 8 for Lansing. A native of Portage, Mich., Criswell was rated Perfect Game's No. 1 high school right-hander in the state in 2017, attended the University of Michigan, and was drafted by Oakland in the 2nd round in 2020, 58th overall.

Up the Ladder: Oakland's Triple-A affiliate, the Las Vegas Aviators, has won 13 of their last 15 games, beating the Oklahoma City Dodgers last night, 5-1, to improve to 55-46 this year, five games behind first-place Reno in the Triple-A West's West Division. In Double-A, meanwhile, 2021 Lugnuts shortstop **Max Schuemann** finished August with a 1-for-5 showing last night, leaving his slash line in Midland at .342/.425/.450. The former Eastern Michigan Eagle batted .402 in August with a .470 on-base percentage and .471 slugging percentage, notching 41 hits (plus 12 walks and two HBPs) and scoring 20 runs in 25 games. He also had 12 steals this month, giving 48 for the year between Lansing and Midland.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2014: The season ended disappointingly, two outs into the sixth inning, shortened due to rain, with a 4-3 South Bend victory at Cooley Law School Stadium. 19-year-old 1B Rowdy Tellez went 3-for-3 with his second home run, finishing with a .357 batting average in a 12-game stint with the Lugnuts. The Nuts finished 62-77.

2018: In a heartbreaker, the Lugnuts blew 7-0 and 9-3 leads at Lake County, as Will Benson launched a three-run homer in the sixth and a two-run homer to ignite a five-run ninth inning for a 10-9 Captains walk-off winner. The Caps completed the comeback on a two-run Miguel Eladio homer to left on a 1-2 pitch from Dalton Rodriquez.

New Talent Infusion: The Lugnuts have five 2021 Athletics acquisitions on their roster in infielders Brett Harris (drafted in the 7th round, Gonzaga) and Drew Swift (8th round, Arizona State), outfielder Jonny Butler (14th round, North Carolina State), and pitchers Kyle Virbitsky (17th round, Penn State) and Jack Owen (undrafted free agent, Auburn).

Root, Root for the Home Team: July 4th's Lugnuts/Dragons series finale drew a season-high attendance of 10,109. That's higher than the average attendance in MLB for the Baltimore Orioles, Pittsburgh Pirates, Tampa Bay Rays, Miami Marlins and Oakland Athletics. Only nine of the 119 other Minor League teams have drawn a larger crowd to a game this season: Albuquerque, Nashville, Salt Lake, Charlotte, Fresno, Indianapolis, Round Rock, Durham and Las Vecas.

Pitching is an Art... and So is Sculpting: Blake McFarland, who pitched for the 2012 Lansing Lugnuts, is now a professional sculptor who competed on NBC's reality show "Making It," hosted by Nick Offerman and Amy Poehler, but was eliminated in the fifth episode.

Major League Lugnuts: Six former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season - pitcher Ty Tice '18 (Toronto, now with Arizona), outfielder Josh Palacios '16-'17 (Toronto), pitcher Tayler Saucedo '16-'17 (Toronto), pitcher Conner Greene '15 (Baltimore), pitcher Kirby Snead '16-'17 (Toronto) and infielder Otto Lopez '19 (Toronto). Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: Carlos Febles and Carlos Beltrán for the Kansas City Royals. Snead most recently debuted, appearing in relief for the Blue Jays on July 28.

Star of Stars: The 2021 MLB All-Star Game MVP Award was won by 2017 Lugnut Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., who went 1-for-3 with two RBIs, including a 468-foot home run, in the American League's 5-2 victory. Fellow 2017 Lugnut Bo Bichette came off the bench for the A.L. as reserve shortstop.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Stolen Bases: On June 15, Max Schuemann broke Samad Taylor's franchise single-game record of four steals in a game (set July 1, 2018) with five stolen bases against the Great Lakes Loons.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Home Runs Allowed: On June 20, Stevie Emanuels broke the franchise single game record, tied many times before, of three homers served up in a game, giving up four HRs to the Loons - two apiece by Deacon Liput and Andy Pages.

Record-Setting, Single Game, HBPs: On July 14, Lansing Lugnuts pitchers hit seven Lake County Captains, breaking the franchise single game record, and the second-highest single game HBP total for a team plunked by one pitching staff behind the 1993 Gulf Coast League Braves, who were hit eight times on June 18, 1993.

Representing His Country: 1B/3B Jordan Díaz played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach Don Schulze was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations Billy Beane was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman Patrick McColl set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

International Appeal: Seven nations are represented on the Lugnuts' roster: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa (Anthony Phillips) and Venezuela (Javier Godard).

Welcome to the Pros: Pitchers Jeff Criswell, Stevie Emanuels, Jack Owen, Kyle Virbitsky and Shohei Tomioka, catchers Jared McDonald, Drew Millas and William Simoneit, infielder Patrick McColl, and outfielder Michael Guldberg have all made their professional debut with the Lugnuts this season.

So Many Starters: The Lugnuts have used 19 different starting pitchers this season, namely Brady Basso, Osvaldo Berrios, Reid Birlingmair, Charlie Cerny, Jeff Criswell, Jack Cushing, David Leal, Stevie Emanuels, Richard Guasch, Jorge Juan, Rafael Kelly, Bryce Nightengale, Jack Owen, Colin Peluse, Leudeny Pineda, Seth Shuman, Shohei Tomioka, Kyle Virbitsky and Brock Whittlesey.

Three Nuts Go to Washington: On July 30, catcher Drew Millas and pitchers Richard Guasch and Seth Shuman were traded by the Athletics to the Washington Nationals in exchange for catcher Yan Gomes and utilityman Josh Harrison.

Personal: Drafted in the 20th round in 2017 from the Puerto Rico Baseball Academy and High School (Gurabo, Puerto Rico) and signed away from Alabama State University commitment... signing scout: Hector Stewart.

PRBHS History: Founded in 2002 by Ed Correa, who first used the Los Angeles Dodgers' Dominican complex in Las Palmas, DR, in 1999 as what would become the Puerto Rico Baseball Academy and High School three years later... produced Carlos Correa (1st overall in 2012), Hiram Burgos, Joe Jiménez, Vimael Machin, Jesmuel Valentin and Christian Vázquez... this year produced one draftee, Astros 16th-rounder Gaby Nieves... in 2017, when Berríos was drafted, he was one of four players drafted from PRBHS.

Puerto Rican Baseball: Puerto Rico has produced four Hall of Famers thus far in Roberto Clemente, Iván Rodríguez, Roberto Alomar and Orlando Cepeda, with 1996 Lugnuts outfielder Carlos Beltrán and current catcher Yadier Molina each with their own Hall of Fame cases... today's Major League stars from Puerto Rico are led by Javier Báez and Francisco Lindor of the Mets, José Berríos of the Blue Jays, and Carlos Correa of the Astros... Lindor, like Osvaldo Berrios, was born in Caguas.

Pro Debut - 2017 in AZL: Made professional debut on July 1, 2017, vs. AZL Giants, allowing three runs on five hits in 1 2/3... final appearance of the year was his best (3 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 5 K) vs. AZL SD1 on September 2... gave up .302 avg. to lefties, .366 to righties... base-stealers were 4-for-6.

2018 in AZL: Relieved Daulton Jefferies in the second game of the season, tossing 3 2/3 innings (6 H, 1 R, 5 K) vs. AZL Giants Black... pitched six-inning gem (3 H, 1 R, 4 K) on the 4th of July vs. AZL White Sox... gave up just two earned runs in final 17 2/3 innings... limited righties to .252 avg./.628 OPS while lefties hit .348/.860... base-stealers were 6-for-6.
