#### JAX EARNS SECOND STRAIGHT SHUTOUT

Joe Mack cracked his first career Triple-A home run on Saturday and the Jumbo Shrimp pitching staff blanked the Stripers 2-0. Mack's solo homer in the first opened the scoring. Maximo Acosta added an RBI single in the third inning to make it 2-0. Jacksonville starter Janson Junk scattered four hits in his 5.2 innings of work. Anderson Pilar and Christian Roa each worked 0.2 innings. Austin Roberts struck out two in a perfect eighth inning and Seth Martinez fanned two in the ninth to pick up his third save of the season

#### WE WILL NEVER ALLOW A RUN AGAIN (MAYBE)

Thanks to a 7-0 shutout on Friday and a 2-0 blanking on Saturday, both of Gwinnett, Jacksonville has earned back-toback shutouts for the first time since August 23 and August 25 of the 2017 season, with both of those zeroes coming against Birmingham. This marks the first time a Jacksonville club has recorded consecutive shutouts in nine-inning games for the first time since August 8-9, 2016 against Chattanooga. Heading into play on Sunday, the Jumbo Shrimp have worked 19 consecutive scoreless innings, and have yielded just one run over their last 33 innings.

### **APRIL COME SHE WILL**

With a 20-6 (.769) record, the Jumbo Shrimp already posses the most wins of any team in MiLB. With three games to play in April, the 20 wins Jacksonville has accumulated through March and April are a club record (2005-present) for most victories over the months of March and April. In the month of April alone, the Jumbo Shrimp have already recorded 18 victories: Jacksonville had not won more than 15 games in any prior April since at least 2005.

### 'PEN PALS

Jacksonville starters have gone at least 5.0 innings just 13 times in 26 games thus far this season. The club's bullpen, however, has responded to the added responsibility in a huge way. Jumbo Shrimp relief pitching has combined for a 2.52 ERA and .180 BAA, the best marks in Triple-A. The club's bullnen also ranks third in the level in fewest hits allowed (79) and tied for sixth in strikeouts (133). Jumbo Shrimp relievers have combined to toss 121.2 innings through 26 games (4.7 per game), sixth-most in Triple-A.

#### BE STILL, MY BEATING START

Jacksonville starting pitchers have tossed just 107.0 innings thus far through the season's first 26 games, a rate of just 4.1 per contest. Those innings, however, have been extraordinarily effective: Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have posted the best ERA in Triple-A at 2.78 and issued just 26 walks, the fewest in the level. The club's starters also rank fifth in both fewest hits allowed (89) and BAA (.229) and eighth in strikeouts (113). Interestingly, Jacksonville starting pitching has the seventh-lowest groundout-to-airout rate at 0.81

#### HOME IS WHERE THE HEART IS

Jacksonville is now an extraordinary 15-2 at home this season. Of the other 119 Minor League Baseball teams, only six have double-digit wins at home, with none above 11 home triumphs. In their home ballpark, the Jumbo Shrimp have allowed only 44 runs (2.6 per game), pitching to a Triple-A best 2.05 ERA. Their .184 BAA, ranks third at the level. The Jumbo Shrimp have scored 80 runs at VyStar Ballpark (4.7 per game), collecting tied for the third-most hits (134) at home in Triple-A.

### MEN OF STEAL

After failing to steal a base in the 2025 season opener, Jacksonville has recorded multiple stolen bases in 16 of their last 25 games (64.0 percent). In fact, the Jumbo Shrimp have five games with at least five stolen bases, including a club record (2005-present) seven steals in game two of a doubleheader on April 12 vs. Charlotte; Jacksonville notched five stolen bases in a game just twice over the 2022-24 seasons combined. The Jumbo Shrimp currently rank tied for second in the minor leagues and first Triple-A with 69 stolen bases.

#### SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville is 9-1 in one-run games this season. No other team in MiLB has more than seven one-run victories... The Shrimp already possess two winning streaks of at least six games for the first time since 2022. Should they win Sunday, they would hold two winning streaks of at least seven games for the first time since 2017... Jacksonville is looking to sweep two sets in a year for the first time since 2014. A win Sunday nets their second brooming of the season.



### **ABOUT ROBINSON**

-A native of San Cristobal in the Dominican Republic, Piña was originally signed by the Los Angeles Angels as an international free agent on February 15, 2017.

-Following the 2023 season, Piña elected free agency. He signed with the Philadelphia Phillies as a minor league free agent and spent the 2024 campaign between Double-A Reading and Triple-A Lehigh Valley.

### 2024 SEASON

-Piña posted major platoon splits; While he held right-handed hitters to a .195/.245/.312/.557 batting line in 249 plate appearances, left-handed batters hit .324/.366/.591/.957 against him over 303 plate appearances.

-Piña posted an 8-2 record and 3.50 ERA over 12 starts during the season's first half (61.2 IP, 65 H, 8 BB, 70 K, .262 BAA). However, over 13 starts in the second half of the year, he went 5-6 with a  $4.79\,\mathrm{ERA}$  (67.2 IP, 71 H, 19 BB, 62 K, .269 BAA)

-With the bases empty, opponents hit .279/.329/.487/.816 against Piña. Those figures dropped to .245/.285/.431/.716 with runners on and .217/.246/.433/.679 with runners in scoring position.

### 2023 SEASON

-Piña posted fairly similar platoon splits, actually faring slightly better against left-handed hitting (.225/.338/.318/.656 in 213 plate appearances). Right-handed hitters batted .242/.351/.320/.671 against him over 210 plate appearances.

-With the bases empty, Piña held opponents to a .205/.323/.274/.597 line in 219 plate appearances. With runners on, however, that swelled to .267/.369/.373/.742 over 205 plate appearances.
