NEWS & NOTES

TWO WEEKS IN THE TRIAD: The Hudson Valley Renegades continue their 12-game road trip of the season this afternoon as they wrap up their six-game series with the Greensboro Grasshoppers. This is the lone 12-game trip of the year for Hudson Valley. Following this six-game series, the Renegades have a six-game date with the Winston-Salem Dash. This is the only series of the year between Hudson Valley and Greensboro, despite both playing in the North Division.

SO, ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Renegades were swept in a doubleheader by the Greensboro Grasshoppers on Saturday night, falling 2-0 in the opener and 1-0 in the nightcap. **Trey Sweeney** had hits in both games of the doubleheader, while **Everson Pereira** went 2-for-3 in the second contest. Starters **Beck Way** and **Jose Panacual** combined to allow just two earned runs in 10.0 innings of work.

PEREIRA YARD WORK: **Everson Pereira** hit two home runs for the Renegades on Friday night, his fifth career multi-homer game. All four have come within the last calendar year, and four while a member of the Hudson Valley Renegades, including two this week. The two-homer game gave Pereira 20 home runs with Hudson Valley, making him just the second player in franchise history to hit 20 long balls with the team.

GADES DIG THE LONG BALL: After hitting just 48 home runs in their first 57 games of the season, the Hudson Valley Renegades hit 13 home runs in the first three games of the series in Greensboro. That represents a whopping 21.3% of the team's total home runs on the season. The Gades have seen four players hit multiple home runs in a game (**Everson Pereira** 2x, **Tyler Hardman** and **Carlos Narvaez**), and on Friday hit a season-high six home runs in one game.

YANKEES AFFILIATES IN GREENSBORO: In the history of Greensboro baseball, the Yankees have fielded teams in the league several times. From 1958-68, the Yankees were affiliated with a Carolina League team, the Greensboro Yankees/Patriots. From 1980-84, the Yankees returned as the parent club of the South Atlantic League Greensboro Hornets. After a five-year hiatus, the Yanks returned from 1990-02 as the parent club of the Hornets/Bats.

START ME UP: In their last 28 games, Renegades starting pitchers have turned in some great individual performances, and as a unit have been performed at a high level. In those games, HV starters are 7-7 with a 2.82 ERA (42 ER/133.2 IP), with 119 hits allowed, 46 walks (3.09BB/9) and 128 strikeouts (8.62 K/9). The run has lowered the collective starting pitchers'

ERA from 4.61 to 3.71, and the starters win total has quadrupled.

CLOSE GAME TROUBLE: Entering play on Sunday, the Renegades sit at exactly .500 with a 31-31 record, despite a +50 run differential, the second-best in the South Atlantic League North Division (36-26 pythag record). Part of the reason for this has been the Gades performance in one and two-run games this season. Hudson Valley is 9-11 (.450) in one-run games, and 7-11 (.389) in two-run games this season. Teams are typically around .500 in these kinds of games, indicating that the Gades have experienced some bad luck.

BOWMAN ON THE RUN: **Cooper Bowman** stole his 24th base of the season on Friday night in Greensboro. That is the most steals in a single season by a Renegades player since **Jake Fraley** set the franchise record with 33 in 2016. Bowman has been successful in eight straight attempts since he was last caught stealing, and is 37-for-41 (.902) on steals in his career.

ALVAREZ CLOSING IN ON RECORDS: Reliever **Nelson Alvarez** has his sights set on two of the Renegades all-time pitching records. He currently ranks fourth all-time in total appearances, just four shy of tying **Oscar Bustillos** and **Jason Jimenez** for the lead. Alvarez also has racked up seven wins out of the bullpen, which ties him with teammate **Charlie Ruegger** for third on the all-time relief wins list, two shy of **Mike Venafro's** mark set in 1995. Dubiously, Alvarez has issued 51 career walks with Hudson Valley, which ties him for fifth most, but he is still 42 shy of **Rich Dorman's** franchise mark of 93.

HARDMAN HEATING UP: After a slow start to the season, infielder **Tyler Hardman** has been swinging a hot bat lately, picking up hits in 14 of his last 16 games. The hot stretch has lifted his season batting line from .173/.279/.298 to .246/.328/.398, a 149-point jump in his OPS. The stretch was punctuated by his first career multi-homer game on 6/15 at Greensboro.

HUDSON VALLEY TO THE SHOW: The Renegades have had two 2021 alumni recently make their MLB debuts. Infielders **Josh Smith** and **Ezequiel Duran** both made their debuts with the Texas Rangers last week. They became the second and third Renegades, respectively, under the Yankees affiliation (2021 - Present) to debut in the Major Leagues, joining **RHP Elvis Peguero**, who saw his first MLB action August 26, 2021. Ironically, all three Yankees-era Renegades in the majors debut with other organizations after both were traded in 2021. **Duran's** debut marked the 110th former HV player to make it to MLB.

HAPPY JUNETEENTH: Today marks the annual celebration of Juneteenth, a federal holiday commemorating the anniversary of the announcement of General Order No. 3 by Union Army General **Granger** on June 19, 1865 after the Army's arrival in Galveston, Texas. G.O. No. 3 transmitted the news of the Emancipation Proclamation to the residents of Texas and freed all remaining enslaved people in the state, nearly two and a half years after the Proclamation was issued. The holiday has been celebrated annually since 1866, but was not made a Federal Holiday until 2021.

LAST TIME OUT: Continuing to be ramped up after missing two full seasons, Sikkema turned in a career-long outing last Sunday against the Jersey Shore BlueClaws, tossing 3.1 innings on 52 pitches in an eventual 10-7 Hudson Valley win. The lone run he allowed came in the third inning, following an Ethan Wilson triple, Rixon Wingrove brought him in with a fielder's choice where first baseman **Spencer Henson** threw home to try to cut off the run, but the throw was high. Sikkema also tied a career high with four strikeouts.

BACK IN THE SADDLE AGAIN: After an abbreviated four-game professional debut in 2019 and the COVID-19 pandemic canceling the 2020 Minor League season Sikkema missed all of 2021 with a lat injury. He told reporters at Renegades media day: "I just want to have fun again, get to play the game. It's been a while since I've played against somebody in a different jersey. That's the biggest thing for me is just going out there and have fun getting to play the game I love." After beginning the season on the I.L., Sikkema made his debut on May 8 (G1) at Jersey Shore, his first appearance in 1,022 days.

CORNBELT CONNECTION: Sikkema and Renegades manager **Tyson Blaser** share a common background, with both hailing from the state of Iowa. Sikkema remembers being a kid and watching Blaser play when the 'Gades skipper was an undergrad at the University of Iowa. The two also played for the same travel ball programs while they were coming up, so Blaser has been watching Sikkema since his high school days. "It's pretty cool to be playing for him," says Sikkema.

2022 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season on the Renegades Break Camp roster, was placed on the 7-day Injured List on 4/8 and reinstated on 5/8.
- Threw 2.0 perfect innings in his season debut on May 8 (G1) at Jersey Shore, his first pro appearance in 1,022 days.

2019 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Made his pro debut, allowing 1ER over 10.2IP (0.84 ERA, 6H, 1BB, 13K) in four starts with short-season Single-A Staten Island.

PERSONAL:

- Full name is Tyler James Sikkema.
- Signed to a \$1.95 million bonus (slot value) following the 2019 MLB Draft.
- Drafted by the Yankees with the 38th overall pick in the 1st round of the 2019 MLB Draft (Competitive Balance Round A), was the second Yankees selection in the first round (**Anthony Volpe**, 30th overall).
- The pick used to select Sikkema was acquired from Cincinnati along with 2B Shed Long in exchange for RHP **Sonny Gray** and LHP **Reiver Sanmartin** on January 21, 2019.
- Pitched three seasons (2017-19) at Missouri... As a junior in 2019, ranked third in the NCAA in ERA, going 7-4 with two shutouts, two saves and a 1.32 ERA (88.2IP, 54H, 23R/13ER, 31BB, 101K, 4HR) in 17 games (13 starts).
- Was a consensus All-American in 2019, earning second-team honors from *Baseball America* and the NCBWA and third-team honors from Perfect Game/Rawlings and *Collegiate Baseball*... Was also a Golden Spikes Award Semifinalist.
- Was a 2017 Freshman All-America selection.
- Graduated in 2016 from Central DeWitt (Iowa) H.S., where he was a four-sport athlete all four years, also playing basketball, football and soccer... His father, Shane Sikkema, was his Head Coach in high school.
- Went 30-5 in his high school career with a 0.83 ERA, while also batting .483 as a senior.
