ALL-STAR FUTURES GAME: New York Mets No. 6 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 97 overall prospect **Brandon Sproat** is representing the Mets in MLB's All-Star Futures Game today at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas. The game will be broadcast live at 4 p.m. ET on MLB Network, MLB.TV, MLB.com and on the MLB App. Sproat is tied for the third-best ERA (1.71) in Minor League Baseball, among full-season pitchers. The 23-year-old is in his first professional season and is 4-0 with a 2.05 ERA in eight Double-A starts. Sproat was selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2023 MLB Draft.

LAST TIME OUT: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies beat the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 6-4, on Friday night to extend their win streak to seven games. **Kevin Parada** homered for the second-straight game and drove in a season-high-tying three runs. **Ryan Clifford**, Parada, **Jeremiah Jackson**, and **Stanley Consuegra** recorded multi-hit games. **Jeffrey Colon** earned his first Double-A win and **Carlos Guzman** got the save.

W7: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies have won seven-straight games, all on the road. With a win on Saturday, Binghamton would tie its season-long eight-game win streak. The Ponies won eight-straight games from May 2 to May 11 with three wins against Hartford and five wins at Portland. The Ponies are outscoring their opponents 40-17 on this seven-game win streak.

PARADA PARTY: Mets No. 10 prospect and top catching prospect **Kevin Parada** has homered in back-to-back games and drove in a career-high-tying three runs on Friday night. Parada has recorded three-straight multi-hit games and is hitting .444 (8-for-18) with two home runs and five runs batted in across four games this series. The 22-year-old is also riding a season-long 13-game on-base streak, hitting .300 with an .915 OPS, 15 hits, three home runs, three doubles, and seven runs batted in.

CLIFFORD CRUSH: Mets No. 4 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 71 overall prospect **Ryan Clifford** recorded his fifth multi-hit game over his last eight games on Friday. He is riding a three-game hit streak, hitting .462 (6-for-13) with two home runs, two doubles, and six runs batted in over that span. The 20-year-old has reached base in 13-straight games, in 35 of his last 37 games, and in 40 of his last 43 games. Clifford hit a grand slam and had a multi-homer game on Wednesday. In 33 games since the start of June, Clifford is hitting .279 with a .423 OBP, 1.080 OPS, 11 home runs, eight doubles, 28 runs batted in, 29 runs scored, and 28 walks. In 10 games in July, the 20-year-old is hitting .405 with a 1.206 OPS, 17 hits, three HR and 10 RBIs.

JACKSON JACKS: **Jeremiah Jackson** recorded his 12th multi-hit game of the season on Friday. He belted his 11th home run of the season on Thursday. It also marked his fifth-career home run at Delta Dental Stadium in his first 13 games. Jackson is hitting .288 (17-for-59) with five home runs, eight runs batted in, and nine runs in 14 games at Delta Dental Stadium in his career.

GUZMAN IS THE MAN: Right-hander **Carlos Guzman** recorded his first save of the season on Friday. Guzman is 1-0 with a 1.23 ERA and a 20-to-7 strikeout-to-walk ratio over 14.2 innings across his last 10 overall appearances.

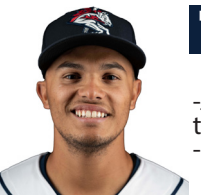
