#### INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: A tie-breaking two-run home run off the bat of Billy McKinney in the fifth inning lifted the Indianapolis Indians past the Buffalo Bisons in a 6-4 win at Victory Field on Thursday night. It was Indy's third win of the homestand. With Buffalo leading 4-3, in the bottom of the fifth inning, the Indians broke through with a three-run frame that would win the game. The rally got started with two outs, when Canaan Smith-Njigba roped a double to the right-field corner to score Jake Lamb from second base and tie the game. McKinney then blasted his second hit of the night with a go-ahead two-run shot off Chad Dallas. Buffalo got the scoring started in the second inning after a Steward Berroa line-drive to plate Luis De Los Santos. Indy then took the lead in the second with three runs courtesy of a Dustin Peterson RBI single. Nick Gonzales sacrifice fly and Yasmani Grandal RBI double. Buffalo recaptured the lead with a three-run third inning, highlighted by a two-run double by Payton Henry, before Indy burst for three runs in the fifth to take the lead for good.

MCMASHING: Outfielder Billy McKinney broke open Thursday night's contest with his go-ahead two-run home run to break 4-4 tie in the fifth inning, McKinney finished his night 2-for-4 with a double, a home run and two RBI — his second consecutive game with multiple RBI. The lefty slugger is 3-for-6 with two runs scored, a double, a home run, five RBI and three walks in three games vs. Buffalo.

NEED FOR SPEED: The Indians entered the week with the least number of stolen bases (10) in the International League before swiping seven bases in as many attempts to lead the IL this week. Indy's seven stolen bases are tied for the second-most stolen bags at the Triple-A level, behind only Salt Lake (10). Ji Hwan Bae paces all Indians baserunners with four stolen bases during this stretch with three others swiping one apiece. Bae leads the team in stolen bases (5), followed by Gilberto Celestino (3) and Liover Peguero (3).

SHUT THE DOOR: Brent Honeywell earned his second save of the season after posting a scoreless ninth inning to preserve Indy's two-run lead on Thursday night. It was Honeywell's second appearance of the week, following a perfect inning with three punchouts on Tuesday. The right-hander followed scoreless performances by relievers by Connor Sadzeck (1.0ip, 1h) and Geronimo Franzua (2.0ip, 1h, 2bb, 3k) to shut down the Buffalo offense.

**BAE HAS WHEELS:** Ji Hwan Bae became the first Indians baserunner to swipe multiple bases in a game this season on Thursday night. Bae had five games with multiple stolen bases last season with Pittsburgh — the last time coming on June 4 vs. St. Louis (NL) when he swiped a pair. Bae has been excellent in the leadoff spot for Indy, reaching base in more than half of his plate appearances in 13 games. He recorded a season-high four hits on Wednesday, his most in a game since his five-hit performance at lowa on April 29, 2022. The speedy 24-year-old has successfully reached base in all 13 games he's played. Dating back to Sept. 19, 2022, Bae has reached base in 25 consecutive Triple-A games.

JAKE RAKES: Jake Lamb, the International League's top hitter, notched his third double of the week on Thursday. Lamb remains atop the league in batting average thanks to hits in 10 of his last 12 games. Along with his league-leading .388 average, he leads the IL with a .482 on-base percentage and ranks third in OPS (1.094). Lamb has reached base safely in 20 of 21 games played this season. The lefty slugger has been an on-base machine, collecting a hit in 16 games and drawing seven combined walks in the five games that he's gone hitless this season.

TWO FOR PEGGY: Infielder Liover Peguero notched yet another multi-hit game on Thursday night with a 2-for-4 performance. He is the newest Indians hitter The catch fire at the plate. Peguero has multiple hits in four of his last five games, going 9-for-20 with four runs scored, two doubles, a triple and five RBI. The 23-year-old is now hitting .317 (32-for-101) with eight doubles, two triples, a home run, 21 RBI and a .816 OPS in 25 games. His season is highlighted by a career-high five-hit night on April 5 at Memphis.

LEADING BY EXAMPLE: Short Indy's roster currently holds the International League leaders in batting average, on-base percentage, doubles, runs scored and earned run average. Jake Lamb paces all IL hitters in batting average — with teammate Nick Gonzales following in the rankings — and OPS. Gonzales leads the league in doubles (12) and runs scored (28). Flamethrower Paul Skenes owns a 0.39 ERA with just one earned run allowed over 23.0 innings pitched to lead qualified pitchers. Outfielder Matt Gorski has clubbed three triple to tie him for the league lead, alongside six others.

TAKING CARE OF BUSINESS: The Indians have been at their best at Victory Field this season. With a 12-3 record at home, the Indians have outscored their opponents 88-64. A culmination of offensive and pitching success has created the best home field advantage in the International League. Indianapolis ranks second in the league in batting average (.293) and ERA (3.86) as the home team. Indy is on a four-game winning streak at Victory Field and have won seven of their last eight home contests.

TONIGHT: The Indians and Bisons continue their six-game set tonight at Victory Field at 7:05 PM ET. The Indians jumped out to a 3-0 series lead with a win on Thursday night. A win tonight would earn the Indians their third series win of the season. Last season, Indianapolis visited Sahlen Field and was swept in the six-game series by the Bisons. Tonight, RHP Wily Peralta (1-0, 6.28) will take the hill for Indianapolis while Buffalo will counter with RHP Andrew Bash (1-0, 4.82). Peralta made five starts against Buffalo with Rochester last season, he surrendered 26 runs over 17.0 innings pitched. Bash made one start against Indianapolis last season on Aug. 31, he posted 5.1 innings with one run allowed on six hits with four strikeouts.

THIS DATE IN 1963: In his International League MVP season, shortstop Don Buford was a triple away from the cycle after hitting two singles, a double and home run in an 11-6 win over the Atlanta Crackers at old Victory Field. He went on to hit .336 with 41 doubles, 114 runs and 42 stolen bases that season.
