### Today's Game

The Fightin Phils return home and begin a six-game series against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays. It is the first-of-18 games between the teams this season and first-of-12 at FirstEnergy Stadium. New Hampshire returns to Reading from June 10-15 and the Fightin Phils head to New Hampshire from Aug. 5-10. Reading won the 2024 season-series over the Fisher Cats 11-6, including a 5-1 record at home.

### Game 30 Recap

The Fightin Phils utilized an all-around effort en route to a Sunday win at Binghamton to ultimately take two-of-five games from the Rumble Ponies last week. Braeden Fausnaught started and allowed one-earned run on three hits over five innings, along with five strikeouts. The bullpen combined to allow one run on just one hit over the final-four frames of the game. Aidan Miller had a strong day offensively, with two hits, a run and double. Keaton Anthony finished off his strong week with two more hits, a run, double and RBI. Luis Verudgo had two runs driven in, along with a hit, for the Fightin Phils in the victory.

### Starting Stat

Braeden Fausnaught's win on Sunday marked just the second time this season a Fightin Phils' starting pitcher has earned a win in a game. The other instance was when Jean Cabrera did it on Apr. 16 against Binghamton.

### A Grand Swing

In the first game of Saturday's doubleheader, Trent Farquhar lifted a grand slam in the top of the second inning. The grand slam was the first of the season for Reading and the R-Phils' first since Justin Crawford on Aug. 10, 2024, at Akron. It was the first grand slam, and only the third-career home run of Farquhar's career. His four RBI in the game one win was a career-high as well for Farquhar.

### Moore Please

Robert Moore turned in another strong week against Binghamton. Over five games, he slashed .389/.476/.778 (1.254 OPS), along with seven runs, four doubles, one home run and two RBI. Entering play today, Moore is seventh in the Eastern League in OBP (.394), fifth in SLG (.532), tied for fifth in OPS (.926) and tied for seventh in home runs with five. Since May 1, he is tied for second with three home runs, tied for second with four doubles, tied for third with seven extra-base hits and tied for fourth with 22 total bases sine the start of the month.

### Keaton Crushing It

Keaton Anthony turned in a very strong week at Binghamton. Over three games, he slashed .500/.538/1.000 (1.538 OPS) with two runs, three doubles, one home run and six RBI. That included a career-night last Wednesday with four hits, one run, two doubles, a home run and five RBI. His five RBI in the game were a career-high and the second time this season a Fightin Phil had five RBI in a game (Robert Moore 4/15 vs Binghamton). Anthony's four hit game was the first time a R-Phil had four hits in a game since Carson Taylor on June 21, 2024, at New Hampshire.

### On the Other Side of History

Saturday's second game was the first perfect game in Binhamton Rumble Ponies history. Jonah Tong went 6.2 innings pitched and struck out 13, then TJ Shook came in and retired the only batter he faced to finish off the perfect game. The perfect game was the first against Reading since August 25, 1990, when Kevin Morton of New Britain tossed a perfect game against Reading in seven innings. It was also the first no-hitter of any king thrown against the Fightin Phils since Bryan Bello of Portland did it in a seven-inning game on May 5, 2022.

### Double Double

The Fightin Phils turned in seven doubles and eight extra-base hits in Wednesday night's game, both of which are season highs. The eight extra-base hits are Reading's most in a game since having eight on June 28, of last season, against Bowie. It was the first time the R-Phils had seven doubles in a game since hitting eight on June 29, 2018, against Hartford.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

**May 14, 1967:** At Reading, Robin Roberts tosses his second straight shutout as the Phillies blank Pawtucket, 2-0. Roberts allows just four singles, walks one and strikes out nine to pick up his second win.

### Here Come the Cats

New Hampshire enters today with a 14-18 record, sitting in fourth place in the Northeast Division. 2024 was a down season for New Hampshire, as they finished with an Eastern League-worse 52-84 record. The Fisher Cats went 3-2 last week against Hartford at home and after this week return back home and welcome Somerset. The Fisher Cats' roster features six of the Blue Jays' top-30 prospects: Charles McAdoo (13), RJ Schreck (20), Ryan Jennings (21), Jace Bohrofen (24), Dasan Brown (27) and Peyton Williams (28).

### On the Mound for the Cats

Righty CJ Van Eyk makes the start today for New Hampshire. Over six starts this season, Van Eyk is 2-3, with a 5.28 ERA (30.2 IP, 28 H, 10 BB, 31 SO). Van Eyk last pitched May 7 vs Hartford and earned the win, as he allowed one run on four hits over seven innings, with six strikeouts. He spent all of last season with New Hampshire and went 3-8, with a 5.68 ERA over 30 appearances and 16 starts. Van Eyk pitched in five games against Reading last season and made three starts, going 1-2, with a 4.58 ERA over 17.2 IP. The 26-year old was drafted in the second round of the 2020 draft out of Florida State.

**LAST START:** 5/7 at BNG: 3.2 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 0 HR, 2 BB, 4 SO, 73 pitches (43 strikes)... The Fightin' Phils lost to Binghamton, 9-7, at Mirabito Stadium. Chace tossed his second-consecutive scoreless outings and allowed just two hits. He matched a season-high with four strikeouts and walked two. He fell victim to a high pitch count, throwing a season-high 73 pitches, and left the game with two outs in the bottom of the fourth inning. Chace was relieved by Andrew Bechtold in the bottom of the fourth inning.

### 2025 Season:

- Prior to the 2025 season, Chace was added to the Phillies 40-man roster (on 11/19/24) to protect him from the Rule-5 Draft
- The Phillies optioned Chace to Reading (AA) on March 8
- Chace appeared in one game for the Phillies during Spring Training (3/7 at PIT) and threw a perfect inning
- Started for the Phillies in the Spring Breakout Game (3/14 vs PIT) and tossed a 1-2-3 first inning, while striking out two hitters in his lone inning of work
- Opens the season ranked as the Phillies No. 5 Prospect (MLB Pipeline)
- Made first start of season Apr. 9 at Somerset, lasting just two innings and walking four batters
- Has not had a decision yet this season, pitching a season-high four innings Apr. 30 vs HBG; which was his first scoreless outing of season: 4.0 IP, 3 H, 1 BB, 4 SO
- Did not allow a run over 3.2 IP May 7 at HBG
- Has not allowed an earned run over last two outings (7.2 IP)

### 2024 Season:

- Began the season in the Baltimore Orioles organization, making 17 appearances (nine starts) with Aberdeen (A+)
- Traded to the Phillies on July 30, along with Seth Johnson, for Gregory Soto
- After making two starts with Jersey Shore (A+) was promoted to Reading (AA) on Aug. 13
- Went 3-1, with a 2.59 ERA in five August starts (7 ER, 24.1 IP), named Phillies Minor League Pitcher of the Month of August
- Set a brief career-high with 10 strikeouts over 4.2 IP on Aug. 24 at Binghamton
- Followed up with new career-high 13 strikeouts on Aug. 31 at Somerset, in best start of career. Had 19 swing and misses on night, with 13 against fastball; Named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week following start
