SOMERSET PATRIOTS NOTES

- The Somerset Patriots matched a season high run total in a 13-5 win over the Bowie Baysox on Friday night in game four of a six-game series at TD Bank Ballpark, coming in front of a season-high 7,452 fans.
 - o Six Patriots had multiple hits, while four Patriots supplied 3+ hit games in the win.
 - o Somerset's 17 hits marked a season-high, while their 13 runs matched a season-high.
 - Each of the top five batters in the Patriots order recorded multi-hit games, combining to go 13for-22 (.590) with 2 HR and 9 RBI.
- RHP Trystan Vrieling (5.2 IP, 5 R, 7 H, 3 BB, 6 K) earned his fourth win of the season in his 10th start.
 - o The Yankees No. 21 prospect fanned 6+ batters for the eighth time this season.
 - Vrieling ranks among the Eastern League leaders with 56 K (T-4th) and 56.1 IP (2nd).
- 2B Anthony Seigler (3-for-4, 2 HR, 2 RBI, 3 R, SB) swatted two home runs in the contest as part of a three-hit night.
 - Seigler set a season-high with 3 H, 3 R, and 2 RBI.
 - Friday marked Seigler's second-career two-homer game, with the first coming on 7/27/21 @WIL as a member of High-A Hudson Valley.
 - After his 2nd inning home run on Thursday, Seigler homered in back-to-back games for the first time in his career.
 - Seigler has reached base in four straight games to begin the series with 3 HR and 4 RBI.
- **DH Jasson Dominguez** (3-for-5, HR, 3 RBI, 2 R, SB) continued his rehab assignment with a three-hit, three-RBI game.
 - Dominguez has hit safely in six straight games with Somerset, going 11-for-25 (.440) with 3 HR and 7 RBI over that span.
 - The Yankees' top prospect has homered in three of his last five games.
 - Dominguez, recovering from Tommy John Surgery, began the game as the DH before playing the final three innings in CF.
- **CF Spencer Jones** (3-for-4, HR, RBI, 4 R, SB) matched a season-high with 3 H, while setting a new season and career-high with 4 R.
 - The Yankees' No. 2 prospect snapped a career-long homerless drought spanning 30 games, dating back to 4/23 @REA.
 - Jones extended his season-long on base streak to 14 games, the longest active streak by any Patriot.
