LHP Devin Smeltzer (4-6, 6.10 ERA) vs. LHP Justus Sheffield (1-4, 7.06 ERA)

THREE THREE-SPOTS LEAD GWINNETT TO 9-3 WIN A Peyton Burdick home run was not enough on Tuesday, as Gwinnett scored three runs in three different innings to roll 9-3 over Jacksonville. In a three-run Stripers second, Yolmer Sánchez lined a two-run single and Luke Williams walked with the bases loaded. Hoy Park launched a three-run bomb in the fifth inning. In the eighth, Justin Dean's two-run homer highlighted another three-run frame for Gwinnett to make it 9-0. The Jumbo Shrimp finally got on the board in the bottom of the eighth on Paul McIntosh's sacrifice fly. Burdick hit a two-run shot in the ninth. Jacksonville went 0-for-10 with runners in scoring position, stranding 12.

X MARKS THE SPOT

Xavier Edwards was optioned to Jacksonville on May 30 by Miami, but has been on a tear in his return to Triple-A. In the 40 games he's played since he's been optioned, the Coconut Creek, Fla., native is 62-for-169 at the plate, slashing .367/.411/.467/.878 with six doubles, one triple, three home runs, 25 RBIs and 36 runs scored. This hot streak has pushed Edwards up to second in the International League in batting average (.348) and ninth in OBP (.419). Among the 291 players in the IL this season with at least 100 plate appearances, Edwards ranks second in swingingstrike rate (4.0 percent).

AUSTIN POWERS

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 48 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 51-for-171 (.298/.378/.678/1.056) at the plate with 12 doubles, one triple, 17 home runs, 48 RBIs and 34 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1 percent of his plate appearances at the Triple-A level last season, Allen is fanning just 20.2 percent of the time in 2023.

NEED FOR SPEED

Xavier Edwards stole a base successfully on Saturday, pushing his personal streak to 24 attempts in a row without getting caught. The Jumbo Shrimp as a whole have been one of the best teams in baseball in stealing bases; Jacksonville's 84.5 percent stolen base success rate is second in Triple-A and fourth out of the 120 full season MiLB teams. Only two Jumbo Shrimp have been caught stealing since July 9, with the club swiping 16 bags in that span.

MAYOR MANGUM

Jacksonville outfielder **Jake Mangum** went hitless in seven of the eight games he played in from May 31-June 8, going just 1-for-24 at the plate. In the 28 games since that point, Mangum is a sizzling 41-for-118, hitting .347/.379/.475/.854 with 10 doubles, one triple, one home run, 12 RBIs and 19 runs scored. The Flowood, Miss., native has picked up 11 multi-hit games in his last 16 games, batting 29-for-78 (.372/.395/.500/.895) with seven doubles, one homer, eight RBIs and 13 runs scored during this stretch. On the season, among the 220 IL players with at least 150 plate appearances, Mangum has the fourth-highest opposite field rate (43.4 percent). His 30.5 percent line drive rate is seventh.

ODDS & ENDS

Jacksonville looked like world beaters in a six-game series at Charlotte from July 4-9. The Jumbo Shrimp took five out of six games from the Knights - their most wins in a series since 2022 and outscored Charlotte by a whopping 58-28 margin. However, in the other 16 games of the second half of the season, Jacksonville is just 6-10, with all but one of those victories coming by no more than two runs. In those 10 defeats, the Jumbo Shrimp have lost by a combined 50 runs. Thus, while the club was +30 in their run differential in the Queen City, they are at -26 against their other second-half opponents (Durham, Worcester, Nashville & Gwinnett).

THE PENDULUM SWINGS

Jacksonville started their series at Nashville with strong performances from their bullpen. In the set's first two games, Jumbo Shrimp relievers surrendered only one run on seven hits in 11.0 innings of work, combining for 12 strikeouts against seven walks. However, things devolved quickly from there; over the next three contests, Jacksonville's relief corps combined to allow 21 runs, all earned, on 24 hits in 17.0 innings with 23 strikeouts against 12 walks. Over the last two games, the Shrimp bullpen regained its footing, firing 9.0 innings of three-run ball, ceding five hits and four walks and picking up 10 strikeouts.

ABOUT DEVIN									

-In the summer of 2015, Smeltzer played collegiate summer baseball for the Hyannis Harbor Hawks of the Cape Cod Baseball League, where he was co-MVP of the league's all-star game, and tossed a nine-inning no-hitter in which he missed a perfect game by a single walk.

-The San Diego Padres selected him in the 33rd round of the 2014 MLB draft, but he chose to enroll at Florida Gulf Coast University to play college baseball for the Florida Gulf Coast Eagles rather than sign with the Padres.

After one year with the Eagles, Smeltzer transferred to San Jacinto College, so that he would become eligible in the 2016 MLB draft. Smeltzer had a 9-3 record and a 1.18 ERA with 128 strikeouts in 91.2 innings pitched for San Jacinto's baseball team.

-Smeltzer committed to transfering to Texas Tech after his sophomore year, but the Los Angeles Dodgers selected Smeltzer in the fifth round of the 2016 MLB draft. He signed with the Dodgers rather than transferring to Texas Tech, and received a \$500,000 signing bonus.

2022 SEASON

-The Twins promoted Smeltzer back to the major leagues on May 14, 2022.[18] On October 11, Smeltzer was sent outright to Triple-A and chose to elect free agency and landed in lacksonville.

2021 SEASON

-On July 17, 2021, Smeltzer was placed on the 60-day injured list with left elbow inflammation.Smeltzer made one appearance for the Twins in 2021 and was outrighted off of the 40-man roster on November 19, 2021.

2020 SEASON

-Smeltxer made Twins Opening Day roster, the first of his career.

-Four of six relief appearances were of 2.0 innings-or-more. Went 0-0, 4.15 ERA (4.1 IP, 2 ER) in one start and 2-0, 7.71 ERA (11.2 IP, 10 ER) in six relief appearances. Held right-handed batters to a .269 average and left-handed batters to a .385 (5-for-13) average.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Smeltzer ttended Bishop Eustace Preparatory School in Pennsauken, NJ before pitching two seasons at San Jacinto College in Houston, TX.

-Smeltzer had his picture posted on the school's Wall of Legends.
