JUMBO SHRIMP OVERPOWER KNIGHTS 9-2

Jacksonville smacked four home runs to beat Charlotte 9-2 in Tuesday's series opener. Lorenzo Quintana opened up the scoring with a three-run bomb in the first inning. Two batters later. Willians Astudillo socked a solo shot to make it 4-0. A Norel González RBI single in the third and Peyton Burdick RBI double in the fourth widened thee gap to 6-1. JJ Bleday led off the fifth with a bomb and González also went yard in the frame to make it 8-1. González later scored on an error in the eighth to set the margin at 9-2. Braxton Garrett yielded just one run in 5.0 innings to earn the win.

SFLF-STARTERS

Through the season's first 10 games, Jacksonville starting pitchers ceded at least four runs on six different outings, posting a collective 7.85 ERA in the process. Over the last nine games, though, Jumbo Shrimp starters have yielded more than two earned runs in a start just once. In total during this run. the Jumbo Shrimp starting rotation has surrendered just 13 runs, nine earned, in 43.1 innings for a 1.04 ERA. During this nine-game run, the club's lid-lifters have registered 33 strikeouts (6.9 K/9) against 36 hits (7.5 H/9) and 17 walks (3.5 BB/9) allowed.

CHARLES LE MAGNIFIQUE

Charles Leblanc went 1-for-3 with a walk on Tuesday, continuing a fantastic start to 2022. The Laval, Quebic City native has already registered multiple hits in six of his 15 games this year, and on the season, ranks fourth in the International League in batting average (.364). He also places fifth in on-base percentage (.446) and OPS (1.082), sixth in slugging percentage (.636), tied for 11th in both hits (20) and home runs (4) and tied for 16th in RBIs (13).

MEN OF STEAL

Heading into play on April 17. Jacksonville had stolen just four bases, tied for the third-fewest in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp swiped five bases in Durham that night, matching the franchise's most in any game since the Jacksonville Suns swiped six bases on April 10, 2016 against Birmingham. In the eight games from April 17 on, the Jumbo Shrimp have collected 15 stolen bases, marking the second-most in Triple-A. Jacksonville has been caught only three times during this stretch, a success rate of 83.3 percent.

THE WHOLE NINE WINS The Jumbo Shrimp have won nine of the past 10 games, outscoring their opponents during this stretch by a whopping 73-30 margin and compiling a 106-65 advantage in hits and 17-3 margin in home runs. Since this roll began on April 15, the Jumbo Shrimp are hitting .301/.388/.509/.897 as a team and rank tied for third out of 120 Minor League Baseball teams in hits, tied for fifth in home runs and sixth in hits. The club's 30 runs allowed is tied for sixth-fewest in MiLB during this span, with Jacksonville's 2.35 team ERA placing third.

THIS CUBAN IS CRUSHING MISSILES

Over his last seven games, Lorenzo Quintana has gone 13-for-30 at the plate, slashing .433/.500/.967/1.467 with four doubles, four home runs, 13 RBIs and nine runs scored. This hot stretch has pushed Quintana up the International League leaderboards on the season; the native of Pinar del Rio in Cuba ranks in the top 15 of the league in home runs (2nd; 5), RBIs (5th; 17), slugging (5th; 683), OPS (6th; 1.077), extra-base hits (T-6th; 10), batting average (7th; .350), hits (T-7th; 21) and runs scored (T-13th; 13). Of the 132 qualified hitters in the International League, Quintana has posted the ninth-lowest strikeout rate (12.1 percent) behind the 33rdlowest swinging-strike rate (9.2 percent). He places fifth in both wOBA (.459) and wRC+ (162).

THE CHICKS DIG IT

Jacksonville has popped 27 home runs thus far in 2022, ranking fifth in the International League. The home run power the Jumbo Shrimp have shown has been a rarity for teams on the First Coast in recent years: no Jacksonville team has finished outside the bottom 10 in either Triple-A (2021) or Double-A (2014-19) in home runs since 2013. when the Jacksonville Suns bashed 104 bombs to place 14th in Double-A. In fact, the last time a Jacksonville club ranked in the top 10 of its level in long balls was 2009, when the Suns cracked 110 homers.

SHRIMP SPECKS

lacksonville has scored at least six runs in eight of their last 11 games, and 10 of the club's 19 contests this year. In 2021. the Jumbo Shrimp mustered at least six tallied in only 48 of their 130 games (36.9 percent).

2021 SEASON

-With the bases empty, opponents hit .234 (59-for-252) with a .740 OPS. However, with runners in scoring position, Lindgren buckled down for a .211 (16-for-76) opponents' average and .598 OPS.

-Lindgren got off to slower starts in 2021; in the first and second innings, opponents batted .290 (43-for-148). However, in the third and fourth innings, often his second time through the order, Lindgren held opposing hitters to a .183 (25-for-136).

-When Lindgren got hitters in a 1-2 hole, they were just 7-for-71 (.099) against him with 33 strikeouts.

Interestingly, when Lindgren was pitching from behind on the scoreboard, he performed better, holding opponents to a .176 (24-for-136) average. When his team led, opposing hitters collected a .241 (27-for-112) average.

2019 SEASON

-With High-A Jupiter, lefties hit .297 with a .680 OPS against Lindgren. However, he held right-handed hitters to a .176 average with a .432 OPS.

-With the bases empty, opponents hit .275 (11-for-40) against Lindgren with a .626 OPS. With runners in scoring position, Lindgren limited opposing batters to .194 (6-for-31) with a .508 OPS. Total, with runners on, Lindgren posted a .188 (9-for-48) batting average against with an OPS of .471.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-At Centennial High School (Champaign, Ill.), Lindgren competed in both baseball and basketball. He served as the baseball team captain, helped win two regional championships and one sectional championship.
