TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves conclude a six-game home series against the Montgomery Biscuits at Trustmark Park. This is the first of five series between the two clubs, who will meet a total of 30 times. They will meet 18 times at Trustmark Park and 12 times at Riverwalk

- ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The M-Braves snapped an eight-game losing streak with a doubleheader split, headlined by Jacob Pearson's walk-off grand slam in game two.
- In game one, the Biscuits shutout the M-Braves 2-0. RHP Sean Hunley pitched five innings of two-hit ball, and LHP Jeff Belge pitched the final two innings.
- In game two, the M-Braves won 6-2 in extra innings on Jacob Pearson's grand slam. The game was tied 2-2 after seven innings. In a wild third inning, Montgomery scored two runs after a dropped third strike and an RBI double from Alika Williams. The M-Braves answered with an RBI base hit from Cody Milligan to score an Andrew Moritz triple. Milligan then stole second base and ran to third base on a throwing error. The centerfielder then missed the ball, allowing Milligan to score on the same play.
- Pearson came in as a pinch runner in the seventh inning and came up for the first time in the bottom of the eighth. Pearson's grand slam was his first hit with the M-Braves this season, ending the dugout and M-Braves fans into a frenzy. Pearson was mobbed at home plate.
- THE RETURN OF THE SLUGBAUER: 1B Drew Lugbauer, the M-Braves all-time and single-season home run leader, returns for a third season. Lugbauer entered the season with a club record 46 home runs over two seasons. He hit 18 home runs in 2021 and led the Southern League and Braves minor league system with 28 homers in 2022. On September 9, 2022, he surpassed Ernesto Mejia's (2011) and Mike Hessman's (2001) single-season M-Braves franchise record (26)
- The first baseman currently ranks as Atlanta's No. 29 prospect in Baseball America. He added to his own club record with his 49th M-Braves home run on Saturday at Chattanooga. He has three homers in 2023, tied for third in the Southern League.
- "IT WAS WORTH THE WAIT": Jacob Pearson's grand slam ended an eight-game losing streak, tied for second longest in club history. The walk-off grand slam was the first hit of the season for Pearson, who entered the game in the inning before as a pinch runner.
- The M-Braves lost nine games in a row twice in club history. The M-Braves lost eight games in a row from July 17-25 during the championship-winning season in 2021.
- MILLI ROCK: The versatile OF/IF Cody Milligan has hit in 11 of 13 games. He currently ranks in the top 10 in the Southern League in batting (.333, 5th), OBP (.467, 3rd) hits (16, T-2nd), doubles (6, T-2nd), OPS (.988, 6th), and runs (15, 1st)
- Milligan played in 68 games for the M-Braves last season. He slashed .271/.345/.326 with one home run, 10 doubles, and 21 RBI.
- THE GORDON MOBILE: RHP Tanner Gordon has a 3.00 ERA over 15 innings in three starts this season. He is currently ranked as Atlanta's No. 28 prospect
- Gordon posted the first quality start for the M-Braves this season. He went six innings, allowing two runs, one earned run with a walk and season-high seven strikeouts against Montgomery on April 21.
- "YOU CAN KISS IT GOODBYE": The M-Braves are third in the Southern League with 13 homers. Eight different players have at least one home run with Drew Lugbauer (3), Arden Pabst (2), and Landon Stephens (2) homering multiple times.
- BIG WHEELS KEEP ON TURNING: The M-Braves have already had several roster moves early in the season, with four players being promoted to Triple-A. RHP Kyle Wilcox, RHP Beau Burrows, IF Luke Waddell, C Hendrik Clementina, and LHP Domingo Robles have all been promoted to Gwinnett this sesaon. Robles was transferred back to Double-A Mississippi on Thursday.
