NEWS & NOTES

FRIENDLY CONFINES: The Renegades recently completed a stretch where they played 24 of 36 games away from home. Hudson Valley is currently playing 15 of 24 games at Heritage Financial Park. After hosting Wilmington last week, Hudson Valley will play six games with Brooklyn, split between Coney Island and Wappingers Falls.

SUNDAY SHOWERS: Sunday marked the first postponement at Heritage Financial Park for the Renegades in 2024. Due to inclement weather in the area, the final game between the Renegades and Blue Rocks was postponed, and will be made up as part of a doubleheader on August 22nd. Four games between the Blue Rocks and Renegades have now been postponed this season due to weather. The Renegades have seen six games postponed overall, and one matchup canceled entirely with the Rome Emperors in April.

CONSISTENCY: **Baron Stuart** was tremendous on Tuesday night in Brooklyn, tossing 6.2 scoreless innings while inducing nine groundball outs. The right-hander retired 18 of the last 23 batters he faced, recording his third quality of the season with the Renegades, and fourth overall. Stuart has allowed three earned runs or less in eight of his last nine starts, and has gone 5+ innings in six of his last eight starts.

WALK-OFF MAGIC: Hudson Valley earned their fifth walk-off victory of the season on Saturday night vs. Wilmington. Josh Moylan scored Jace Avina with a walk-off single down the left-field line to secure a 4-3 win. Jace Avina doubled to lead off the bottom of the ninth, and came in to score from third on the Moylan knock. Avina has been on either end of the last two Renegades walk-off wins. He hit a walk-off sacrifice fly on June 16th vs Brooklyn.

FUHGEDDABOUDIT: For the second time this season, the Renegades travel to Coney Island to face the Cyclones. The former NY-Penn League foes play 24 times in the regular season. This week, the first three games of the series will take place in Brooklyn, before the Renegades return home for the final three games of the tilt. Saturday's game will mark the conclusion of a stretch where the two teams are playing 12 of 24 games against one another. In their most recent series in mid-June, the Renegades took four of six games at Heritage Financial Park. However, the Cyclones earned two late come-from-behind wins that week, damaging the Renegades first-half title hopes. In the first series of 2024 between the two foes in May, Brooklyn took four of six on Coney Island. The Renegades did record 16 runs and 18 hits in the third game of the series, recording their second-highest hit total of the season. Omar Martinez had a two-run homer, and Jace Avina was 3-for-5 with three RBIs and three runs scored. In 2023, Brooklyn and Hudson Valley faced off 24 times as well, with the Cyclones taking 14 of 24 matchups from the Renegades.

LEFTY PUNCHOUTS: It was announced Tuesday that **Ben Shields** was called to Double-A Somerset. Since joining the Renegades rotation, Shields has been excellent. On Friday night, he matched his career-high with nine strikeouts in 5.1 scoreless innings. The southpaw didn't allow a hit until the sixth inning, and only allowed two baserunners to reach safely in his entire outing. In his last two starts, Shields has struck out eighteen batters and allowed one run on five hits. Since joining the rotation in the middle of May, the 25-year-old has struck eight or more batters on four separate occasions. Shields has recorded 12.2 K/9 this season.

HE WENT TO JARED: **Jared Serna** continues to be one of the best hitters in the South Atlantic League. The Renegades infielder was 2-for-4 on Wednesday with two RBIs and two runs, which included his 12th home run of the season. Serna ranks in the top 10 in eight hitting categories in the South Atlantic League. His 52 RBIs are tied for the second-most in the SAL, and his 20 doubles are ranked fourth. He is tied for fourth with 48 runs scored, and his 12 long balls are also tied for sixth in the league.

NY SLUGGERS: The Renegades currently have the third-highest team OPS in the South Atlantic League (.741), and have the fourth-best mark in High-A. With 147 doubles in 2024, Hudson Valley has the most doubles in High-A this season, seven more than any other team. Five Renegades have 14 or more doubles, and ten players have seven or more two-baggers.

SUNDAY FUNDAY: **Cam Schlittler** continued his strong pitching on Saturday night vs. the Blue Rocks, allowing just two runs in 4.2 innings and striking out seven batters. Schlittler has struck out six or more batters

in five of his last six starts. His ERA now sits at 2.44 this season through 12 starts, which is the second-best mark in the South Atlantic League. His .172 opposing average is the lowest in the SAL.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER: The Renegades bullpen collectively sports a 3.30 ERA (115 ER/313.1 IP) this season, the second-best mark in High-A. Hudson Valley received 6.1 frames from their pen on Tuesday night. After Sebastian Keane went just 1.2 innings, Luis Arejula, Hueston Morrill, and Mason Vinyard were able to combine to finish the game. Trent Sellers, Eric Reyzelman, and Matt Keating combined to allow just one unearned run in 4.1 innings out of the bullpen on Friday night. **Eric Reyzelman** was called up to Double-A Somerset on Tuesday. The right-hander did not allow a run in his first six career High-A appearances. The Yankees 2022 fifth-round pick allowed just two hits in 9.1 innings while striking out 17 batters.

STELLAR STARTERS: Starting pitching continues to be excellent for the Renegades. Twenty-seven of the last 30 starters have allowed three earned runs or less in their outings. In the last 30 games, 23 starters have gone at least 4.1 innings. On Tuesday, Baron Stuart tossed 6.2 scoreless innings while striking out four; retiring 18 of the last 23 batters he faced.

LIMITING HITS: Hudson Valley pitchers have allowed only 495 hits through 75 games. The Renegades have allowed the fewest hits in MiLB, eight fewer than the Carolina Mudcats (A, MiL). Incredibly, the Amarillo Sod Poodles (AZ, AA) have allowed a staggering 691 hits through 77 games, most among all non-AAA teams.

MIDWEST REINFORCEMENTS: **Jace Avina** debuted with the Renegades on April 17 after being traded to New York for Jake Bauers in November from Milwaukee. The 20-year-old has been crucial all season for the Renegades. Avina is hitting .288 (68-for-236) with 21 doubles, 40 RBIs, 33 runs scored and a .847 OPS in 61 games. His 21 doubles are tied for the most in the South Atlantic League. On Friday vs. Wilmington, Avina was 2-for-4 with a home run, double, walk, and two runs scored. Avina also currently holds a 27-game errorless streak.

INTERNATIONAL OUTREACH: The Hudson Valley Renegades and the Bhutan Baseball & Softball Association have partnered to present Bhutan Night on August 20 at Heritage Financial Park. The team is currently fundraising to bring over several Bhutanese baseball players for baseball and cultural enrichment tour of the Hudson Valley and New York. DEFENSIVE ISSUES: The Renegades have the eighth-most errors in MiLB, with 100 errors in 75 games. Their .963 fielding percentage is tied for fifth-worst in the minors. In three of their last six games, the Renegades played error-free on their way to victories. Hudson Valley is now 17-5 in games this season where they do not commit an error. They lost four games to Greensboro in which they played errorless baseball.

HEATING UP: Renegades infielder **Roc Riggio** has started to swing the bat much better lately. During an 20-game on-base streak, Riggio is 21-for-74, slashing .284/.404/.527 with 12 extra-base hits and a .931 OPS. The Oklahoma State product has a hit in 16 of his last 19 games. His on-base streak is the longest active streak among Renegades players.

POWER SURGE: **Garrett Martin** has been hot at the plate recently. In his last 13 games, Martin is 12-for-43 (.279) with five home runs, three doubles, and a triple. Martin has a .744 slugging percentage and a 1.111 OPS during that stretch. The outfielder hit his seventh home run of the season on Tuesday vs. Brooklyn, his second long ball in three games. Martin has also not committed an error in 39 games in the outfield this season for Hudson Valley.

CAROLINA POP: **Josh Moylan** is having his best stretch of the season at the plate. On Wednesday, Moylan had a nine-game hit streak snapped. It was the longest active streak for a Renegades player, and tied for the second-longest streak in the South Atlantic League. During the streak, Moylan is hitting .452 (14-for-31) with a .742 slugging percentage and a 1.227 OPS. The East Carolina product was hitting .220 on June 19th, and is now hitting .254 this season. Moylan's OPS has also risen from .634 to .719. The infielder has multi-hit games in five of his last seven appearances.

PRESEASON PROSPECT RANKINGS: *Baseball America* - NYY #10; *MLB Pipeline* - NYY #12

LAST TIME OUT: Carr allowed a leadoff home run to Jeremy De La Rosa last Thursday night but settled down afterward to allow just two runs on four hits across 5.1 innings against the Wilmington Blue Rocks. He walked only one and struck out two in his outing. He departed with a runner on base who came in to score against Cole Ayers which put Wilmington up 2-0 at the time. The Blue Rocks eventually took a 7-0 lead in the eighth before a fierce comeback by the Renegades got the score to 7-5, which was the ultimate final.

INJURIES IN SAN DIEGO: Carr spent two years playing at the University of San Diego before transferring to Palomar for 2023. During that time he struggled with injuries including Tommy John surgery in October 2020, and a broken hand and torn right shoulder labrum in 2022. Carr to the San Diego Union-Tribune: "I struggled with injuries and school at USD. And they were related. As I fought my way through the injuries, I let my schoolwork slip. And you can't do that in college. You have to stay on top of your classes. I didn't do that. I loved the coaches and players at USD. [USD head coach] Brock Ungricht is one of the really good guys, my favorite all-time coach. I felt I let him down."

POWER PITCHING: Carr opened eyes at Palomar with a fastball that touches 97 mph, a sharp-breaking slider and a mid-80s power changeup. Scouts registered his velocity as continuing to sit at 95 late into games. Carr: "The biggest thing for me is that I'm finally healthy ... That hasn't always been the case. I've always been able to throw hard, but now as I've matured, I've been able to keep my stuff late into games."

- 5/3 @ Wilmington: 4.0 IP, 9 H, 9 R, 6 ER, 2 BB, 2 K -> t:2nd-most runs allowed in a game by a Renegades starting pitcher in the Portal Era (2005-present). Most since RHP Juan Carela allowed 9 R on 4/29/23 @ Greenville.

PERSONAL:

- Full name is Kyle Isiah Carr.
- Pitched one season at Palomar College (2023) after spending two seasons at the University of San Diego (2021-22).
- Underwent Tommy John surgery in October 2020 after graduating from high school, also broke his hand in February 2022 while at San Diego, then tore his right (non-pitching) labrum in March 2022 while swinging a bat.
- Had committed to play at TCU following his graduation from Palomar, but signed with the Yankees instead. TCU had recruited him out of high school, but he decided to stay home in Southern California. When he transferred to Palomar, TCU was one of the first schools to reach out.
- Was named ABCA West Region Pitcher of the Year and the ABCA Pitcher of the Year after going 12-1 with a 2.31 ERA (78.0 IP, 20 ER) in 15 games (14 starts) for the Palomar Comets in 2023.
- At San Diego was a two-way player who mostly pitched, going 2-for-14 at the bat in 2022.
- Graduated from San Marcos HS in 2020, where as a two-way player he hit over .400 in his last two seasons.
