Last Night: Lugnuts 8, Wizards 2. Athletics top pitching prospect Luis Morales earned his first professional win, striking out eight batters while scattering four hits and a walk in five innings, and Will Simpson launched his third home run of the season in an easy Lugnuts victory on Thursday night. Luis Carrasco tossed three scoreless innings of relief and Euribiel Ángeles led a 12-hit attack by going 3-for-5 with three singles.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play the TinCaps through Sunday, then return home for a six-game series against the Peoria Chiefs from May 28-June 2.

Scar at the Helm: Lansing is managed this series by Steve Scarsone, replacing second-year manager Craig Conklin during Conklin's prescheduled week-long break. Scarsone was drafted by the Phillies in the second round in 1986 from Santa Ana College, rising through the ranks to play seven years and 350 games in the Majors with Philly, Baltimore, San Francisco, St. Louis and Kansas City. He managed in the Midwest League with South Bend in 2001 and Kane County in 2009. Scarsone's current title within the A's system is Minor League Outfield and Base Running Coordinator, a position he has held since 2020. He also served as interim manager last season, skippering the Lugnuts to a six-game split at Quad Cities, July 25-30.

Shrimp! 2022 Lugnuts C/1B Tyler Soderstrom delivered a pinch-hit walk-off walk to beat Colorado vesterday, as the A's scored five runs in the bottom of the 11th for a 10-9 victory. Fellow former Lugnut Joey Estes struck out six while walking none in seven innings in a no-decision.

Fireworks: The Lugnuts have scored the most runs in the Midwest League (235) and have the second-most hits (362), but have also allowed the most hits (403) and runs (255) in the league.

Pride of Palo Alto: 20-year-old Henry Bolte, the youngest player on the team, was named the Midwest League Player of the Week for the week of May 13-18 and a member of Minor League Baseball's Prospect Team of the Week after going 10-for-22 (.455/.586/1.000) with four doubles, one triple, two homers, six walks, nine runs scored, seven runs batted in, and four steals against Lake County.

Others of Note: Closer Colton Johnson is tied for 1st in the Midwest League with 16 appearances and tied for 3rd with five saves. Colby Halter is 2nd in walks (30); Brayan Buelvas is tied for 1st in extra-base hits (21), tied for 2nd in doubles (12), tied for 3rd in triples (3), tied for 3rd in walks (29), tied for 3rd in runs (34) and tied for 8th in RBIs (30); and Will Simpson is tied for 3rd in walks (29), 4th in OBP (.451), 8th in average (.322) and 9th in slugging (.529).

Welcome Back: Euribiel Ángeles, a member of the 2021 TinCaps, opened the year 1-for-22, but is 44-for-132 since, a .333 clip. He is tied for 5th in the league in hits (45), tied for 2nd in RBIs (35, 23 in May alone) and tied for 1st in triples (4).

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster includes four MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in pitcher Luis Morales (No. 2), outfielder Henry Bolte (No. 10), first baseman Will Simpson (No. 27) and southpaw Will Johnston (No. 30). In Eric Longenhagen's Top 32 A's prospects for Fangraphs, he gives a nod to Morales at No. 3, Simpson at No. 28 and Johnston at No. 32. Keith Law placed Morales at No. 7 and Bolte at No. 17, giving a nod to Morales as his sleeper prospect of the organization.

### **Today in Lugnuts History**

**2009:** An hour and 46 minutes for a nine-inning game?! Yes indeed. The Lugnuts' Henderson Álvarez (7 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 4 K) and the Cedar Rapids Kernels' Will Smith (8 IP, 5 H, 6 K) breezed right through a 1-0 Kernels victory in Cedar Rapids. The game featured zero walks and a combined seven runners left on base.

**2017:** With time running out due to intensifying rainstorms that progressed from an early mist in the early innings to a steady drizzle in the middle innings to utterly pouring by the end, the Lugnuts rallied for two runs in the bottom of the seventh to beat Lake County (who were furious that the game wasn't called sooner), 5-4. Broadcaster Jesse Goldberg-Strassler called the game from The Outfield apartment complex and was thoroughly drenched. Justin Maese set a career high with 12 strikeouts in seven innings, his league-leading third complete game of the year (6 IP, 7 IP, 9 IP).

**Hometown Hero:** Home city of Rocky Gap, Virginia, is in the Ridge-and-Valley Appalachians, located near the West Virginia border... neighboring city: Bluefield, home of the Bluefield Ridge Runners, previously known as the Bluefield Orioles and Bluefield Blue Jays, which fed such stars as Alejandro Kirk and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. to the Lugnuts when both were part of the Jays' system... cousin is Jason Michaels, who played 11 years (2001-2011) in MLB.

**Glory Days:** Starred for the Bland County HS Rockets as an all-state baseball player as well as in basketball (where he regularly posted double-doubles and topped out at 45 points in one game) and football.

**Off to College:** Did not receive much notice before his high velocity was discovered at a tryout in Morgantown... named to the Academic All-Big 12 Rookie Team as a freshman (5 G, 4.70 ERA, 7 2/3 IP, 4 R, 6 BB, 11 K)... as a sophomore, made 19 appearances: 3.33 ERA, 27 IP, 15 H, 11 R, 32 BB, bullpen-leading 53 K, .165 avg. allowed, tied for team lead with four saves; named Academic All-Big 12 Second Team; NCBWA Stopper of the Year Midseason Watch List... made first college start in the 2021 Big 12 Championship vs. Texas: 3 IP, 0 H, 1 R, 4 BB, 8 K... as a junior in 2022, named preseason All-American; dominated early as team closer and was moved into role as Friday starter; struck out 15 Texas Longhorns in 6 1/3 IP on May 7; overall: 18 G, 11 GS, 3-7, 6.22 ERA, 59 1/3 IP, 64 H, 44 R, 41 BB, 75 K; named All-Big 12 Honorable Mention.

**Entering Draft Day:** Rated Keith Law's No. 68 draft prospect for The Athletic, with Law writing, "Watters started the year in the Mountaineers' bullpen, where he hit 99 mph a few times, so the team moved him to the rotation around midseason, where he struggled more with control (37 walks in 50.2 innings) but also showed enough that some scouts think he can start in pro ball. Watters sits 94-97 mph with a power slider in the mid-80s that can miss bats ... when he locates it. It's not a bad delivery, with a reasonably short arm stroke and strong finish, so that's not the reason he doesn't throw strikes, but it's true across all of his pitches. It's much more likely he ends up a power reliever with two plus pitches. But with enough of a changeup to start and a delivery that looks like it should work, I wouldn't be surprised to see a pro team keep him in the rotation."... Fangraphs' No. 96 draft prospect.

Inked: Selected 124th overall by the A's in the 4th round and signed for \$491,750... highest pitcher taken by the Athletics in 2022 (following first-round catcher Daniel Susac and three straight outfielders in high schooler Henry Bolte in the second round, Clark Elliott in the compensatory round B, and Colby Thomas in the third round).

**WVU to the Pros:** First of three Mountaineers selected in the 2022 draft... the Fort Wayne TinCaps have featured two WVU teammates in Jackson Wolf and Ryan Berger; pitched against Bergert on May 26, 2023, and tossed 5 2/3 scoreless innings, allowing only one hit... the last WVU player taken in the first round was Alek Manoah by Toronto in 2019, who in 2022 joined John Means as the only Mountaineers to be named MLB All-Stars... the last West Virginia player to suit up for the Lugnuts was Ryan McBroom, who won the 2015 Midwest League Most Valuable Player award.
