History vs. Wisconsin

The Lugnuts are 88-62 all-time vs. the Timber Rattlers, 44-25 at home and 44-37 in Appleton, Wisconsin.

The two clubs did not meet up in 2021 nor in 2024. In 2022, the Nuts won four of six in Appleton, a series that saw the MWL debut of A's closer Mason Miller.

In 2023, the Nuts and T-Rats split a six-game series, made memorable by Jack Winkler's cycle on June 21. That remains the Lugnuts' most recent cycle.

Today: Riding a four-game winning streak, the Lansing Lugnuts play a doubleheader against the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers, the only meetings of the year between the two teams. The Athletics' No. 13 and No. 12 prospects respectively, **Gage Jump** and **Steven Echavarria**, start for the Lugnuts against Milwaukee Brewers rehabber **Brandon Woodruff** and right-hander **Chandler Welch**. Each game is set for seven innings.

Last Night: Lugnuts 4, Timber Rattlers 3. **Jadher Areinamo** capped a T-Rats comeback from 3-0 down with a game-tying home run in the 8th, but **Clark Elliott** opened the 9th with a triple and scored on a **Jeferson Figueroa** balk to lift the Lugnuts to a third straight win in the series and a fourth straight victory overall.

On Deck: The Lugnuts and T-Rats play a doubleheader tomorrow and a matinee Saturday to wrap up the series, then the Nuts head home to play 12 games in 13 days.

WWW: The Lugnuts' four-game winning streak is their longest winning streak since July 11-14, 2024. The last time the Nuts won five straight games, it was August 10-14, 2022. The last time Lansing won six straight games: August 4-10, 2018. (The 2018 Lugnuts were wild, with both a nine-game winning streak and a nine-game losing streak en route to an overall record of 80-60 and the franchise's most recent playoff appearance.)

Consistency: **Jared Dickey** and **Rodney Green, Jr.** enter today on 10-game on-base streaks, while **Clark Elliott** has reached base in nine straight games. The longest hitting streak belongs to **Nate Nankil**, who has at least one base hit in his last nine games, slugging his first home run of the season yesterday.

Consecutive: Speaking of that Nankil home run, his back-to-back roundtrippers with **Darlyn Montero** in the 4th inning yesterday marked the first time the Nuts hit back-to-back home runs since **Jake Suddleson** and **William Simoneit** accomplished the feat at Fort Wayne on May 22, 2021.

Best in the League: Lansing's offense ranks 1st in the Midwest League in batting average (.260), base hits (106), fewest strikeouts (82) and on-base percentage (.384).

Leaderboard: **Rodney Green, Jr.** is tied for the Midwest League lead in home runs (4), tied for 3rd in runs scored (10), and 7th in total bases (23). **Nate Nankil** is tied for 3rd in RBIs (12) and tied for 5th in base hits (14), while ranking 6th in batting average (.333). **Jared Dickey** is tied for 6th in walks (11), ranks 6th in on-base percentage (.468) and is 8th in batting average (.314). **T.J. Schofield-Sam** is 10th in batting average (.313). **Clark Elliott** is tied for 2nd in triples (2).

Alumni Report: Athletics first baseman **Tyler Soderstrom**, who spent the 2022 season in Lansing, leads the Major Leagues with nine home runs and is tied for 2nd in total bases (52) and ranks 2nd in slugging (.712), 4th in OPS (1.095), tied for 5th in RBIs (18) and tied for 6th in runs scored (17). 2017 Lugnut **Bo Bichette** is tied for 3rd in the Majors in base hits (25) and tied for 3rd in doubles (8).

103 Miles South: While the A's and Brewers' High-A affiliates battle here in Appleton, the Athletics and Brewers start up their own three-game series at American Family Field tonight at 7:10 p.m.

Prospecting: The Nuts boast the A's second, third, fourth and fifth selections in the 2024 draft: slugging third baseman **Tommy White** (40th overall), southpaw starter **Gage Jump** (73rd), shortstop **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer** (75th) and outfielder **Rodney Green, Jr.** (104th). White is rated the A's No. 7 prospect, Kuroda-Grauer is No. 10, Jump is No. 13 and Green is No. 19. The Lugnuts also have 19-year-old **Steven Echavarria**, rated No. 12, and outfielder **Nate Nankil**, who is No. 29.

DK at the Helm: The 19th manager in Lugnuts history is **Darryl Kennedy**, entering his second year in the A's organization. Kennedy distinguished himself as a catcher at Manatee Community College before starring at the University of North Florida and was named an NCAA All-American in 1991 en route to North Florida's Hall of Fame, inducted in 2017.

APRIL 18TH IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2014: Kendall Graveman, who would eventually go from Lansing on Opening Day to Toronto by the end of the season, pitched 8 1/3 no-hit innings at Beloit before No. 9 hitting catcher Jose Chavez reached on an iffy infield single to shortstop. Griffin Murphy relieved Graveman and allowed a single to Chih Fang Pan before wrapping up a Lugnuts 5-0 victory with a double play, ending the Nuts' seven-game losing streak.

2019: The Golden Cycle! Ryan Gold went 4-for-5 with a first-inning single, a third-inning two-run triple, a fourth-inning RBI groundout, a sixth-inning grand slam, and – after Dayton third baseman Juan Martinez dropped a foul pop – an eighth-inning double, becoming the seventh Lugnut to hit for the cycle in franchise history in a 12-4 victory over the Dragons at Cooley Law School Stadium.

Gage Jump joined **Trystan Magnuson** as the only Lugnuts in franchise history to make their pro debut as the Opening Day starter. The 6-foot-7 Canadian southpaw was drafted 56th overall in 2007 from Louisville. Pitching in Fort Wayne on Opening Day, April 3, 2008, Magnuson allowed a two-run homer in the first inning to Angel Mercado, allowed three runs total in 1 2/3 innings and took the L in a 7-1 Nuts loss to the Wizards. He finished the season 0-9 with a 5.40 ERA in 81 2/3 innings, was traded by Toronto to Oakland with Danny Farquhar for Rajai Davis on November 17, 2010, and made nine appearances for the A's in the Major Leagues in 2011. According to his wikipedia page, Magnuson "now works as a mechanical engineer in the automotive industry."

Background: Jump starred at JSerra Catholic H.S., which also produced Royce Lewis and former TinCaps catcher Austin Hedges... he was rated California's No. 1 LHP and No. 5 prospect, the nation's No. 5 LHP, and No. 41 draft prospect... drafted in the 18th round by San Diego, but declined Padres' offer... began his college track at UCLA, making seven appearances as a freshman 2022 before he was shut down due to injury; missed all of 2023 after undergoing Tommy John surgery... transferred to LSU, saying "I just wanted to be in the SEC"... his older brother Hunter, an outfielder, had played SEC ball in 2022 for Kentucky after transferring from Arizona State... spent one season with Bayou Bengals: 6-2, 3.47, 17 G/15 GS, 83 IP, 22 BB, 101 K, .218 avg. ... No. 8 in SEC in ERA and opp. avg. ... named to SEC All-Tournament Team after shutting down Georgia on four hits and one run in seven innings, whiffing seven... 7-IP CG at Missouri, April 19: 3 H, 1 R, 14 K.
