FROM THE CROWS NEST

THIS DAY IN MARAUDERS HISTORY: On this day in 2023, former Pittsburgh Pirates No. 1 overall draft pick Paul Skenes made his Marauders debut against the Lakeland Flying Tigers. In one inning of work, the 2024 All-Star pitcher threw 16 pitches (11 strikes) while striking out two and allowing one hit as Bradenton went on to win 14-13 in a wild one.

ON A ROLL: Since coming off the injured list on August 2, **LHP Michael Kennedy** has been superb in his three starts. The southpaw sports a 1.38 ERA after only allowing two earned runs on five hits while striking out 14 and only walking two in 13.0 innings. Opponents are hitting just 116 off him in August

THOU SHALL NOT PASS: RHP Danny Carrion tossed two more scoreless innings on Wednesday night to run his scoreless innings streak up to nine innings. Over his last five plus outings, Carrion has allowed just two hits while striking out eight. The 2023 9th round pick has lowered his season ERA from 5.40 to 3.26.

FLASH: Justin Miknis is riding a season-long 12-game on-base streak after recording two hits on Tuesday night against Dunedin. During this streak, Miknis is hitting .206/.400/.324 with a double, HR, 11 walks, and five runs scored. It's the third-longest active streak in the Florida State League right now.

TOP OF THE TABLE: Bradenton's pitching staff found their form once again during the last week. Over the last eight games, Bradenton has allowed just 23 earned runs in 71.0 innings which is good for a 2.92 ERA, the second-best in the Florida State League and eighth-best in Single-A. The Charleston Riverdogs (TB) lead the way with a 0.47 ERA during this span.

CURSE REVERSED: With a win on Friday night, the Bradenton Marauders clinched their first road series victory of the season. Bradenton had split a pair of road trips in June in Clearwater and Dunedin. Their previous road series victory came in their last in the 2023 season when they won four out of six in Fort Myers.

GRAND SALAMI: C Derek Berg's first professional home run came on an inside-the-park grand slam on Thursday night in Port St. Lucie. For the Marauders, it's their second inside-the-park grand slam this year, with the other coming from **Esmerlyn Valdez** against the Mets at LECOM Park on May 10. Bradenton has five grand slams this year, which is the second-most in Single-A and tied for the 10th-most in all of Minor League Baseball.

AMONG LEAGUE LEADERS: The Marauders hold four of the top nine home run leaders in the Florida State League, with **Esmerlyn Valdez** leading the way in second with 17 longballs. **Axiel Plaz** is currently in third with 15, **Javier Rivas** is in eighth with 11 and **Shalin Polanco** is tied for ninth with 10. Valdez is one just HR shy of tying league leader in Ariel Almonte (Daytona). The 17 HR hit by a Valdez are the second-most by a Marauder since the Florida State League was moved from High-A to Low-A. Rodolfo Nolasco hit 20 bombs last year for Bradenton to lead the way.

BOMBS AWAY: Since May 1st, the Bradenton Marauders have clubbed 86 home runs in 88 games which is the most by any team in Single-A. Bradenton led Single-A with 31 longballs in the month of June and were just three shy of tying their franchise record. In July, Bradenton racked up 26 in 22 games with Axiel Plaz and Esmerlyn Valdez accounting for 12 of the 26. The 26 home runs were the third-most in Single-A in July, trailing the Inland Empire 66ers who had 29.
