JACKSONVILLE WINS FIFTH STRAIGHT GAME

Jakob Marsee homered and the Jumbo Shrimp scored four runs in the sixth en route to an 8-5 win over the Knights. Marsee's shot and Devvison De Los Santos' sacrifice fly in the first put Jacksonville ahead, but Charlotte scored once in the second and another time in the third to even the score. With the same score in the fifth, a wild pitch coupled with an error allowed Andrew Pintar to score all the way from first. The four-run sixth and Agustín Ramírez's RBI double in the seventh made it 8-2. The Knights plated three in the eighth to set the final margin. Jacksonville's bullpen worked 8.0 innings, yielding only two runs, one earned.

HIGH FIVE!

Thanks to Thursday's 8-5 victory over Charlotte, Jacksonville has won five games in a row - their longest winning streak since a five-game winning streak from June 7-12 of last season. Should the Jumbo Shrimp win again Friday, it would be the club's longest winning streak since an eight-game roll from August 4-12, 2023. All five victories on Jacksonville's current winning streak have come at home.

THE TWO TOWERS

After winning two of three in Nashville, the Jumbo Shrimp took four of six contests against Worcester. Thus, this marks just the fourth time since 2005 (2009, 2013, 2021) that the club started a season with consecutive series victories. Each of those prior three teams had winning records, with the 2009 squad going 82-58 (.586) en route to a Southern League championship, the 2013 Jacksonville Suns posting a 73-63 (.537) mark and the 2021 team going 75-55 (.577). Only the 2021 Jumbo Shrimp won each of their first three sets of the season, starting 13-5 (.722). One more Jacksonville victory in this set against Charlotte would mean three straight set triumphs to begin 2025.

BOOM OR BUST

With little in-between thus far in 2025, Jacksonville's offense has either been extraordinary or has really struggled depending on the game. In three of their 10 contests thus far, the Jumbo Shrimp have plated double-digit runs - something they accomplished only 10 times in 149 games last season. However, in their other eight contests, Jacksonville has plated a total of 17 runs.

MEN OF STEAL

After failing to steal a base in the 2025 season opener, Jacksonville has recorded multiple stolen bases in 10 of their last 11 games. In fact, the Jumbo Shrimp have recorded two games with five stolen bases (March 29 at Nashville, April 5 vs. Worcester, April 9 vs. Charlotte), a mark the club reached only twice in the prior three seasons. Jacksonville currently leads Triple-A with 35 stolen bases; second-place Omaha's 23 steals is closer to 12th place (Las Vegas, Norfolk, Round Rock: 12) than they are to the Jumbo Shrimp, Moreover. Jakob Marsee's 12 stolen bases are double the two players tied in second with six walks. That 12-steal figure is also egual to or more than the totals for 20 Triple-A teams.

'PEN PALS

Jacksonville starting pitchers have gone at least 5.0 innings just five times in 12 games. The club's bullpen has responded to the added responsibility in a huge way. Jumbo Shrimp relief pitching has combined for a 2.07 ERA, the best such mark in Triple-A. The club's bullpen also ranks first in the level in strikeouts (78), third in batting average against (.172) and eighth in fewest hits allowed (37). Jumbo Shrimp relievers have combined to toss 61.0 innings through 12 games (5.1 per game), third-most in Triple-A and the most in the International League.

MAXIMO OVERDRIVE

Jumbo Shrimp infielder Maximo Acosta is off to an absurd start to the 2025 season. In 12 games thus far, the native of Caracas, Venezuela has recorded five multi-hit contests and two multi-RBI affairs. Acosta is 15-for-46 in total at the plate, slashing .326/.426/.435/.861 with two doubles, one home run, six RBIs, eight walks, nine runs scored and five stolen bases. He is second in the IL in hits (15), tied for fourth in steals (5), tied for seventh in runs (9), tied for 11th in walks (8), 15th in batting average (.326) and 22nd in OBP (.426).

SHRIMP BITES

Jumbo Shrimp starters rank first in Triple-A in fewest walks (6), second in batting average against (.183), fourth in FRA (2.49) and fifth in fewest hits allowed (31) Agustín Ramírez's seven extra-base hits are tied for second in the IL... Jakob Marsee and Jacob Berry each ranked tied for sixth in walks (nine).

ABOUT FREDDY

-A two-way player at Riverview High School (Fla.), Tarnok went 7-0 with a 0.66 ERA while also batting .393. He was selected by the Braves in the third round, signing with Atlanta to bypass a commitment to the University of Tampa.

-Tarnok made his major league debut for the Braves on August 17, 2022, pitching 0.2 scoreless innings in a 9-7 loss to the New York Mets in Atlanta. His first big league strikeout came at the expense of Tyler Naquin.

-On December 12, 2022, the Oakland Athletics acquired Tarnok from the Braves in a three-team trade in which the Atlanta Braves received Sean Murphy, the Milwaukee Brewers acquired William Contreras, Joel Payamps, and Justin Yeager, and the Athletics also acquired Manny Piña, Kyle Muller, Esteury Ruiz, and Royber Salinas.

-The Philadelphia Phillies claimed Tarnok off waivers on June 1, 2024. Following the 2024 season, he signed a minor league contract with the Miami Marlins.

-In seven starts, Tarnok was 0-2 with a 3.65 ERA (12.1 IP, 13 H, 3 BB, 15 K, .283 BAA). However, over 16 relief appearances, he posted an 0-3 record and 9.78 ERA (19.1 IP, 21 H, 17 BB, 21 K, .280 BAA).

2023 SEASON

-Tarnok held left-handed batters to a .192/.276/.269/.545 line in 58 plate appearances compared to a .184/.333/.447/.780 line for right-handed hitters over 93 plate appearances.
