TODAY'S GAMES: Leading the Isotopes 2-1 in the series, the Space Cowboys continue their series against the Isotopes. Sugar Land will play as the 'Dulces de Sugar Land' against the 'Mariachis de Nuevo Mexico' on Cinco de Mayo.

ABOUT THURSDAY AFTERNOON: In a contest that saw 29 combined runs and 36 combined hits, Sugar Land topped Albuquerque 16-13. Bligh Madris and JJ Matijevec hit back to back homers in the first, and after the Isotopes scored four in the bottom of the first to take a lead, Sugar Land struck back for two in the second to take the lead for good. The big blow came in the seventh on a grand slam from Justin Dirden, which at the time made it 14-7.

TAXI: RHP JP France was added to the Houston Astros taxi squad on Friday. If France makes an appearance with Houston, it will be his Major League Debut after 99 career minor league outings. France was recognized as the Pacific Coast League Pitcher of the Week of the Week of April 18 through 24.

ROSTER MOVES: RHP Cesar Gomez transferred to Sugar Land from Corpus Christi... RHP Franny Cobos transferred to Sugar Land from Corpus Christi... RHP JP France added to Houston's taxi squad... INF Bryan Arias & RHP Shawn Dubin placed on the 7-Day IL, retro to 5/4... LHP Nick Allgeyer acquired from the Phillies and assigned to Sugar Land

HOME GROWN TALENT: Sugar Land's roster has 13 players drafted by the Astros, 4 international signings and 2 players signed as non-drafted free agents in the five-round 2020 MLB Draft.

PROSPECTING: The Space Cowboys active roster boasts six of the Astros Top 30 Prospects according to MLB Pipeline. They include C Korey Lee (#5), OF Pedro León (#6), OF Justin Dirden (#7), INF Joe Perez (#14), RHP Forrest Whitley (#19), RHP Shawn Dubin (#23)

YOUR FAVORITE UNCLE: Astros' OF Michael Brantley began a rehab assignment with the Space Cowboys on 4/23. Brantley is returning from right-shoulder surgery in August. On Tuesday night, Brantley reached base in each of his four times up, doubling twice and scoring four runs.

MATIJEVIC'S CAREER NIGHT: On Tuesday, 5/2 @ Albuquerque, INF JJ Matijevec re-wrote the Sugar Land Space Cowboys record books, going 5-for-6 with a double, 2 triples, 8 RBI and 2 runs scored. Since the Sugar Land franchise joined the affiliated ranks, Matijevec is the first player to record five hits in a game, surpassing the 17 times a player had registered four hits in a game, most recently done by... Matijevec on 4/5/23 vs. RR. His 8 RBI also establish a new single-game franchise record for Sugar Land, overtaking the 7 RBI recorded by Lewis Brinson on 8/3/22 @ LV. Matijevec also recorded two triples, the first player to record two three-baggers in single game.

For Matijevec, it was his first five-hit game of his career, passing his previous high of 4 hits on 6/21/21 @ ELP and the most RBI in a game for Matijevec in his career, surpassing his 5 RBI on 7/2/19 with Corpus Christi @ Frisco.

GRAND DAY FOR DIRDEN: Outfielder Justin Dirden had a career day on Thursday against ABQ, going 4-for-5 with 3 doubles, a grand slam, 6 RBI and 2 runs scored... The six RBI are a new career high for Dirden, who had previously registered 5 RBI on 8/27/22 @ LV... It was also the third 4-hit game of his career, tying his career high. The former SEMO Redhawk also tied two single-game Space Cowboys franchise records with three doubles and four extra-base hits.

AGAINST ABQ: Sugar Land is 33-19 all-time against the Isotopes, including 18-12 at Isotopes Park... In 2022, the Space Cowboys went 18-13 during the season vs. Albuquerque and 8-7 at Isotopes Park.

DOUBLE, DOUBLE: On Thursday afternoon, the Space Cowboys pounded out 9 doubles, a new single-game franchise record. That surpassed the previous high of 6 doubles in a 9-inning game, done six previous times, last on 8/13/22 @ El Paso, AND 8 doubles done in an extra-innings game (11 innings) on 7/18/2021 at Oklahoma City. Additionally, three players recorded multiple doubles, with Justin Dirden hitting three while Grae Kessinger and Michael Sandle each hit two.

MADRIS MAGIC: Bligh Madris is currently on a 20-game on-base streak for Sugar Land (.299/.426, 32-77, 17 BB), the longest of the year for any Space Cowboys' player. His on-base streak is the fourth longest streak in the Pacific Coast League this season (Michael Stefanic - 26) and is the third longest active streak in the PCL.

GOT 'EM: C Korey Lee threw out two base runners on Sunday afternoon, including catching OF Jake McCarthy in the seventh. Lee has now registered 10 caught stealing in 23 total attempts. His 10 caught stealing are the most in the Pacific Coast League and tied for the fourth most caught stealing in Minor League Baseball (Nick Clarno - 14, Augusta). In 2022 with Sugar Land, Lee was tied for fifth in the Pacific Coast League in caught stealing, throwing out 17 of 62 attempted base stealers (27.4%)

GRAE ALL DAY: Grae Kessinger continues to get on base at a great clip for the Space Cowboys, reaching in 22 of his first 28 games with Sugar Land while recording hits in 15 of 27 contests. The former second-round pick out of Ole Miss has worked 22 walks this year, tied for the eighth most in the Pacific Coast League, and leads Sugar Land with a .414 on-base percentage

HITTERS HEATING UP: Korey Lee is currently riding an 8-game hitting streak (.343, 12-for-35, 4 2B, 3B, 8 RBI), the longest by a Space Cowboys hitter this year. In his first action in a week, Pedro Leon doubled on Tuesday night, the 13th time in 14 games he has reached base. Luke Berryhill is also riding an 11-game on-base streak, hitting .279 (12-43) in that span.

SUGAR LAND TO THE SHOW: RHP Brandon Bielak was recalled by the Astros on 5/1 and came on in relief of Luis Garcia on Monday night, throwing 4.0 innings and allowing two runs on two hits with six strikeouts. Though he didn't receive a decision, Bielak helped hold down the Giants offense down and set the stage for a 7-3 Astros win. LHP Matt Gage was recalled by Houston on Tuesday, 5/2, and threw 1.2 innings of scoreless relief on Tuesday night.

RECORD SETTING DAY IN ABQ: On 5/4/23 at Isotopes Park, the Space Cowboys scored 16 runs and pounded out 22 hits as part of a record setting 16-13 victory over Albuquerque, setting several single-game franchise record, including:

- Doubles in a game (9)... The previous record for a nine-inning game was 6, done six previous times, and the overall record was 8, done in an 11-inning game on 7/18/2021 at Oklahoma City. Three players recorded multiple doubles, with Justin Dirden hitting three while Grae Kessinger and Michael Sandle each hit two.
- Extra-Base Hits in a game (13)... That surpassed the record of 12 extra-base hits, accomplished three previous times, last on 8/23/22 @ Las Vegas.
- At Bats (50), exceeding 48 at bats, yet again accomplished on 8/23/2022.
- On a personal level, Justin Dirden tied the single-game franchise record for doubles in a game (3) & extra-base hits (4)... Dirden also hit the first grand slam of the 2023 season, recording 6 RBI in the process.

UNA NUEVA Y DULCE IDENTIDAD: As part of MiLB's 'Copa de la Diversión,' the Space Cowboys will rebrand on multiple occasions in 2023 as "Las Dulces de Sugar Land." The name is to honor the Latino community's contribution to the foundation and growth of the City of Sugar Land, which are as real as the sugar that gives our hometown its name. The primary logo of 'Las Dulces de Sugar Land,' is vibrant and features a watermelon candy capped in a flame of chamoy and chili powder.

SOME PEOPLE CALL THEM: Opening Day of 2022 was the first-ever game for the Astros' Triple-A affiliate under the Sugar Land Space Cowboys brand. The Astros re-branded their Triple A affiliate on Jan. 29, 2022, following the purchase of the Sugar Land franchise in 2021. Sugar Land had played under the "Skeeters" brand for the first 10 years of its existence. They spent 2012-20 as members of the independent Atlantic League and rose to the Triple-A level for the 2021 season.

WHERE TO FIND US: Once again in 2023, all 150 Space Cowboys games can be heard on ESPN 92.5 FM (Gow Media). An audio streaming link is also available at slspacecowboys.com. All Space Cowboys games can be seen on MiLB.TV. Garrett Greene begins his first year as the 'Voice of the Space Cowboys' and will be on the call for all game, home and away. He'll be joined by longtime Houston area broadcaster Gerald Sanchez for home games.

NOW HERE'S A STOREY: Mickey Storey returns for his fourth season as the manager of the Astros' Triple-A affiliate and his third with Sugar Land. Storey joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2016 and has managed with Single-A Quad Cities (2018) and Triple-A Round Rock (2019), along with two seasons in Sugar Land. Storey appeared in nine seasons at the professional level as a right-handed pitcher, including stints at the Major League level with the Astros (2012) and Blue Jay (2013). He appeared in four collegiate seasons at Florida Atlantic and was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft.

TO INFINITY AND BEYOND: Key elements of the Space Cowboys brand include the Mission Patch, Horizon Gradient and Primary Space Cowboys Logo.

- **Primary Logo:** The primary logo features the Space Cowboy donning a traditional cowboy hat, a bandanna and a blast shield over his face that is peppered with space dust and has a starburst at the eye.
- **Horizon Gradient:** Inspired by a shot of the horizon of the earth from space, the color palette and gradient feature light blue, navy, orange, gray and black notes that are prominent in the franchise's logo and uniforms. The colors represent the ever-expanding Sugar Land community and an exciting new chapter on the horizon
- **Mission Patch:** This patch will be featured on all three uniforms and serves as an alternate logo. It intertwines elements from the Texas state flag, with a rocket superimposed over the front ready to launch.

READY TO RIDE: The Space Cowboys brand pays respect to elements that are key to the identity of Greater Houston. The NASA Johnson Space Center is located in Houston and the Cowboys element is a nod to the rugged, Western roots that are embedded in Houston as Texas' largest city.

A LITTLE ABOUT US: Through its first nine seasons, Sugar Land played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in '16 and '18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. Sugar Land still holds Atlantic League single-season records for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from its '13 season. Sugar Land was managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, Sugar Land went 601-502. Notable people to appear for Sugar Land include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino.

REST OF THE CREW: Joining manager Mickey Storey on the Space Cowboys coaching staff are pitching coach Erick Abreu, hitting coach Aaron Westlake and development coach Wladimir Sutil. Abreu returns for his third season in Sugar Land as the pitching coach for the Astros' Triple-A affiliate. He's previously worked as the pitching coach for Astros affiliates at the Single A, Short-Season, Appalachian League, Gulf Coast League and Dominican Summer League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014. Westlake spent 2022 as the hitting coach in Double-A Corpus Christi and worked as a development coach for the Florida Gulf Coast League Astros in 2021. Sutil enters his second season on the Space Cowboys staff after serving as the manager for the Astros' Florida Complex League team in 2021. He's worked as a manager for Astros affiliates at the Short-Season and Gulf Coast League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014.

AGAINST ABQ: Hansen is making his third career appearance and first career start against Albuquerque. Hansen made his Triple-A debut on 5/8/21 in Albuquerque, throwing 3.0 innings of relief to earn a save in a 15-1 Sugar Land victory.

BACK IN THE SADDLE: On Opening Night, Hansen started for the Space Cowboys and went 3.1 innings... It was his first appearance since August 5, 2021 at Round Rock... The righty missed the entire 2022 season while recovering from Tommy John Surgery

IN SPRING: Appeared three times for the Astros in Spring Training in West Palm, all three in relief... Went 0-0, 4.76 ERA, allowing three runs in 5.2 innings pitched with four walks and five strikeouts... All three of his outings were over 1.0 IP (1.2, 1.1, 2.2)... In his final outing of Spring Training, spun 2.2 scoreless innings, giving up two hits and two walks while striking out two.

DOUBLE DIGITS: Hansen recorded his two 10+ strikeouts in a game during the 2019 season... The first came in his first start of 2019 when Hansen struck out a career-best 11 batters in 5.0 scoreless innings on April 9... He then struck out 10 hitters on May 6, 2019 @ Lansing, giving up just one hit and two walks across a career-best 7.0 frames.

HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR: The righty was named a New-York Penn League Midseason All-Star in 2018 before earning a Midwest League Midseason All-Star nod in 2019.

VALLEYCATS STRIKE: Hansen had an impressive professional debut with the then Class-A Short Season Tri-City ValleyCats, posting a 1.76 ERA with 45 strikeouts in 14 appearances, all but two in relief, spanning 30.2 innings.

TO THE 'STROS: Drafted in the 8th round of the 2018 draft by the Astros out of the University of Oklahoma.
