**ABOUT LAST NIGHT....** The Vancouver Canadians lost 6-4 to the Spokane Indians (Rockies) Friday night at Ron Tonkin Field, their third consecutive loss that puts them two games under .500 for the first time since May 7 when they were 1-3.

Spokane put the game out of reach with three runs in the seventh. Leading 3-2 after single runs in the second, third and fifth, the Indians sent seven men to the plate and used two hits, a hit batter and an error to go up 6-2.

Vancouver scored a run in the bottom of the seventh thanks to two out hits by DJ Neal (single) and Luis De Los Santos (RBI double) to pull within three before they threatened in the ninth. Davis Schneider singled before an Andres Guerra double though Schneider was cut down at the plate trying to score. Neal followed with an RBI single to make it 6-4, but the potential tying run grounded out to end the game and hand the C's their sixth loss in 16 games against the Tribe.

De Los Santos hit his team-best seventh home run of the year to begin the fourth after Spokane starter Mitch Kilkeny (W, 3-0) was perfect through his first three innings of work. The Canadians scored their second run of the game in the fifth after a Guerra single, a Neal walk and an error by the third baseman that scored Guerra from second base.

Four different C's had two hits in the game: De Los Santos, Sebastian Espino (triple, single), Guerra and Neal. On the mound, Parker Caracci worked a scoreless ninth as the only Vancouver hurler to not allow a run. Sean Mellen worked three innings and allowed a run on three hits with one walk and three strikeouts.

**THE TRIBE HAS SPOKANE:** The Canadians welcome the Indians to Ron Tonkin Field this week for the third series of the season between these two clubs. The last time they met was June 8-13 at Avista Stadium; that week, the C's took four of six and outscored Spokane 41-31, though one of their two losses was an 8-0 defeat in which they were shutout for the second and last time this year.

**HOME AWAY FROM HOME:** Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

**ON THIS DATE IN CANADIANS HISTORY:** July 10, 2010 - The C's took down Yakima 10-1 on 14 hits - 11 of which were singles - thanks in part to a seven-run fifth inning. Ryan Lipkin drove in four runs while Wade Kirkland and Doug Landaeta contributed three hits apiece. Anivoris Ramirez earned the win with five shutout innings while Jake Brown, Josh Bowman and Pedro Vidal combined to one-hit the Bears over the last 3.1 innings of the game.

**BIG FLY GUYS:** Luis De Los Santos' home run in the fourth inning yesterday was his team-best seventh of the season and Vancouver's 40<sup>th</sup> longball of 2021. 18 of those 40 have been with runners on base - 10 two-run shots, seven three-run homers and a Tanner Kirwer grand slam on May 14 against Spokane.

**HOT START:** The C's have scored 53 runs in the first inning this year, their most in any single stanza. However, they've also allowed a team-worst 49 first inning scores

**ON THE HILL:** MLB.com's #10 Blue Jays prospect CJ Van Eyk gets the ball for Vancouver. In his last turn on July 4 in Everett, the right-hander took the loss after he allowed five runs on two hits with four walks and eight strikeouts. The former Florida State Seminole is 0-2 with 14 earned runs in his last 11 innings pitched (11.45 ERA) in his last three starts. Despite some recent struggles, Van Eyk has lowered his opponent's batting average against by 28 points over his previous six outings. A native of Tampa, FL, Van Eyk earned his first professional win against these Indians on June 9 at Avista Stadium; that night, he went five frames and allowed two runs (one earned) on five hits with two walks and five strikeouts. All told he's 1-0 with a 1.86 ERA with four walks and 12 K's in two starts across 9.2 innings of work and has limited the Tribe to a .235 batting average

Righty Trent Fennell makes a spot start for Spokane after scheduled starter Will Ethridge was scratched earlier today. He last climbed the slope first on June 30 against Tri-City when he dazzled with five hitless innings in which he walked one and struck out a career-high nine. He's faced the C's five times and given up three runs on seven hits in nine innings of work.
