## Jersey Shore BlueClaws (26-20) vs Brooklyn Cyclones (24-22)

ShoreTown Ballpark - Lakewood, NJ (opened 2001) LHP Sam Aldegheri (3-2, 1.89) vs RHP Dakota Hawkins (1-1, 4.01) Series: Game 2 of 6 (Jersey Shore leads season series 4-3 of 27)

Last Time Out... Otto Kemp broke a 3-3 tie with an RBI triple in the seventh and the BlueClaws held off Brooklyn for a 5-4 win on Tuesday night at ShoreTown Ballpark...Andrick Nava added a home run for the BlueClaws...Gunner Mayer gave up a run in the ninth but got Nick LoRusso to line out to right field to end the game...Nick Morabito tied the game with a two run home run off Jean Cabrera in the top of the seventh inning.

Home Sweet Home...The BlueClaws haven't lost a home game since April 30th, winning 12 straight games at ShoreTown Ballpark since May 1st...They are 17-5 at home on the season, and their .773 home winning percentage is the 4th best in the minors (Birmigham, AA White Sox, is 17-4)...Their 2.41 home ERA is the 6th best in the minors (Birmingham, AA White Sox is at 1.91)...The BlueClaws are 9-15 on the road with a 5.15 team ERA.

State of the Claws...Jersey Shore has won back to back games (the last game in Aberdeen and the first at home against Brooklyn) as they return home after a 5-7 road trip (they went 2-4 at Hudson Valley and 3-3 at Aberdeen)...They are now 17-7 in May and enter today one game back of first place Greensboro (won won at Asheville on Tuesday night)...The BlueClaws have been as many as 4.5 games out and as many as 1.5 games up.

The Claws and the Clones...The BlueClaws open a series with Brooklyn tonight, the second series of the season between the two teams (Jersey Shore leads 1-0)...They split six games in Lakewood from April 16-21 with the BlueClaws taking three of the first four and the Cyclones winning the last two...Last year, the BlueClaws nosed out Brooklyn on the final day of the season to win the SAL Northern Division Second Half title

Hot Hitting Otto...Otto Kemp had the game winning RBI triple on Tuesday night and is 17-49 since May 14<sup>th</sup> with two home runs, three doubles, three triples, four walks and three stolen bases...He is hitting .319 with the BlueClaws this year...Kemp has also played first (his first four professional games there), second, and third base this year, plus one

inning in right field (he caught a fly ball to end the win on May 19th at Hudson Valley), his first professional appearance in the outfield... He finished last season with the BlueClaws, hitting .223 in 31 games...Kemp signed with the Phillies out of Point Loma Nazarene (CA) in 2022.

Nava a Doubt...Andrick Nava hit a solo home run and had three hits on Tuesday...Since May 4th, Nava is 13-31 with a home run and four doubles and seven RBIs...Nava has two HRs on the season after he hit three with the BlueClaws last year, adding a .221 batting average... Nava has been with the BlueClaws since August of 2022 and turned 22

Jumpin Justin...Justin Crawford (8-21 in his last five games with four SBs) leads the BlueClaws with 14 multi-hit games including seven in May (he had two hits on Wednesday, Thursday, and Saturday)...He enters today at .276 on the seson and leads the BlueClaws with 16 stolen bases...He had a four-hit game on May 7<sup>th</sup> (the second by a BlueClaw this year following William Bergolla on April 6<sup>th</sup>)...He was the 17<sup>th</sup> overall pick in the 2022 draft from Bishop Gorman HS in Las Vegas and is the 15<sup>th</sup> former

William The Kid...William Bergolla, the BlueClaws youngest player (19), is 21-64 since he entered the April 30th game at .145 for the year...He is 13-32 in his last eight starts...The #12 prospect in the system per MLB Pipeline, Bergolla is one of just six 19 year olds to play for the BlueClaws as a High-A affiliate (including teammates Justin Crawford and Bryan Rincon who were 19 when they debuted with Jersey Shore last year and have since turned 20).

Hot Hitting EB...Erick Brito had two hits on Sunday and stole five bases in Aberdeen, giving him nine on the season...He had three hits including a triple and two RBIs on May 21st...Brito is 17-62 since May 9th...He homered on May  $9^{th}$  in Lakewood, his first home run in 358 days (since May 16, 2023 with Clearwater vs Bradenton)...Brito now has four career home runs...The 22 year old (as of May  $25^{th}$ ) split last year between the BlueClaws and Clearwater, hitting a combined .238 with 29 stolen bases

A Chance at 20...The BlueClaws are 17-7 this month with three games remaining...They have chance at a 20-win May, which would be just the fifth 20-win month in franchise history (most recently 20-9 in July of 2018)...All four 20-win months came before the MiLB scheduling adjustments and came in months where the BlueClaws played 29 or 30 games)...They will play 27 games this month...Since 2021, their best month was August of 2023, when they went 18-9.

Three Saves for Gunner...Gunner Mayer has earned his first three professional saves in his last three appearances (two at Aberdeen at Tuesday against Brooklyn)...He has moved to the bullpen this year and struck out 24 batters in 18 innings (24 of the 72 batters he faced)...Last year as a starter, Mayer had a 5.47 ERA with 79 strikeouts in 77.1 innings pitched...He was a 5<sup>th</sup> round pick in 2019 from San Joaquin Delta JC (CA).

Triple Your Pleasure...Coming into this road trip, only five BlueClaws had hit two triples in a game...Otto Kemp did it on Sunday at Hudson Valley and then Troy Schreffler matched him with two triples on Friday at Aberdeen (before this year, the last to do so was Marcus Lee Sang on 8/4/23 vs Brooklyn)...The BlueClaws had four triples in their

Keep On Chuck-king...Charles King threw two scoreless innings on Ma 19th to earn his first professional win and added two scoreless innings at Aberdeen...King signed with the Phillies in February after spending the two previous sea with the Padres as a biomechanical pitching analyst...He had not played competitive baseball since graduating TCU in 2021 before signing with the Phillies after spending the winter at Driveline in Scottsdale...11 of his 14 outings this year have been scoreless outings and he has two saves.

Bouncing Back...Leandro Pineda is 11-35 with two home runs in his last 10 games to get back to .296 on the season...He leads the team with five home runs on the year after hitting nine last year...Pineda had a 13-game hitting season...Last season, Pineda hit .243 (.298 in the second half with an .852 OPS and .193 in the first half with a .607

Harper Locks It Down...Daniel Harper threw four scoreless innings on the road trip...He leads the BlueClaws with four saves, picking up his fourth save of the year on May 11th...The right-hander from the University of Kentucky has 20 strikeouts in 15.1 innings so far this year...He had a six out save on April 25th at Aberdeen and a three out save on May 3th and 5th against Bowling Green...Harper was an 18th round pick in 2022 from the University of Kentucky.

Going Gone...The BlueClaws (10 HRs in Lakewood and 16 on the road, 8 of those in Hickory from April 9th - 16th) got Andrick Nava's second HR of the season on Tuesday...They had two home runs from both Leandro Pineda and Otto Kemp on the last road trip...Pineda leads the team with five on the season while Cade Fergus. Troy Schreffler, and Jordan Dissin have three apiece.

Strike 'em Out Danny...LHP Danny Wilkinson, a Scotch Plains native, has 22 strikeouts in just 11.1 innings this season...Last year, he fanned 106 batters in 56.2 innings with Clearwater...Wilkinson signed with the Phillies in 2022 out of Villanova.

Trying For Back to Back...The BlueClaws have only made the playoffs in back to back years once - in 2009 and 2010, both SAL Championship seasons...They have a chance to do so again this year after reaching the SAL Northern Division Championship Series last year.

Of the Week...Braeden Fausnaught was named

SAL Pitcher of the Week for the week ending May 5th...He threw six scoreless innings on May 4th...He is the fifth SAL Pitcher of the Week winner for the BlueClaws since moving to High-A (Mitch Neunborn in 2023, Ben Brown in 2022, Tyler McKay and Kevin Gowdy in 2021).

Youth Is Served ... Per Baseball America, the BlueClaws have five of the 25 youngest players in the South Atlantic League (based on Opening Day rosters of 360 players): William Bergolla (3rd youngest), Bryan Rincon (9th), Justin Crawford (11th), Hendry Mendez (17th), and Emmaarion Boyd (21st).

In the First Round...Justin Crawford is the 15th former first round pick to play for the BlueClaws and the fourth to play for the

BlueClaws as a High-A team (Andrew Painter and Mick Abel in 2022 and Bryson Stott in 2021)... Since 2000, the only two Phillies first round picks not to play for the BlueClaws are Joe Savery (2007) and Aaron Nola (2014) plus 2023 firstround pick Aidan Miller, who is currently with Clearwater.

Go Phils...The BlueClaws have several players that grew up Phillies fans: C Jordan Dissin (went to Malvern Prep in Philadelphia, 27 miles from Citizens Bank Park), OF Troy Schreffler (from Harrisburg), and LHP Braeden Fausnaught (from Danville and went to West Chester University).

Walk-Off This Way...The BlueClaws had an Opening Night walk-off win when Emaarion Boyd scored on a wild pitch...They had eight walk-off wins in 2023, including one in their final regular season home game...On September 3rd, Felix Reyes hit a three-run walk-off home run to cap a four-run BlueClaws ninth inning comeback against Aberdeen...It was the first BlueClaws walk-off home run since Ben Pelletier hit one on August 15, 2019 against Delmarva.

From The Shore to the Show...123 players have now gone From the Shore, to the Show including one this year (Ben Brown, Cubs)...Three debuted in 2023 – James McArthur with the Royals, Johan Rojas with the Phillies, and Orion Kerkering with the Phillies...Kerkering, who was with the BlueClaws from May 9th through July 6th, is the only player to play for the BlueClaws and Phillies in the same year.

On the Staff...Greg Brodzinski returns to manage the BlueClaws in 2024 after leading the BlueClaws to the playoffs and a league-best 73-58 mark in 2023...Pitching coach Brad Bergesen is in Lakewood for a third time (2018 and 2022) and is joined as a pitching coach by first-year Phillies coach Matt Ellmyer...Hitting coach Adam Lind hit 200 big league home runs and is in his first year as a coach...Position coach Orlando Munoz is in his first year with the BlueClaws after managing the DSL Phillies since 2017...Development coach Beth Greenwood is the first BlueClaws female position coach and a member of Team USA Women's National Baseball


