### RIDERS TAKE DOWN NWA IN GAME ONE OF SERIES:

The Frisco RoughRiders defeated the Northwest Arkansas Naturals 6-1 on Tuesday evening from Arvest Ballpark. Frisco (29-23, 73-48) opened the scoring against Northwest Arkansas (25-26, 60-60) starter Cruz Noriega (6-3) when **Abimelec Ortiz** clubbed his 12th homer of the season, a solo shot to right center to give the Riders a 1-1 lead in the top of the second. In the home half of the second inning, Luca Tresh evened the game with a solo homer to left against **Ben Anderson** (6-7). The RoughRiders regained the lead with two runs in the top of the fifth. **Daniel Mateo** doubled, driving in **Aaron Zavala** to break the tie. **Alejandro Osuna** pushed Mateo across the plate with an RBI single, giving the Riders a 3-1 advantage. Anderson finished after 5.0 innings, allowing just one run on one hit and three walks while fanning five. **Larson Kindreich** and **Andy Rodriguez** combined to allow just one hit across 3.0 scoreless innings. In the top of the eighth inning, **Cody Freeman** padded the Riders lead with an RBI single that plated **Maximo Acosta** to push the Frisco lead to 4-1. In the top of the ninth, Acosta gave the RoughRiders some breathing room with a two-run double that brought **Cooper Johnson** and Mateo across home to make it a 6-1 game. **Skylar Hales** took the mound in the bottom of the ninth inning, striking out two of the three batters he faced to seal the win for Frisco. Offensively, the Riders collected nine hits as the top three in the order in Osuna, Acosta and Freeman each snagged two hit nights.

### ABIME-LECTRIC ORTIZ:

**Abimelec Ortiz** has been on fire for the RoughRiders recently. Over his last 33 games, Ortiz is hitting .323/.413/.548/.961 with seven doubles, seven home runs, 22 RBIs, 23 runs scored and 18 walks. Ortiz has reached in 14 games in a row, batting .420 (21-for-50)/.532/.720/1.252 with three doubles, four home runs, 14 RBIs, 11 walks, 12 strikeouts and 13 runs scored. Entering into June 23rd's game, he was hitting .179 with a .550 OPS. Since, he is hitting .303 with an .898 OPS, raising his batting average to .231 and a .703 OPS.

### DOUBLE-A RON TAKING DOUBLE-A:

Aaron Zavala has been swinging the bat well as of late, hitting in seven-games in a row. Over that streak, he is batting .440 (11-for-25)/.483/.520/1.003 with two doubles and 10 RBIs. Over his last 20 games, he is hitting .250/.321/.333/.654 in August.

### PLEASE DON'T HIT ME ONE MORE TIME:

The Riders pitching staff has been a strength this season, but they have struggled over their last 13 games. During that stretch, Springfield and San Antonio have hit .282 (131-for-465) with 27 doubles, nine home runs and averaging 5.6 runs per game on the offensive side, taking seven of 13 games. Frisco's bullpen had a 7.15 ERA (45ER/56.2 IP) and has allowed 75 hits over 56.2 innings while blowing leads in five of their seven losses. The Riders lost back-to-back series for the first time all season before taking their last series against San Antonio. They are now 8-11 in their last 19 games, but 5-1 in their last six games.

### HOMER HAPPY:

On August 16th, the Riders hit a season-high four home runs with **Luis Mieses** capping the night with his second for a walk-off home run. It was Mieses's third multi-home run game of his career. The RoughRiders have hit 13 home runs in the last 10 games, with those 13 home runs being third in the Texas League over the last 10 games. Frisco is still just seventh in the Texas League in home runs this season with 89 across their 121 games (on pace for 101, which would be for the fifth-fewest in the 21 seasons of the franchise).

### RISP-ECT THIS PLEASE:

Over the last 31 games, the Riders are fourth in the Texas League with a .737 OPS, second with a .260 batting average and are sixth with 4.7 runs per game. Holding them back, Frisco is just batting just .219 (63-for-287) with runners in scoring position over their last 31 games.

### HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 40-22 at Riders Field this season. At home this season, Frisco has a +69 run differential, a 4.12 ERA and is averaging 5.6 runs per game with a .763 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 33-26 with a 3.18 ERA, but a +26 run differential while averaging 3.9 runs per game and owning a .640 OPS (10th in the league). **Cody Freeman** has 10 of his 14 home runs at home while **Abimelec Ortiz** has hit 10 of his 12 homers at Riders Field. Ortiz is hitting .286 at home as opposed to .140/.203/.222/.425 on the road.

### WE'RE GOING DANCING:

The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

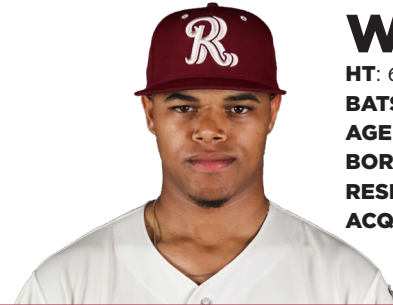

-Worked on increasing his fastball velocity from the low 90s when he signed. He spent the fall of 2023 at the Rangers spring training facility and working out in the biomechanics' lab where the velocity was up to 99 mph.

-Looking to become the first player born in Payita to make MLB debut.
