YESTERDAY'S RECAP

The Chesapeake Baysox ended a seven-game losing streak on Wednesday night with a 4-2 victory in 10 innings. Chesapeake fought back from a two-run deficit and tied the game in the ninth on an **Adam Retzbach** safety squeeze bunt. **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** gave the Baysox their first lead of the game with a two-run homer in the 10th. Starter **Trace Bright** fanned a season-high seven batters in six innings and **Keagan Gillies** lowered his ERA down to 0.72 with two scoreless innings of relief to seal the win.

ENRIQUE ELECTRIFIES

OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.**'s 10th inning two-run homer on Wednesday was not only his first homer of the season **but the first Baysox extra inning homer of the year and the first extra inning homer since September 6, 2023.** The Orioles No. 3 prospect has now reached base in 15 of 19 games played to start the season. The 2023 first rounder missed 32 games from April 11 - May 19 due to a left hamstring injury.

CREED CRUSHES

C **Creed Willems** celebrated his 22nd birthday yesterday. The Orioles No. 12 prospect is tied for ninth in the Eastern League in extra base hits (19), is 10th in OPS (.838) and 10th in SLG (.484). Willems hit five homers in the month of May, which was tied for the fifth-most in the league, including a 406-foot homer off Mets No. 4 prospect Jonah Tong on Thursday.

RETZ CAN RAKE

C **Adam Retzbach** was one of the Eastern League's best offensive players in the month of May. The 24-year-old posted the third-best on-base percentage (.457) and the sixth-best batting average in the league (.327). Retzbach has reached base in 12 of his last 13 games.

TEACH ME HOW TO DOUGIE

Over his last 10 games, OF **Doug Hodo** is batting .308 (8-for-26) with an on-base percentage of .471. Hodo is tied for fifth in the Eastern League in walks (28). After a slow start to the season, Hodo's bat heated up in the month of May, posting a slash line of .294/.380/.426 with three doubles, two homers and eight RBI.

WALK THIS WAY

C **Silas Ardoin** leads the Eastern League in walks (36). Ardoin drew the most walks in the league in the month of April with 18. Last season, he drew 47 walks in 104 games.

ONE RUN WONDERS

Chesapeake has won 13 one-run games this season - **which is tied for the second-most of any Minor League team.** The Baysox have played 22 one-run games this season, which is tied for the third-most in Minor League Baseball.

A REMATCH AGAINST THE RUBBERDUCKS

The Akron RubberDucks enter this week with a 34-17 record, which is tied for the best record in the league. The Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians are coming off a series victory in Somerset and have won nine of their last 12. Akron won four of six in Bowie in the most recent series meeting from May 13 - 18. The RubberDucks roster features two active members of the Guardians Top 30 prospect list (per MLB.com) - C Cooper Ingle (No. 8) and RHP Austin Peterson (No. 29).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Austin Peterson is expected to start tonight for the RubberDucks. The Guardians No. 29 prospect has been one of the best starting pitchers in the Eastern League as he holds the lowest ERA (1.47) and WHIP (0.88) in the league. The 25-year-old last faced Chesapeake on May 16 and threw six innings, allowed two unearned runs on four hits, three walks and five strikeouts. The former UConn Husky holds a 0.95 ERA in three career starts against the Baysox.

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in franchise history, he led the Baysox to a 62-75 overall record, oversaw 18 player promotions to Triple-A and coached two former Baysox who would go on to make their Major League debuts in the same season. CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasma De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™" - a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasma de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
