However, Bradenton's 12.65 K/9 is the best in MiLB during this stretch.

Rivas is currently riding a career-long 12-game on-base streak which is the longest since he reached base in 11-straight games from 8/10/21-8/26/21 when he was a member of the DSL Pirates Black. He's also tied his career-high with five home runs this season.

The Rome Emperors (High-A, ATL) lead the way with 10. Last season, Bradenton finished with seven shutouts in 130 games. The pitching staff this yeaer accomplishing that feat in only 60 games. The franchise record for most shutouts in a season is 18 set back in 2014, which featured future Major Leaguers in Chad Kuhl, Tyler Glasnow, and Shane Carle in the rotation.

This came after the Marauders had only 10 longballs in 22 games in April. So far in June, Bradenton has 18 home runs in 15 games, which is the most in the FSL and second-most in all of Single-A only trailing the Modesto Nuts (SEA) who have 18 in 14 games. Bradenton had homered in seven straight games until failing to do so on Friday night. It was the longest stretch with a home run for Bradenton since they homered in 11 consecutive games last year from 6/8 - 6/20.

PROSPECTS, PROSPECTS, PROSPECTS: With the addition of OF Enmanuel Terrero, the Bradenton Marauders now hold seven of the Pittsburgh Pirates' Top 30 prospects according to MLB Pipeline, which is the most of any Minor League team in the Pirates system. The Altoona Curve (Double-A) are the closest team holding six of the Top 30 with five of the Pirates top eight prospects there. LHP Michael Kennedy is the highest-rated player on the Marauders roster at No. 14.

CLOSE QUARTERS: Sunday's win in Dunedin marked the Marauders' 24th one-run contest of the season.
