- The Blue Jays were swept in a doubleheader by Lakeland on Saturday, marking a series loss for the Jays.
- Victor Arias opened game one with a leadoff homer, but Lakeland scored eight unanswered runs to claim the contest.
- In game two, Fernando Perez fired five innings of one run ball, striking out five without issuing a walk.
- After Lakeland struck first in the fourth, Nic Deschamps tied the game with a solo homer in the fifth.
- Dunedin took the lead with a two-out RBI single from Tucker Toman in the sixth. Lakeland tied with two outs in the bottom of the inning on Jose De La Cruz's RBI infield single.
- Neither team scored in the seventh, but Clayton Campbell ended the game in the bottom of the eighth with a sacrifice fly.

SERIES SUCCESS STYMIED

This week's series loss to Lakeland snaps a streak of six straight sets with at least a split for the D-Jays. The team's last series loss came on the road at Fort Myers, May 7-12. The D-Jays four straight losses mark the team's longest losing streak since their nine-game skid April 19-28.

BACK UNDERWATER

With Saturday's two losses, the Blue Jays are back under .500 for the first time since June 7, when the team was 27-28 following a win at Palm Beach.

TOUGH STRETCH

The Blue Jays are in the midst of perhaps their toughest stretch of the year, scheduled to play nine games in eight days (with yester-day's doubleheader). All nine games are against the two best teams in the FSL in Lakeland (47-26) and Clearwater (46-28).

JAMMIN' BATS IN JUNE

Dunedin's pitching staff is in the midst of its best month of the season, pitching to a 3.43 ERA in 23 games in June, the fourth best mark in the FSL. Lakeland's 2.74 mark is tops in the circuit. In May, the Blue Jays turned in a 4.70 ERA - the second-worst in the league

WHOOPS!

The Blue Jays committed two errors in both games of yesterday's twin bill. The team has committed two errors in five of the last seven games. The Jays are 7-14 when committing more than one error in a game.

NICE TO SEE YOU, NIMMALA

In his first game with Dunedin in over a month, Arjun Nimmala lifted a solo home run Thursday - his fourth of the season in Single-A. Nimmala was placed on Dunedin's development list on May 14, and then was assigned to the FCL Blue Jays on June 3. In 8 FCL contests, Nimmala went 5-21 with a home run. Nimmala was the Blue Jays first round draft pick last season, and is the organization's third-ranked prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

ALLERGIC TO BLOWOUTS

Saturday's 3-2 loss marked Dunedin's 27th one-run game this season - tied for the most in the FSL with Bradenton. The Jays are 12-15 in those contests. 51 of the Blue Jays 73 games this season (70%) have been decided by three or fewer runs. Dunedin has a 25-26 record in those games. 10 of the team's last 12 have been decided by three or fewer.

ROAD COOKING

Dunedin's pitching staff has proved to be more effective on the road than at home. At TD Ballpark, the Jays have posted a 4.30 ERA in 343 innings. On the road, the staff's ERA stands at 3.60 in 305 innings - the second best road ERA in the FSL.
