RHP Logan Tabeling (2-0, 2.61 ERA) vs. LHP Grayson Hitt (0-0, 6.19 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes complete a six-game road trip this afternoon, with the final game of a six-game series against the Visalia Rawhide (AZ). The Quakes will return to LoanMart Field on Tuesday, May 13th, taking on the Inland Empire 66ers in a six-game series. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE RAWHIDE: Today's game is the sixth of 24 head-to-head meetings and the sixth of 15 here at Valley Strong Ballpark. Last season, the Quakes went 14-16 against the Rawhide, 7-8 here in Visalia.

LAST GAME: One night after blowing a four-run lead, Rancho reversed course and used great pitching to hold a four-run lead in a 6-2 win over the Visalia Rawhide on Saturday at Valley Strong Ballpark. Aidan Foeller, Shawndrick Oduber (1-0), Michael Vilchez and Myles Caba held the Rawhide offense to just three hits, helping Rancho to their third win in five games of the series. Offensively, Kellon Lindsey had two hits, two runs scored, two RBIs and a stolen base to help lead Rancho's nine-hit attack. Jaron Elkins finished with two hits and an RBI. Visalia starter Wilkin Paredes (2-2) gave up four runs over five innings, taking the loss. The win sets up an opportunity for Rancho to win their fourth straight series since dropping four of six on their opening road trip to Stockton.

LONG-BALLS: Even though they didn't go deep in Saturday's win, the Quakes have launched six home runs over the first five games of this Visalia series, giving them a league-high 25 in 32 games. San Jose is next up with 21. Eduardo Quintero is tied with Cameron Leary of Stockton for the league lead with six, while Mike Sirota is just one back at five.

ZED, ZERO, NADA: Thursday's shutout gave the Quakes three over a five-game span and a total of four here in 2025, tied for most in the league. Entering Saturday's action, Rancho's team ERA is at 3.28, now tops in the league, just ahead of San Jose at 3.40. Rancho's staff also leads the league in strikeouts with 376, 56 more than Fresno (320).

SUBSTANTIAL ROSTER MOVES: On Thursday, the Quakes promoted two of their most valuable arms to High-A Great Lakes. Starting pitcher Sean Paul Linan, who leads all of Minor League Baseball in strikeouts with 50 strikeouts over just 29.2 innings will be making his first trip to High-A. Reliever Alex Makarewich, who has not allowed an earned run over his first 13 innings and has 27 strikeouts over 13 innings, will also be heading to High-A for the first time. Taking one of those respective spots on the roster will be RHP Shawndrick Oduber, who joins the team from the ACL, where he made just one appearance (two scoreless innings).

WEEKLY AWARDS SWEEP: The Quakes had a great home stand and the Cal League's weekly awards reflect that. Quakes' starting pitcher Sterling Patick (five perfect innings against Stockton) was named the Pitcher of the Week, while Mike Sirota (7-for-20, 2 HR, 5 RBI, 7 R, 4 BB, .458 OBP, 1.208 OPS) was named Hitter of the week.

LOGAN TABELING: 23-year-old right-hander Logan Tabeling makes his first pro start today, his eighth overall appearance this year and his first against Visalia. In his last outing, Tabeling struggled through his worst pro outing, as he allowed two runs over one hitless inning, walking two and hitting three batters in a no-decision against Stockton on May 4th. Tabeling allowed just one run on five hits with one walk and 16 strikeouts over six April appearances. The undrafted free agent out of Illinois signed with the Dodgers in July of 2024.

GRAYSON HITT: 23-year-old left-hander Grayson Hitt makes his sixth start of the year, his first against Rancho. In his last game overall, he allowed two hits and three walks with four strikeouts over four scoreless innings in a no-decision against Fresno on May 4th. Last season, he made six appearances and covered just six innings in the Arizona Complex League, going 0-0 with an ERA of 15.00, allowing ten earned runs on five hits, but with 11 walks over six innings. Hitt was a 2023 fourth-round pick by Arizona out of Alabama, after undergoing Tommy John surgery in 2023.
