ZILCH, ZERO, NADA: RHPs Kodai Senga (2.2 IP) and Kade Morris (6.1) combined on a four-hit shutout, as the Cyclones blanked the Renegades, 4-0, on Wednesday...A night before, RHPs Jonah Tong ( 5.0 IP ), Ben Simon (3.0), and Jake Stevenson (1.0) combined on a two-hitter in a $7-0$ triumph vs. Hudson Valley...Since OF Garrett Martin's solo home run in the eighth inning on Monday, Cyclones pitching has thrown 20.0-consecutive scoreless innings...Brooklyn's lon-
gest scoreless stretch of the year is 23.2 frames from June $1-5$ at Jersey Shore and vs. Aberdeen Brooklyn has thrown consecutive shutouts three times this season...The Cyclones blanked the IronBirds, 2-0 and 4-0, on May 3 and 4 at Maimonides Park...The Cyclones then earned 7-0 and 3-0 wins at Jersey Shore and vs. Aberdeen, respectively....Each of Brooklyn's last three victories has come in shutout fashion...RHPs Dakota Hawkins (6.0 IP) and Josh Hejka (3.0) united on a three-hit blanking in a $7-0$ rout at Aberdeen last Friday...With Wednesday's win, Brooklyn now has 10 shutouts, the second most by a South Atlantic League pitching staff in 2024 trailing only Rome (13)...It is also tied for third most throughout the 2023 campaign.

THE TONG SONG: RHP Jonah Tong tied a career-high with 11 strikeouts over 6.0 innings of one-run ball in a no-decision last Wednesday night in Aberdeen and threw 5.0 spotless innings to earn the win on Tuesday vs. Hudson Valley...Over his last three starts since June 20, the 21 -year-old is $2-0$ with an 0.56 ERA (1 ER in 16.0 IP), allowing only five hits and six walks ( 10.0 BB ), while striking out 25 ( 41.67 K\%)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont age against (194), second in ERA (3.02), fourth in WHP (1.22), and 10th in innings pitched (47.2)...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 60.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is third in FIP (2.18), fourth in strikeout rate (36.3\%), eighth in strikeouts (99), and ninth in strikeout-to-walk rate (26.0\%).
NICK SQUARED: OF Nick Morabito and IF Nick Lorusso have been two of Brooklyn's biggest offensive contributors as of late...Lorusso is seventh in the South Atlantic League in total bases (119), eighth in slugging (.482), walks (39), and so is second among New York Mets' full-season minor leaguers in slugging (.482) and OPS (.854)...He is also tied for fourth in extra-base hits (27), home runs (11) and triples (3), and fifth in total bases (119), RBI (40), and batting average (.271)... Morabito is 10th in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (35)...Since making his SAL debut on May 7, the former second-round pick is third in the circuit in stolen bases (24), tied for fifth in hits (53), and tied for ninth in runs scored (32)...The percentage (424), and stolen bases (35) He also is second in hits (84), third in percentage (.424), and stolen bases ( 35 ).... YOU'LL GET NOTHING AND LIKE IT: Hawkins, Joey Lancellotti (1.0), and Joshua Cornielly (3.0) combined on the first nine-inning no-hitter in Brooklyn Cyclones history in June 4's 3-0 win vs. Aberdeen...The only previous no-hitter came on August 23, 2009, when RHP Brandon Moore tossed a seven-inning no-no in a 5-0 win during Game 1 of a doubleheader at Aberdeen...The effort was the first no-hitter by a Mets minor league affiliate since RHP Joander Suárez hurled a seven-inning effort on September 7 at Hartford...It was also the first nine-inning no-hitter thrown in the borough of Brooklyn since RHP Sal Maglie tossed a no-no for the Dodgers against the Philadelphia Phillies on September 25, 1956, at Ebbets Field.

BIRDMAN BIRDMAN: Prior to joining the rotation, Hawkins impressed in a relief role...Among South Atlantic League relievers, the 24-year-old was sixth in strikeouts (34) and tied for sixth in innings pitched (24.2) prior to his first start...He was also first in ground ball rate ( $62.1 \%$ ) and swinging strike rate (19.7\%), second in strikeout rate (33.0\%) and FIP (1.88), fourth in strikeout-to-walk rate (24.3\%), seventh in walk rate (8.7\%).
