#### LAST TIME OUT...

**MOOSIC, Pa. (July 28, 2021)** – The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders fended off a ferocious late comeback by the Syracuse Mets to hang on for a 9-8 win in extra innings on Wednesday night at NBT Bank Stadium.

The RailRiders jumped out to a lead before an out was recorded, when they worked four straight hits to start the game against Trey Cobb. Socrates Brito and Armando Alvarez brought in runs with singles to give SWB a 2-0 lead. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre tacked on another run in the third on a solo home run from Brito. However, Syracuse struck back in the bottom of the third against Matt Krook when Wilfredo Tovar doubled down the left field line to score former RailRider Mark Payton to cut the deficit to 3-1.

In the top of the fourth, the RailRiders broke the game open with four runs against Andrew Mitchell. Andrew Velazquez smoked a two-run double to left-center and scored on a wild pitch, while Alvarez chased home another run with a double to take a 7-1 lead.

Martin Cervenko homered off Nick Nelson in the bottom of the sixth to narrow the gap to 7-2, but Syracuse squandered further opportunity in the frame, stranding the bases loaded. Matt Pita clubbed a solo home run off Bradley Roney for an insurance run in the top of the ninth. The Mets responded with six runs in the bottom of the ninth against Braden Bristo to tie the game at 8-8, capped off on a three-run double from Cheslor Cuthbert.

SWB played small ball in the top of the 10th, with Cristian Perez laying down a sacrifice bunt to move automatic runner Brandon Wagner to third base. The move paid dividends immediately when Tom Windle uncorked a wild pitch to score Wagner to put the RailRiders on top 9-8.

In the bottom of the 10th, Nick Green (1-1) set the Mets down in order to finish off the victory.

#### NEWS & NOTES

**GOING FOR A WALK:** On Wednesday night, Scranton/Wilkes-Barre pitchers walked 16 Syracuse Mets batters, tying a franchise record set in 1991. Five of the six RailRiders pitchers in the game (**Matt Krook**, 6; **Greg Weissert**, 1; **Nick Nelson**, **Adam Warren** and **Braden Bristo**, 3 each) combined to issue the free passes. It tied a franchise record set by the SWB Red Barons on May 11, 1991 in a game against the Tidewater Tides. In that contest, coincidentally also against a Mets affiliate, the Red Barons used four pitchers with starter **Chuck Malone** walking 11 in 2.0 innings, and **Rocky Elli** walking five more out of the bullpen. Malone's 11 walks are still a franchise record for a player in a single game.

**ALVAREZ ON THE RISE:** RailRiders infielder **Armando Alvarez** has been on a tear over his last 10 games at the plate, batting .372/.400/.791 with four home runs and 13 RBIs. Of the 16 hits he has in this span, 10 of them have gone for extra bases, with six doubles added to his home runs. He has raised his season batting average from .219 to .250, and his OPS has jumped 108 points from .648 to .756. He has seven multi-hit games in these 10 games, including five in his last six contests. In addition to his recent offensive spurt, Alvarez made a diving catch into the first base camera well last Tuesday night against Rochester which ended up as the No. 1 "Top Play" of the night on ESPN's *SportsCenter*.

**FALLING BEHIND:** The RailRiders have made a habit of notching comeback wins this season, but the flip side is that is predicated on the team falling behind in many of these games. Through 70 games this season, Scranton/Wilkes-Barre has allowed the first run in 37 games, notching a 21-16 record in those contests. The RailRiders have been out-scored 79-67 (-12) in the first two innings of games this season, a shocking number considering the team is +112 in run differential this season, the second-best mark in Triple-A East (Durham, +156). Most of the damage has been done in the middle innings, with SWB sporting an impressive +95 run differential in innings four through six.

**SWB DIGS THE LONG BALL:** On Friday night the RailRiders set a new season high by hitting six home runs against the Rochester Red Wings in a 14-5 triumph at PNC Field. **Armando Alvarez**, **Donny Sands**, **Thomas Milone**, **Andrew Velazquez** (2x), and **Frederick Cuevas** all went deep for SWB on the night. It was the first career multi home run game for Velazquez, and Cuevas' dinger was his first above the High-A level in his career. The SWB franchise record for home runs in a game is seven, set on May 31, 1998 at Toledo. The RailRiders have hit 10 home runs in the first five games of the series.

**TURN AROUND NOW SWITCH:** As part of his two-homer performance on Friday night, **Andrew Velazquez** became just the second player in SWB franchise history to switch hit home runs in a game. He hit a home run right-handed against Matt Tomshaw in the fourth inning, and clubbed one left-handed against Ronald Peña in the sixth. Velazquez joined **Darren Burton** in the annals of franchise history with his switch-hit performance. Burton accomplished the rare feat on April 23, 1998 in a game at the Rochester Red Wings.

**NO HITS FOR YOU!** Last Wednesday **Luis Gil**, **Reggie McClain** and **Stephen Ridings** combined to no-hit the Rochester Red Wings in an 8-0 victory. It was the first no-hitter thrown by Scranton/Wilkes-Barre under the Yankees affiliation (2007 - Present), and the first overall since **Jeremy Cummings** no-hit Rochester on Sept. 3, 2006. With the RailRiders having thrown a one-hitter on May 27 against the Buffalo Bisons, 2021 is the first season in franchise history to feature both a no-hitter and a one-hitter in the same season.

The RailRiders no-hitter was the third thrown in Triple-A East this year. The Iowa Cubs have thrown two no-nos this year, using four pitchers to no-hit the Indianapolis Indians on May 9, and had three pitchers no-hit St. Paul on July 11. It was the first no-hitter for a Yankees Triple-A affiliate since 2002, when **Adrian Hernandez**, **Bob Scanlan** and **Kevin Lovinger** of the Columbus Clippers no-hit the Indianapolis Indians in a 15-1 win. The Clippers threw four no-hitters while affiliated with the Yankees from 1979 - 2006, including one by **Mariano Rivera** in 1995.

**IT'S THE FINAL STRETCH (DA NA NA NA):** In lieu of a traditional playoff in Triple-A Baseball, MLB announced last Wednesday that all Triple-A teams will compete in a 10-game postseason tournament called the Triple-A Final Stretch from Sept. 22 through Oct. 3. Each league will have a regular season champion, crowned for having the best record across 120 games, and a Final Stretch champion, crowned for having the best record in the added 10 games. Unlike any tournament you may be familiar with, the Triple-A Final Stretch has a set schedule of opponents and you continue to play even if you are eliminated from contention. MLB announced the RailRiders will play Syracuse from 9/22-26 at PNC Field and finish the Final Stretch at Rochester from 9/28-10/3. MLB also announced it will give a prize to the winners.

# RAILRIDERS STARTING PITCHER

**54 BRODY KOERNER • RHP • 6'2" • 220 LBS • 27**

**LAST TIME OUT:** After throwing only 1.0 inning in the previous 10 days because of several weather postponements, Koerner turned in a terrific start on Saturday against Rochester. In 5.0 shutout innings, he allowed only two hits, both singles, and walked one while striking out two. He got the win to improve to 3-3 on the season, and continued a run of nine straight appearances allowing two earned runs or fewer.

**WELCOME BACK, KOERNER:** After not playing in the 2020 season due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Brody Koerner returns to the RailRiders for his third season with the club. He has the distinction of being the longest-tenured pitcher on the team who has stayed within the Yankees organization, with 41 appearances (30 starts) spread out since the start of the 2018 season. Only teammate Adam Warren (69 G) has made more appearances with SWB than Koerner, but left the Yankees organization on multiple occasions. Warren (56 GS) also has more starts with the RailRiders/SWB Yankees than Koerner.

**STAFF WORKHORSE:** During the 2019 season, Koerner logged 138.2 innings between Double-A Trenton and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, tying him for most among Yankees minor leaguers (Miguel Yajure -- Charleston, Tampa). The right-hander also finished 1-3<sup>rd</sup> in GS (22), 6<sup>th</sup> in AVG (.289) and Winning Percentage (4-8 combined), 7<sup>th</sup> in ERA (5.00) and WHIP (1.53), and 10<sup>th</sup> in K (109).

**HEADING OVERSEAS:** Following the 2019 season, Koerner left the country to play for the Gigantes del Cibao in the Dominican Winter League. It was the first time in his career that he played in a foreign winter league after the regular MiLB season. Koerner went 1-3 with a 2.17 ERA in seven starts with the Gigantes, striking out 21 and walking 17 in 29.0 innings. The right-hander was teammates with several former SWB RailRiders in the DWL, including Abiatal Avelino, Greg Bird, José DePaula, Anyelo Gómez and Adonis Rosa. Also appearing for the team were Wander Franco (No. 1 prospect in baseball) and Eloy Jimenez. Syracuse starter Jesus Reyes also played for the Gigantes.

**2021 HIGHLIGHTS:**

- Began the season on the RailRiders Break Camp Roster.
- Has allowed 2-or-fewer earned runs in 14 of his 15 appearances this season.

- Full name is Brody Tyler Koerner.
- Pitched for Clemson for three seasons (2013-15) and was 5-7 with a 7.00 ERA (97.2 IP, 76 ER) in 31 G/19 GS.
- Graduated from Clemson in 2015 with a degree in Accounting and was a 2x ACC Academic Honor Roll member.
- Graduated from Jay M. Robinson HS (NC) where he lettered three years in baseball, three in basketball and one in football. Was a two-time All-State selection in baseball.
- Born in Winchester, VA but grew up in Concord, NC, a suburb of Charlotte.
