THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On this day in 2013, the Sounds shut out the New Orleans Zephyrs 6-0 at Herschel Greer Stadium, bouncing back from the previous nights' 12-0 defeat. Johnny Hellweg earned the win (5.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 3 K). Sean Halton (3-for-4), Cole Garner (HR) and Blake Davis each had 2 RBI while Scooter Gennett knocked three hits.

Tonight's Games: The Nashville Sounds play games two and three of their six-game series against the Memphis Redbirds. Memphis took the opener 7-5. This will be the Sounds second doubleheader of the young season. Robert Gasser makes his first start of 2023 in game one, going against fellow prospect Gordon Graceffo. Caleb Boushley gets the call for the second game against lefthander Matthew Liberatore.

Robert Gasser: 23-year-old southpaw Robert Gasser will start for the Sounds in game one. The Houston, Texas resident made five starts for the Sounds to end the 2022 campaign, going 2-2 with a 4.44 ERA (26.1 IP/13 ER). He is touted as the No. 10 prospect in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline. Gasser was traded to the Brewers organization from San Diego as part of the Josh Hader trade on August 1, 2022. He was originally drafted by San Diego in the second round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Houston.

Gordon Graceffo: 23-year-old Gordon Graceffo makes his Triple-A debut in game one at AutoZone Park. The right-hander from Wayne, N.J. is the No. 4 prospect in the Cardinals system and the No. 79 prospect in all of baseball per MLB Pipeline. Graceffo combined to go 10-6 with a 2.97 ERA (139.1 IP/46 ER) across three levels of the Cardinals farm system last year. St. Louis selected Graceffo in the fifth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft. The former Villanova Wildcat posted a 1.82 ERA with 86 strikeouts his junior season before being drafted.

Caleb Boushley: 29-year-old Caleb Boushley will start for the Sounds in game two. Boushley was on the mound for the Sounds' season opener on April 1, his first career opening game start. The Wisconsinite was drafted by Milwaukee in the Triple-A phase of the 2021 Rule 5 Draft from San Diego. He was originally selected in the 33rd round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft by the Padres out of Wisconsin-La Crosse.

Matthew Liberatore: 23-year-old Matthew Liberatore gets the ball for Memphis in game two. The southpaw from Peoria, A.Z. is the No. 6 prospect in the Cardinals system per MLB Pipeline. Liberatore made his Major League debut for St. Louis last season, going 2-2 with a 5.97 ERA in nine games (7 starts). He was traded to the Cardinals organization in 2020 as part of a deal involving OF Randy Arozarena on January 9, 2020. Liberatore was initially selected by Tampa Bay in the first round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Mountain Ridge HS (Glendale, A.Z.).

2023 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in 2023: First: 1, Second: 0, Third: 1, Fourth: 1, Fifth: 1, Sixth: 1, Seventh: 0.

Quite a Jack by Ajax: Catcher Alex Jackson launched a mammoth solo homer 471 feet off Tommy Parsons in the fourth inning of the series opener. According to MLB Statcast, Jackson's homer was the longest up to this point in the Triple-A season and the third-longest including the Major Leagues. Only Giancarlo Stanton's 485-foot home run off Ross Stripling on April 2 and Austin Riley's 473-foot blast off Jake Woodford on April 3 went further.

I Can Be Your Hiura: Infielder Keston Hiura continued to come through in the clutch on Tuesday with a first inning RBI single. He has recorded an RBI in each of his first three games played this season. Through 124 Triple-A games, Hiura is batting .302 (133-for-441) with a .404 on-base percentage. He's also got a career .276 (63-for-228) average with Nashville with 15 homers, 46 RBI, a .401 on-base percentage and a .932 OPS in 67 games.

Awesome Eddy: Infielder Eddy Alvarez broke through for his first two hits as a Sound, knocking a triple and home run in the process. The seven total bases on Tuesday are the most by a Sounds hitter in a single game this season.

Sal's Streak Ends: Sal Frelick did not reach in the loss on Tuesday night. It was the first time Frelick had not reached in a Sounds game since August 6, 2022 at Norfolk. He was the only Sound to reach base safely in all three games to date the season. Through Sunday's game vs. Louisville, Frelick had a 44-game on-base streak. He batted .358 (63-for-176) with 38 runs, 9 doubles, 3 triples, 4 home runs, 24 RBI, 20 walks and 10 stolen bases during the streak.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet begins his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022, 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 602-520 record during an eight-season span.

LAST OUTING: Gasser made his last start on September 28, 2022 vs. Memphis at First Horizon Park. The young southpaw ran into trouble in the second inning as the Redbirds picked up three runs. Gasser tossed 5.0 innings and allowed five runs (all earned) on a career-high 10 hits. He struck out six, but took the loss as the Sounds fell 8-4.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Gasser has made two starts against Memphis, both his first start and most recent start as a Sound. He gave up five runs (all earned) on five hits and six walks in his Triple-A debut on September 2 vs. Memphis.

2023 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Is on Nashville's Opening Day roster for the first time in his career.

LAST OUTING: Boushley started game one of the Opening Day doubleheader against Louisville, tossing 3.0 innings and allowing one run on three hits. The lone run came on a solo homer by rehabbing Major Leaguer Joey Votto. Boushley walked three and struck out two. The righty did not factor into the decision as the Sounds earned a walk-off, extra-innings win.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Boushley is facing Memphis for the fourth time in his career, with all previous games coming in 2022. His most recent start came on 9/4/22 in Nashville, where he allowed two runs over 3.0 innings. Boushley is 1-0 with a 6.17 ERA (11.2 IP/8 ER) and 8 strikeouts in his career against the Redbirds.
