TODAY'S GAME: The Isotopes begin the second half of the season with a six-game set against Salt Lake, the second and final series between the club's in 2024 ... The Bees claimed the first series in Salt Lake, 4-2 ... Noah Davis is slated to start for Albuquerque while Reid Detmers is expected to toe the rubber for the Bees

SERIES WINS: With Albuquerque's four wins last week over Oklahoma City, the club has won back-to-back series for the fourth time since Minor League baseball switched to a sixgame format prior to the 2021 season (also: July 1-13, 2021 vs. El Paso, at Round Rock; June 28-July 9, 2023 vs. El Paso, at Oklahoma City; Aug. 15-27, 2023 vs. El Paso, at Oklahoma City;

FIRST HALF: The Isotopes finished the first half 26-49, tied for the most losses among all 120 Minor League clubs (Chattanooga, 20-49) ... Albuquerque suffered one more defeat in the first half compared to last year, when they were 27-48 and also in last place.

KEEPIN' IT 100: For the year, the Isotopes have tallied 100 home runs and 100 stole bases. No other MiLB or MLB team has reached triple digits in both categories yet in 2024.

OPENING DAY 2.0: Noah Davis gets the nod for the start of the second half after getting the Opening Day start March 29 vs. El Paso.

RUNS ALLOWED: Albuquerque allowed eight or more runs in a contest for only the third time since June 2 Sunday, when they lost the series finale 13-2 vs. Oklahoma City.

DUBS: Albuquerque has won six of its last eight contests and

DINGERS: Albuquerque has belted a homer in 11-straight contests, a team-high for 2024 (previous: eight, May 7-15 ... During current stretch they've hit 21 homers.

ALLOWING DINGERS: The Isotopes pitching staff surrendered multiple home runs Sunday for the first time since June 14 vs. El Paso (two).

VS. OKC: Albuquerque finished 8-16 against Oklahoma City this season, their most defeats to one opponent in a campaign in club history.

ROLI: On Sunday, Ryan Rolison made his first appearance at Triple-A since June 2, 2023 at Salt Lake, retiring the side on eight pitches in the sixth inning. MR. JONES: Greg Jones was 2-for-4 Sunday, his second time racking up back-to-back multi-hit performances this season (also: April 9-10 vs. Sugar Land) ..._ Jones has reached base in 15 consecutive games started in Triple-A this season, dating back to April 9.

STOVIE: Hunter Stovall extended his hitting streak to eight games Sunday with a 2-for-4 afternoon, including an RBI single in the sixth inning. Stovall is 13-for-32 with four doubles, two homers and seven RBI during the stretch. ... Tied for the secondlongest active streak in the PCL.

TAKE FLIGHT: Jimmy Herron launched a two-run homer in the first inning Sunday, his sixth of the season and third in his last eight contests ... The two RBI marked his seventh multi-RBI game of the year.

HIS NAME IS DREW: Drew Romo went 3-for-5 Sunday, his 18th multi-hit game of the campaign but only second since May 18 ... He also had three knocks on June 1 vs. Oklahoma City, which was also his last three hit game and eighth contest with at least three hits.

REAL SLIM SCHUNKY: Aaron Schunk's 24 doubles are 3rdmost in all of MiLB.

JC: Julio Carreras swiped his 20th bag of the season last Wednesday, establishing a new career high.

PCL LEADERBOARD: Drew Romo is 6th in average (.306) Coco Montes is 1st in average (.356) ...
OPS (.965), T-3rd in triples (6), 4th in OBP (.414), 5th in slugging (.551), T-7th in total bases (140), T-9th in XBH (31) and T-10th in RBI (47) ... Julio Carreras is 6th in SB (20).

TEAM STATS: Offensively in MiLB, the club is 1st in triples (35), slugging (.477) and total bases (1,258), 2nd in hits (729), average (.276), and OPS (.834) and 6th in runs (438).

ERROR 404: Julio Carreras committed an error at second base Sunday, his 14th miscue of the season ... Carreras and his teammate Grant Lavigne (15) have the most errors of any Triple-A players.

RAIN. RAIN GO AWAY: This marks the third time the Isotopes have completed the first half of a campaign without having a game postponed. In the prior two occurrences (2005 and 2012), the first contest after the All-Star Break was rained out in Nashville each time.

NUCLEI NOTES

SKIPPER: Pedro Lopez enters his 20th year as a minor league manager and second guiding the Isotopes, the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1. Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

HOMETOWN KID: Jordan Pacheco begins his third season as the Isotopes hitting coach ... An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI) ... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his second season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five season with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his first year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... It's his second stop in Albuquerque after the former outfielder played in 33 games for the club and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the second-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 23) will host the second half winner (beginning June 25) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, Sept. 28.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Automated Ball-Strike System (ABS), now in its third year in the Pacific Coast League, will be used for all Monday-Thursday games while the Challenge System, second year in the PCL, will be used for all Friday-Sunday contests. Each team has three challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.

- Pitched for the 2017 Cotuit Kettlers of the Cape Cod League
