JACKSONVILLE BASHES SEVEN HOMERS, WINS 12-6

Jacksonville smashed seven home runs on Sunday in a 12-6 victory at Durham. Jakob Marsee led off the game with a long ball. After the Bulls took the lead, Brian Navarreto hit a three-run shot in the second. Rob Brantly's two-run homer in the third made it 8-5 before **Troy Johnston** added a solo shot in the sixth. With the score 9-6, Matt Mervis, Maximo Acosta and Jacob Berry hit back-to-back-to-back home runs in the ninth to set the final score at 12-6. Sunday's effort marked the most runs scored for the Jumbo Shrimp since a 15-3 win over Nashville on June 27.

SEVENTH HEAVEN

Heading into play on Sunday, the Jumbo Shrimp had maxed out with three home runs in a game on seven occasions in 2025. Jacksonville blasted seven home runs at Durham, the club's most in a game since also hitting seven on June 4. 2010 against Carolina. The main difference between Sunday's game and that 2010 contest against the Mudcats was seven different Jumbo Shrimp went yard on Sunday. Thanks to Mark Saccomanno's three homers in that 2010 contest, only five Suns hits a home run in that game.

MARSEE-SAW

Heading into play on June 8, Jakob Marsee was hitting just .193 with a .651 OPS. Since that point, the Allen Park, Mich., native has registered hits in 28 of his 38 starts, including 13 contests with multiple hits. During this stretch, Marsee is 46-for-144 (.319/.411/.639/1.050 at the plate with nine doubles, two triples, 11 home runs, 24 RBIs, 23 walks and 27 runs. On the season, Marsee leads the IL in steals (45) and walks (64). He also ranks tied for second in triples (5). 18th in OBP (.374), tied for 18th in homers (14) and tied for 21st in hits (84).

BERRY BLAST

Jacob Berry mustered a .126 batting average and .452 OPS with 35 strikeouts through his first 33 games this year. The former LSU Tiger has completely changed around his season since that point. Over his last 53 games, Berry has nearly drawn more walks (27) than strikeouts (28) while going 50for-162 (.309/.410/.506/.916) at the plate with 12 doubles, one triple, six home runs, 29 RBIs and 28 runs. He has the winning hit in four of Jacksonville's 12 last at-bat wins.

IT GFTS LATE FARLY

With their starters working such a small amount of innings, Jacksonville's bullpen has been forced to shoulder the load throughout the 2025 campaign, Jumbo Shrimp relief pitchers have worked 481.2, or 54.8 percent, of the club's 879.1 innings this season. Despite the huge workload, which marks tied for the fifth-most innings of any bullpen in Triple-A, Jacksonville relievers have posted the level's best BAA (.215) and second-best ERA (3.76).

THE MORE, THE MERRIER

In 2024, Jacksonville shattered the city's previous Double-A/ Triple-A era (1962-present) record of 20 different starting pitchers over the course of the season and used 28 different starters in 149 games. Meanwhile, through 101 games this season, the Jumbo Shrimp have already used 27 different starting pitchers. Perhaps unsurprisingly, Jacksonville starting pitchers have totaled just 397.2 innings (3.9 per start) this season, the fifth-fewest in Triple-A. That said their 3.71 starters' ERA ranks third at the level.

MEN OF STEAL

Over the last three seasons, Jacksonville ranked 23rd, 21st and 29th, respectively, in Triple-A in stolen bases. The club's 208 this season not only lead the entire level, but they are the most in a campaign for any Jacksonville team in the club's Double-A/Triple-A era (1962-present). No Jacksonville club has finished in the top five in their respective level in steals since at least 2005.

PARTY LIKE IT'S 1968

Tuesday's series opener between the Jumbo Shrimp and Clippers will mark the first visit for Columbus to Jacksonville since September 18, 1968, the final game of the 1968 Governors' Cup Finals, The Jacksonville Suns/Mets swept the Columbus Jets by scores of 6-1, 6-4, 2-1 (11 innings) and 3-1, with the final two games played at Wolfson Park. That 1968 title marks the city's lone Triple-A championship.

SHRIMP BITE

Jacksonville has cracked 63 home runs in the 38 games since June 10, the most in Triple-A. The club had hit only 52 bombs over the first 63 games of the season, tied for 26th in Triple-A.
