LAST GAME

Led early by another strong start from Brennan Hanifee, Bowie was able to halt a brief two-game skid on Wednesday, taking down Altoona 7-5. Bowie did build their lead to six runs over the first six innings, aided early by a pair of RBI by Connor Norby, a two-run home run by Coby Mayo, another RBI by Cody Roberts, and some miscues on the Altoona side to plate two runs. Hanifee tossed five innings for the Baysox to earn his second-consecutive win, only hampered by a solo home run by Jared Triolo. Altoona made a late jump against rehabbing Orioles pitcher Travis Lakins, when Fabricio Macias launched a three-run home run in the seventh inning, but Bowie never surrendered the lead.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

When Bowie and Altoona met less than a month ago, they were the top two teams in the league. Bowie took five-of-six in the series to send Altoona into the bottom half of the second half standings, where they've been slowly making a push back into playoff contention. The Curve have been run by their pitching staff in the second half, while they are among the bottom half in the league in runs scored, home runs, batting average, and OPS in the half. Despite allowing 56 runs in the six-game series to Bowie in late July, the most runs allowed in the league by nine that week, Altoona still sports a sub-4.00 ERA in the half, the third-best in the league.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Aaron Shortridge had a late start to the season, as he was recovering from Tommy John Surgery he underwent in January of 2021. Following three brief outings with Single-A, he made the jump up to Altoona at the end of June, and has been starting to get his legs under him at the new level. While he did allow a pair of home runs in his Double-A debut, he has only allowed three in the following 30 2/3 innings. Two of those home runs were from Bowie batters, however, as Shayne Fontana collected a solo shot, and Colton Cowser clubbed a grand slam. A fastball-slider pitcher, Shortridge has allowed a large ratio of fly balls in his time with Altoona.

JOLTIN' JOEY

Baysox infielder Joey Ortiz has had an incredible second half. Since the standings reset, Ortiz is slashing .333/.400/.596 with 11 home runs, 13 doubles, and just 27 strikeouts to 21 walks. His 61 hits since the start of the second half are tied for the most in Double-A. Ortiz was ranked as the Orioles #15 prospect entering the 2022 season according to MLB Pipeline, #16 according to Baseball America. He has already played more games this season than in 2021, due to a torn labrum in his left shoulder in late June that season.

I'VE GOT A FEVER, AND THE ONLY PRESCRIPTION IS MORE COWSER

Bowie outfielder Colton Cowser has been staying hot since his call up to Double-A to start the second half. Cowser went 3-for-4 on Wednesday with a double and two runs scored. Already established as a patient batter, Cowser leads the Eastern League with 34 walks since he debuted to start the second half. Cowser sports a 16.7% walk rate across the full season, third-best in the Orioles minor leagues. Cowser is ranked as the Orioles #4 prospect and #54 overall prospect by MLB Pipeline at the time of his promotion.

FRESH RANKINGS

With mid-season updates to top prospect lists, Bowie has reloaded themselves with some of the best talent in the Orioles organization. Ranked as the best farm system in baseball by *MLB Pipeline*, Bowie sports nine players among the update top-30 Orioles prospects. Colton Cowser (#4/#43 OVR), Coby Mayo (#7), Connor Norby (#12), Chayce McDermott (#14), Cade Povich (#15), Joey Ortiz (#19), Cesar Prieto (#21), John Rhodes (#23), Hudson Haskin (#24)
