Today: It's Michigan Baseball Hall of Fame Day, inducting **Fred Decker** and **Danny Litwhiler** as the Class of 2023, as the Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the fourth in a six-game series against the Lake County Captains, High-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. The Nuts are 7-8 against Lake County this year, winning two of the first three games in this series. LAFUC Fireworks will follow tonight's game.

About the Hall of Famers: An All-America outfielder at Western Michigan, **Fred Decker** went on to managed 29 seasons at WMU, setting school and MAC records for most career wins and most conference wins. The late **Danny "Skip" Litwhiler** is the winningest coach in Michigan State baseball history, coaching 19 seasons in East Lansing and introducing over 100 innovations to baseball, most notably the radar gun.

Last Night: Lugnuts 3, Captains 1. **Max Muncy** delivered a tie-breaking RBI single in the seventh inning and then robbed **Chase DeLauter** of a potential game-tying RBI single in the eighth, helping the Nuts top the Caps in a nailbiter. **Tyler Baum** recorded the five-out save, striking out **Jake Fox** with a 99-mph fastball to end it with the tying runs aboard.

Among the League Leaders: **Tyler Baum** is tied for first in saves (10); **Daniel Susac** is tied for fifth in triples (5), seventh in batting average (.283) and eighth in hits (72); and **Junior Pérez** is tied for sixth in steals (20).

All-Star Nuts: 2017 Lugnuts standouts **Bo Bichette** and **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.** will appear in the Major League Baseball All-Star Game, named All-Star reserve infielders on the American League squad. It is Guerrero's third consecutive All-Star Game appearance and Bichette's second All-Star nod, joining 2021.

The Future is Now: **Tyler Soderstrom** and **Lawrence Butler**, teammates on the 2022 Lugnuts will take part in the 2023 Sirius XM All-Star Futures Game. It is Butler's first Futures Game and Soderstrom's second; Tyler initially appeared in 2021 when he was playing for the Single-A Stockton Ports.

Roster Transaction: Earlier today outfielder **Colby Thomas** and infielder **Brennan Milone** joined the Lugnuts from the Single-A Stockton Ports. Thomas makes his debut as the designated hitter tonight, becoming the 913th Lugnut all-time. The 95th overall pick in last year's draft as Oakland's third-round selection, Thomas is ranked MLB Pipeline's No. 5 A's outfield prospect and No. 17 overall A's prospect.

Two for the Price of One: The Lugnuts' defense leads the league with 70 double plays this year, seven more than second-place South Bend and 43 more than 12th-place Quad Cities. The Nuts' 57 errors ranks third lowest in the circuit, with 38 errorless games this season.

Historic on the 4th: A crowd of 11,521 packed in to Jackson Field on July 4, the largest home attendance in Lansing since July 4, 2013. It was also the largest single game crowd in all of High-A, let alone the Midwest League, and an attendance larger than any crowd drawn by every Minor League Baseball team save for six Triple-A teams (Buffalo, Albuquerque, Salt Lake, Indianapolis, Norfolk and Round Rock) and one Double-A team (Frisco).

The Cycle: On June 21 at Wisconsin, **Jack Winkler** went 4-for-4 with a single, double, triple, home run and four RBIs, becoming the eighth player in team history to hit for the cycle. The other cycles: **Corey Patterson** (7/5/99 at South Bend); **Donnie Hood** (4/21/03 vs. Dayton); **Chip Cannon** (6/2/05 vs. Clinton); **Travis Snider** (7/7/07 at Fort Wayne); **Brad Glenn** (7/26/10 vs. Clinton); **Edward Olivares** (4/24/17 vs. South Bend); and **Ryan Gold** (4/18/19 vs. Dayton).

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has three players acquired via trade by the Oakland Athletics on its roster: **Christian Fernandez** (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); **Euribiel Ángeles** (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); and **Junior Pérez** (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo).

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lansing roster boasts Oakland's last two first-round selections.

- SS **Max Muncy** was taken 25th overall in 2021. MLB Pipeline ranks Muncy the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect.
- **Daniel Susac** went 19th overall in 2022 and is ranked the A's No. 2 catching prospect, trailing only No. 1 overall prospect Tyler Soderstrom.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2007: Travis Snider went 5-for-5, hitting for the cycle – in reverse order, no less, beginning with a first-inning home run – in the Lugnuts' 9-3 victory at the Fort Wayne Wizards.

2016: The Lugnuts overcame deficits of 6-0 and 9-3, scoring 11 unanswered runs for an electrifying 14-9 victory over the Dayton Dragons at Cooley Law School Stadium, improving the Nuts' record to 9-1 against Dayton. The Lugs scored five runs in the sixth, narrowing the Dayton lead to 9-8, and then six more runs in the eighth. 14 marked the most runs the Nuts had scored all season.

2019: A Copa de la Diversión Sunday at Classic Park: The Lansing Locos beat los Picantes de Lake County, 3-2, on Johnny Aiello's two-out bases-loaded walk in the top of the ninth. Makesiondon Kelkboom supplied a sacrifice fly in the loss for los Picantes.

Rave Reviews: Dicochea was promoted from Single-A Stockton to Lansing on June 13 to replace Jack Perkins, who was transferred up to Double-A Midland... coincidentally, an article about Dicochea had just been written by MLB.com A's beat writer Martín Gallegos a day earlier, quoting A's GM David Forst in including Dicochea's name among the top pitching prospects in the system (Royber Salinas, Gunnar Hoglund, J.T. Ginn and Joey Estes). Wrote Gallegos about Dicochea, "Dicochea, an eighth-round selection by the A's in the 2019 MLB Draft out of Sahuarita (Ariz.) High School, ranks just outside Oakland's Top 30 Prospects list. But his inclusion in that group from Forst speaks volumes about how highly he is viewed. In nine games (seven starts) for Single-A Stockton this season, Dicochea holds a 3.20 ERA with 47 strikeouts against 17 walks in 39 1/3 innings. He has held opposing batters to a .163 average, which ranks lowest among all California League pitchers with at least 30 innings pitched. Dicochea's development hit a snag early in his pro career after he underwent Tommy John surgery in 2021. Since his return from injury, the 22-year-old right-hander is taking a big step forward this season, showing off a fastball that consistently hits 95 mph along with a solid slider and a changeup he's recently added to his mix. A's assistant general manager and director of player personnel Billy Owens added, "He's off to a promising start. Averaging well over a strikeout per inning. Overall, his command has taken a step forward. He's definitely an interesting arm on the horizon."

Home Cooking: Also from Tucson: Alex Verdugo, four-time All-Star Ian Kinsler, two-time All-Star J.J. Hardy, Cardinals All-Star catcher Tom Paganuzzi and Ron Hassey... in all, Tucson ranks second behind Phoenix in producing Major Leaguers from the Grand Canyon State.

Glory Days: Boasting a 96 mph fastball, Dicochea was highly regarded coming out of Sahuarita High School, ranked the No. 1 prep prospect in Arizona by Baseball America entering the 2019 draft... twirled a no-hitter in the state semifinals... signed for \$400,000... signing scout: Scott Cousins... signed away from commitment to University of Arizona... senior year stats: 1.30 ERA, 54 IP, 24 H, 10 ER, 11 BB, 86 K... in addition to pitching, also starred at shortstop.

Minor League Path: Dicochea opened his professional career in the 2019 Arizona League after signing, but his 2021 campaign was halted in Single-A Stockton due to injury on June 6 after only six appearances, five starts... returned from Tommy John surgery on August 12, 2022, and made two appearances in the Arizona Complex League before returning to Stockton on August 26, 2022... finished the year with three appearances for the Ports.

Bagels in April: Opened 2023 as the Ports' No. 4 starter, firing four scoreless innings at Fresno on April 11... that was the start of three consecutive scoreless outings to begin the year, finishing April with 13 2/3 scoreless innings... didn't allow first run until May 3 vs. Fresno, entering in relief in the fifth inning and allowing two runs in the fifth and two more in the seventh in a 5-4 Ports win... in total with Stockton, posted a 2.42 ERA with a .132 average against in five road starts (22 1/3 IP) compared to 4.24 ERA, .200 avg. in four home appearances (17 IP)... lefties hit .111/.243/.175 compared to righties' .205/.279/.308... base stealers went 2-for-2.
