## FRES-NOTES

**STREAKS STACKED ON STREAKS:** Tanner Thach delivered a team high 19th multi-hit game of the season on Friday and now owns the longest active hitting streak in the California League at 14 consecutive games. Roldy Brito posted the longest hitting streak this season at 15 games and Thach is currently tied for the second longest this season with Derek Bernard, who had his snapped Thursday night.

**CROOKS KEEPS IT STRAIGHT:** Dylan Crooks has the longest scoreless streak and hitless streak among California League pitchers this year after another stellar outing Friday night. Crooks has not allowed an earned run in 12 innings, spanning his last nine appearances. He has not allowed a hit in seven appearances throughout the month of May. Crooks has 24 strikeouts this season across 16.1 innings and 13 appearances

**FAMILIAR FOE:** The Grizzlies have 33 official career at-bats among active players against Rancho's scheduled starter Trey Gregory-Alford. That includes 14 hits for a .424 batting average with ten different Grizzlies having faced him over the last two years across the Arizona Complex League and the California League.
