- The Blue Jays win streak was snapped at six games last night as Bradenton evened the series with a 7-1 win.
- Dunedin starter Juaron Watts-Brown struck out eight batters in four innings. After allowing an unearned run in the bottom of the third, he struck out three straight to end the inning. With runners on second and third, he did the same in the fourth.
- The Blue Jays stranded the bases loaded in the fourth against Marauders starter Antwone Kelly, who racked up seven strikeouts in four innings.
- Bradenton chased Watts-Brown in the fifth with an RBI double from Braylon Bishop.
- The Marauders busted the game open in the eighth inning, scoring four runs on five walks and two hits.
- Tucker Toman scored on a wild pitch in the top of the ninth to avoid the shutout, but the comeback effort stopped there.

BIG TIME BELTRE

Blue Jays No. 27 prospect Manuel Beltre has turned red-hot at the plate, hitting .350 over his last 10 games (14-40), including a 4-9 start to the week. Beltre has two hits in six of his last seven games. After hitting .236 in the opening month of the year, Beltre is hitting .294 this month, which has boosted his batting average to .264 for the season.

K COUNTER

The Blue Jays pitching staff tied a season-high with 15 strikeouts last night. Dunedin is now second in the FSL in punchouts with 431 this season (10.5 per game). On the flip side, the Jays lead the league with 213 walks issued (over 5 per game).

BIRTHDAY BOY

Today's starter, Grant Rogers, celebrated his 23rd birthday yesterday. Tonight's outing will mark his sixth of the season. The righthander has thrown six innings in back-to-back outings, but has allowed 5 ER in those 12 innings.

STREAK SNAPPED

Just as the Blue Jays' six-game win streak was snapped with last night's loss, Jean Joseph's 19-game on base streak went by the wayside. The 19 game stretch, which started on April 26, is the longest for the Blue Jays this season and tied for the longest in the FSL in 2024.

LATE MAGIC

Dunedin continued its trend of scoring late runs last night, their only run of the game in the ninth inning. The Blue Jays have scored in the seventh inning or later in 14 straight games, and 18 of their last 19 games. The Blue Jays hold a +12 run differential in the final three innings this season (74 runs scored, 62 runs allowed).

JAYS JUICE

The Blue Jays have homered in eight of their last 10 games. Across that stretch, seven different players have gone deep. Dunedin is tied third in the Florida State League with 26 homers. Both Dunedin and Bradenton have homered 15 times this month - tied for the most in the league.

GAINING LITTLE GROUND

Despite winning six straight games, the Blue Jays made little progress in the FSL-West standings, as first-place Clearwater also won six times in the last seven games. Entering action tonight, Dunedin trails the Threshers by eight games.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

Last night marked a rare lopsided loss for Dunedin, as 28 of the Blue Jays 41 games this season have been decided by four or fewer runs. Dunedin has an 13-15 record in those games. Each of the Blue Jays' last four wins have required saves.

BACK IN THE SERIES WIN COLUMN

Last week's series victory was the Jays' first set win since April 9-14 at Tampa, when the team took five of six games. Dunedin's five game win streak is the team's longest since they won six straight from April 6-12.
