ALL-STAR BREAK

WELCOME TO THE CRETACEOUS: The Trash Pandas continue the second half of their 12-game homestand on Thursday night, with game three of a six-game series against the Chattanooga Lookouts at Toyota Field. Rocket City took four of six games from the Pensacola Blue Wahoos to start the homestand.

GORDON-SAURUS REX: Panda starter Austin Gordon earned his second win of the season by tossing a career-high 7.0 innings, allowing one run on five hits while striking out six in Rocket City's 3-1 victory over Chattanooga. Tucker Flint and J.J. D'Orazio each homered, and the trio of Gordon, Chris Cortez, and Luke Murphy retired the final 16 Lookouts batters to even the series. Murphy recorded his Minor League-leading 16th save and extended his scoreless streak to 25 consecutive appearances.

TUCKER-SAURUS REX: Over his last 27 games since June 6, OF Tucker Flint is batting .312 with five doubles, five home runs, 18 RBIs, 20 walks, and a .443 OBP. Flint has homered in two-straight games, and has reached base safely 21 times over his current 9-game on-base streak, batting .375, with a .512 OBP.

MIDWEEK METEOR: With last night's victory over the Lookouts, the Pandas improved to 12-2 on Wednesday's in 2026, including a perfect 7-0 at Toyota Field.

DINO-MITE OFFENSE: Rocket City is 5-3 during the homestand while averaging 6.4 runs per game. Tucker Flint is batting .429 (12-for-26) with 11 RBIs, and has scored a run in all eight games. Jake Munroe is hitting .419 (13-for-31) with four doubles, and seven RBIs. Jake Thompson has nine RBIs and a grand slam, Mac McCroskey is batting .304 (7-for-23), and has reached base 15 times with eight walks, and David Calabrese is batting .308 (8-for-26) with two doubles, and a home run.

DIGGING UP THE PAST: Rocket City took four of six games from Pensacola, securing its first-ever season series victory over the Blue Wahoos with an 8-4 mark. The Pandas' offense was among the hottest in Double-A during, batting .302 while leading the league with 62 hits and scoring 45 runs, the fourth-most in Double-A baseball during the week. The Trash Pandas recorded two Toyota Field-record eight-run innings—in the sixth inning of a 16-6 win on July 2 and the eighth inning of a 14-6 victory on July 4.

RAKING LIKE A RAPTOR: OF Jake Thompson wasted no time making an impression after joining the Angels organization from the Atlantic League's Lancaster Stormers. Thompson has four extra-base hits, including a grand slam, eight RBIs in his first two games.

HATCHING A HYBRID: Since his June 23 promotion, 20-year-old catcher Juan Flores is batting .270 (10-for-37) with two home runs in his first 10 Double-A games. His first homer came on the opening pitch of his Double-A career before he followed it with a 422-foot drive in his Toyota Field debut.

RAUDI-SAURUS-REX: Through 77 games, Raudi Rodriguez is the only Double-A player with 80+ hits, 10+ homers, 60+ runs, 40+ RBIs, 50+ walks, 20+ stolen bases, and a .400+ OBP. He has reached base safely in 18 of his last 20 games since June 13, batting .347 with four home runs, three doubles, 10 RBIs, 15 walks, and 13 runs scored.

TOP OF THE FOOD CHAIN: Raudi Rodriguez is 1st in runs scored (62), 3rd in OBP (.413), 4th in hits (81), 5th in batting average (.293), T-5th in games played (77), 8th in total bases (130), 6th in OPS (.884), 2nd in walks (54), and 10th in slugging (.476) ... Tucker Flint is 3rd in games played (79), T-5th in runs (50), and 4th in walks (49), 8th in OBP (.372), 8th in RBIs (49) ... Nick Rodriguez is 1st in doubles (21), and 8th in games played (75), and 9th in hits (74) ... Joel Hurtado is 1st in ERA (3.42), T-3rd in starts (16), 5th in innings pitched (79.0), 3rd in WHIP (1.18), 4th in BAA (.220), and T-7th in wins (5) ... Ryan Costeiu is T-3rd in wins (6), and 6th in strikeouts (74) ... Austin Gordon is T-1st in starts (17), 9th in innings pitched (74.2), 9th in WHIP (1.37), and T-7th in BAA (.257) ... Kenyon Yovan is T-3rd in appearances (28), and T-2nd in saves (6), Leonard Garcia is T-1st in appearances (29) ... Luke Murphy is 1st in saves (16), and T-1st in appearances (29).

THE APEX PITCHER: Joel Hurtado leads the Southern League with a 3.42 ERA over 16 starts. Over his last 12 starts, since April 29, Hurtado has a 2.62 ERA, tops in the league, and 2nd in Double-A.

THE EXTINCTION EVENT: After another save on Wednesday night, Luke Murphy continues to lead all of Minor League Baseball with 16 saves. Murphy has allowed just 1 earned run over 29 games and 31.0 innings (0.29 ERA), 9 walks, and 39 strikeouts, and no earned runs over his last 25 outings, 27.1 innings, 5 walks, and 34 strikeouts.

JURASSIC ARMS: Over the last 56 games (since May 3), the Trash Pandas own a 3.96 ERA, ranking 2nd in the Southern League, 2nd in Double-A, and 6th among all full-season Minor League clubs.

SNEAD-ACTYL: Nate Snead matched a career high with 6.0 innings in last Friday's 4-1 win over Pensacola, allowing one run on three hits while walking none on just 62 pitches. After allowing 15 runs over his first five Double-A starts, the Angels' No. 14 prospect has surrendered just one run over his last 11.0 innings, walking none and striking out seven.

BULLPENASAUROS: The bullpen had a 5.38 ERA over the first 26 games, with six blown saves. Over 55 games since May 3, they are tops in Double-A, and 3rd among full-season MiLB teams with a 3.42 ERA, and T-2nd with 19 saves.

ANOTHER EXPEDITION: This week marks the third of four series between the Trash Pandas and Chattanooga in 2026. Rocket City is 8-6 against the Reds' Double-A affiliate this season and is 78-79 over the all-time series, including a 40-39 record at Toyota Field. The clubs will meet one final time Sept. 8-13 at Erlanger Park to close the regular season.

FUTURE PREDATORS: The Trash Pandas feature seven of the Angels' top 30 prospects according to MLB Pipeline.

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ROSTER CHANGES: Since June 9, the Trash Pandas have added seven new players to the active roster, including four on June 23, and five promoted from High-A Tri-City. OF **Jake Thompson** (6/30/Indy), C **Juan Flores** (6/23/A+), INF **Jake Munroe** (6/23/A+), LHP **Kucas Knowles** (6/23/A+), LHP **Blake Weiman** (6/23/ACL), INF **Caleb Bartolero** (6/9/A+), and OF **Anthony Scull** (6/9/A+).

SCULL STREAKING: After starting his time in Rocket City 1-for-17, Anthony Scull has now hit in seven-straight games since June 17, batting .333 with a home run, and three RBIs.

HOME SWEET HOME: Rocket City is in the midst of their longest home stretch of the season, playing 18 of 21 games at Toyota Field from June 30-July 28. The Trash Pandas host Pensacola and Chattanooga over the next two weeks before welcoming Knoxville July 21-26, with their only road trip during the stretch coming July 17-19 in Birmingham following the All-Star break.

RECORD SETTING NIGHT: Rocket City set new Toyota Field single-game records with 16 runs and 16 hits in Thursday's win over Pensacola. The eight-run sixth inning was the first eight-run frame by the Trash Pandas at Toyota Field and their biggest inning since scoring eight runs at Chattanooga on June 28, 2024.

KRUZEL REACHES 500 CAREER WINS: The June 6, 2-1 victory over Columbus at Toyota Field marked the 500th career managerial win for Joe Kruzel. In his first season with Rocket City, Kruzel reached the milestone in his ninth year as a manager across stops in the Reds, Cardinals, and Angels organizations.

RETURN OF THE MECK: Anaheim native **Wade Meckler** was promoted from Rocket City to Los Angeles on May 22, and homered off Jacob deGrom in his first MLB at-bat since 2023. Meckler added his first career grand slam on May 30. He's finished 13th in All-Star voting among AL outfielders with 306,875 votes.

LOST PRODUCTION: Over the last 6 weeks, the Trash Pandas have lost three key pieces of their lineup. **Wade Meckler** (promoted to Los Angeles), **Matthew Lugo** (claimed off waivers by KC), and **Gustavo Campero** (right hand fracture) combined for 116 hits, 36 extra-base hits, 78 runs, 66 RBIs, and 28 stolen bases.

MEANINGFUL MAY: After completing the May 31 suspended game on Tuesday, the Trash Pandas set a new club record for wins in May, going 16-11 (15-11 in '22), and posted a 3.50 ERA as a team, which was the tops in Double-A, and 4th in all of Minor League Baseball.

MR. PANDA?: OF **Tucker Flint** surpassed **Orlando Martinez** for the most games played for Rocket City with his 297th appearance on May 19.

HIGH SCHOOL TEAMMATES REUNITE: RHP **Camden Minacci**, and INF **Nick Rodriguez** reunite in Rocket City after being teammates at Tampa Jesuit High School. Minacci was the Florida 6A Player of the Year in 2020, and Rodriguez, a year younger, graduating in 2021. Both played under head coach Miguel Menendez.

GLOBAL BASEBALL SERIES: The Trash Pandas picked up a 6-3 win over Japan's Toyota Red Cruisers on April 1 at Toyota Field. **Tucker Flint** led the way offensively, homering twice and reaching base four times. The victory capped the three-game Global Baseball Series in front of a crowd of 4,355. The Red Cruisers are the official industrial team for TOYOTA Japan.

SEASON TURNAROUND: The Trash Pandas went 45-92 in 2025, a 32.8% winning percentage, which was the worst in Southern League history. The club finished fourth in the Southern League's North Division, 35.5 games out of first place, and was 24-45 at Toyota Field and 21-47 on the road. The Trash Pandas have already won 37 games in 2026.

NEW TO THE ANGELS ORGANIZATION: **Elijah Dunham** (NYY), **Blake Weiman** (HOU), **Lucas Knowles** (WAS), **Jose Gonzalez** (TEX), **Eyeberson Polanco** (Rule 5, BOS), **Lucas Knowles** (WAS), and **JJ D'Orazio** (ARI), and **Jake Thompson** (MIA) are all making their Angels organizational debut this season

LAUNCHED TO THE LEAGUE: RHP **Brett Kerry** became the 51st player in franchise history to make their Major League debut, doing so during the Los Angeles Angels' game on June 17 against the Diamondbacks at Chase Field. Kerry joins fellow pitching alums **Samy Nater**, (6/6 for LAA), **Coleman Crow** (4/17 for MIL), **Walbert Urena** (3/26 for LAA) and **George Klassen** (4/5 for LAA) on making their MLB debuts this season. Kerry was a member of the franchise's inaugural team, Kerry spent parts of four seasons with Rocket City from 2021-24 and remains the club's all-time leader in wins (13), innings pitched (292.1), strikeouts (310), and starts (49). LHP **Samy Nater Jr.** has the claim of being the 50th to debut, 50th former Trash Panda to make his Major League debut The Juárez, Mexico native tossed 2.0 hitless innings with three strikeouts against the Dodgers in his debut after emerging as one of the Angels' top relief prospects in 2025, posting a 4-1 record, 2.64 ERA, 68 strikeouts, and eight saves in 41 appearances with Rocket City, after reaching the Double-A level in 2024. RHP **Coleman Crow**, originally selected by the Angels, Crow was acquired by Milwaukee in December 2023 after prior stints in the Angels and Mets organizations. Crow spent part of the 2022-23 season with Rocket City, where he ranked among the franchise's career leaders in innings pitched (152), strikeouts (159), wins (11), and starts (27). He earned Southern League Pitcher of the Week honors three times in 2022 and was named Pitcher of the Month in June of that season. Notably, Crow threw six hitless innings in a combined no-hitter on April 8, 2023, vs. Chattanooga, in a seven-inning game at Toyota Field. The infamous game included Rocket City issuing five walks, four hit batters, and committing an error, allowing seven runs without surrendering a hit—one of the rare instances in professional baseball history of a team throwing a no-hitter and losing. RHP **George Klassen** made his Major League debut with the Los Angeles Angels on April 5 against Seattle at Angel Stadium, becoming the 48th former Trash Panda to reach the Majors, and second so far in 2026. A native of West Bend, Indiana, Klassen worked 2.2 innings, allowing two runs while striking out four, and the Angels went on to win the game 8-7 in 11 innings. Ranked as the Angels' No. 4 prospect by MLB Pipeline, Klassen was a key member of Rocket City's 2025 rotation, earning a Futures Game selection and ranking among the franchise leaders in starts during his first full Double-A season. RHP **Walbert Urena** became the 47th player in franchise history to make his Major League debut, doing so during the Los Angeles Angels' Opening Day win over the Houston Astros on March 26.

NEW COACHING STAFF: **Joe Kruzel** was named manager of the Rocket City Trash Pandas prior to the 2026 season, becoming the third manager in franchise history following **Jay Bell** (2021) and **Andy Schatzley** (2022-25). Kruzel enters the role with more than 30 years of coaching experience at the professional and collegiate levels. The 2026 season marks his first year managing in the Angels' system after serving four seasons in a developmental leadership role. His all-time managerial record is 473-472. Joining Kruzel in Madison this season are **Daren Brown** (Coach), **Tim Leveque** (Pitching Coach), **Doug Henry** (Assistant Pitching Coach), **Tony Jaramillo** (Hitting Coach), **Dylan Cutwell** (Athletic Trainer), **Chase Galloway** (Assistant Athletic Trainer), **Matt Gabriel** (Strength and Conditioning Coach), **Tristan Saglime** (Game Planning Strategist), and **Joe Wike** (Video Assistant).
