YESTERDAY: Xzavion Curry shut out Great Lakes over 5.1 innings to lead the Captains to a 6-1 victory. Curry held the Loons to three hits, walked one and struck out four. The Captains scored two runs in the third on a **José Tena** single and added a run in the fourth on a throwing error by Loons right fielder Andy Pages. Lake County tacked on three runs in the seventh on an RBI triple by **Julian Escobedo**, an RBI single by **Christian Cairo** and a wild pitch. **Jerson Ramirez** inherited a bases loaded situation in the ninth and recorded the final two outs to earn the save and secure the win for Curry.

PRESSURE PACKED: The last nine Captains games have featured opponents in the top two spots in the High-A Central East Division standings. Every game has pitted the Captains against a team within 1.0 game of Lake County in the standings.

PLAYOFF PICTURE: The Captains enter today 2.0 game behind the Cedar Rapids Kernels for the second playoff spot in the High-A Central League (HAC). Lake County, Cedar Rapids, the Dayton Dragons and the Great Lakes Loons are all separated by just 3.5 games. The Quad Cities River Bandits currently hold the top playoff spot and are 10.5 games ahead of second place. The top two teams in the HAC earn playoff bids (regardless of division).

ARCH NEMESIS: The Great Lakes Loons are the only team against whom the Captains have a losing record this season (8-13). Lake County also has its worst run differential (-57), ERA (6.50) and opponent's OPS (.915) against Great Lakes.

NO TRAFFIC: In the month of August, the Captains' pitching staff owns the league's lowest WHIP (1.16), has allowed the second-fewest hits (151) and has the second-lowest batting average against (.217). Their WHIP is the third-lowest in all of High-A, while their hit total and batting average against are sixth-lowest.

WALK THIS WAY: The Captains' offense enters today leading the High-A Central League with the most walks in August (93). Lake County has not finished a month above fourth in the league in that category this year.

HOME COOKIN' TASTES BETTER: The Captains have a better record at home (27-18) compared to on the road (25-28). Lake County's run differential, however, is better on the road (even) compared to at home (-16).

NEW BLOOD: 3B **Jhonkensy Noel** joined the Captains on August 17. The 20-year old led all of Low-A (minimum 160 PA) with a .393 batting average and a 190 wRC+, while hitting 11 homers. INF **Christian Cairo** and OF **Jonathan Rodriguez** joined the Captains on August 24. Cairo led Low-A Lynchburg with 37 walks and held a .364 on-base percentage, which led all Hillcats (minimum 200 PA). Rodriguez slashed .314/.363/.450 with the Hillcats, good for an .812 OPS

BIG LEAGUE REHAB: RHP **Aaron Civale** will make a rehab start for the Captains tonight as he works to return from a right middle finger sprain. Civale pitched for the Captains in 2017 and is now in his third major league season, all with Cleveland. Civale owns a career 3.53 ERA in the majors. OF **Harold Ramirez** is also making a rehab start with the Captains for the third time in four nights. Ramirez is in his first season with the Cleveland organization after breaking into the big leagues with Miami. He is coming back from right knee soreness.

HIGH-A: The 2021 season marks the Captains' first as the High-A Affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. Lake County had been Cleveland's Low-A Affiliate for 17 seasons (2003-2019) and 18 years (2003-2020).

REHAB: Civalé made a rehab start for Double-A Akron on Sunday. The right-hander pitched two innings (39 pitches) and held the Harrisburg Senators (Nationals) hitless with two walks and two strikeouts.

2021 + INJURY: Began the season 10-2 with a 3.32 ERA before being sidelined with a right middle finger sprain. Civalé has been out since June 22 and is currently on the 60-Day Injured List.

2020: Averaged over 6.0 innings per start in his first "full" Major League season. Made every turn in the rotation and finished third in the AL with 74.0 IP, but also allowed the most hits (82) in the league. Civalé's 11 starts of 6+ innings tied Yu Darvish (Cubs) and Lance Lynn (Rangers) for the MLB lead.

2019: Began the season ranked as Cleveland's 19th-best prospect according to *MLB.com*. Started the season at Double-A Akron. Promoted to Triple-A Columbus in early June. Made his MLB debut on June 22, 2019 against Detroit and allowed just two hits over six shutout innings to earn the win. Posted a 2.34 ERA over 10 big league starts that season, which ranked as the third-lowest ERA in MLB among pitchers with 10 or more starts.

AS A CAPTAIN: Part of a 2017 staff that included Shane Bieber and later Zach Plesac (who joined after Bieber and Civalé were promoted). Civalé made 10 starts and went 2-4 with a 4.58 ERA. Between Low-A Lake County and High-A Lynchburg, Civalé led the organization in wins and ranked second among Cleveland minor leaguers with 164.2 innings pitched.

TOP PITCHER: Cleveland selected Civalé with the 92nd overall pick in last year's draft. That selection made Civalé the top pitcher selected by the organization in the 2016 MLB Draft.

CONVERTED RELIEVER: Civalé pitched the first two years of his collegiate career as a reliever for Northeastern and transitioned to a starting role last year. Civalé went from throwing 41.2 innings in 2015 to 152 innings last year (114.1 with Northeastern; 37.2 with Mahoning Valley). Despite the increase in innings, Civalé pitched markedly better last year. As a reliever, he posted ERA's of 3.19 and 3.24. As a starter, the righty had a 1.73 ERA with Northeastern and a 1.67 ERA with Mahoning Valley.

BIG LEAGUE EXPERIENCE IN COLLEGE: Civalé pitched against the Boston Red Sox in a Spring Training exhibition in 2015. The lineup included David Ortiz, Mookie Betts, Dustin Pedroia, Mike Napoli, Xander Bogaerts, Hanley Ramirez and Pablo Sandoval. Civalé allowed no hits and struck out Ortiz, Ramirez, Napoli and Bogaerts. Civalé grew up in Connecticut as a Red Sox fan.

COLLEGE COACH: Civalé's head coach at Northeastern was Mike Glavine, the brother of Hall of Famer Tom Glavine. Mike was selected by the Indians in the 22nd round of the 1995 MLB Draft.

COLLEGE MAJOR: Civalé majored in engineering at Northeastern.
