YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Akron RubberDucks, 11-7. The game was played in 3 hours and 46 minutes, which tied the longest nine-inning home game in the franchise's history (matching the game this season against Hartford on May 6). Akron opened a 2-0 lead in the second inning with a solo homer by Jose Fermin and a RBI double by Marcos Gonzalez. The Flying Squirrels answered with five runs, all with two outs, in the bottom of the third inning. **Sandro Fabian** and **Frankie Tostado** hit back-to-back RBI singles to tie the game. **Will Wilson** put the Flying Squirrels ahead, 4-2, with a two-run double. **Jacob Heyward** capped the five-run frame with an RBI single. Akron responded with five runs in the fourth, including a three-run homer by Eric Rodriguez. Will Brennan pushed the RubberDucks' lead to 9-5 in the sixth with a two-run single. Victor Nova brought in two runs with a single in the seventh to open Akron's lead to 11-5. Heyward hit a two-run homer, his 10th of the season, in the bottom of the seventh inning. **Ryan Walker** and **Frank Rubio** combined for 2.1 scoreless relief innings for Richmond.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the fourth of a six-game series against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. Richmond has gone 28-34 against Southwest Division opponents this season, including a 15-18 mark at The Diamond. This series is the final homestand of the year for the Flying Squirrels and the only trip to Richmond for the RubberDucks. The RubberDucks won five of six games in Akron against the Flying Squirrels in the only other series between the two teams this year from July 20-25. Today marks the latest into the calendar the Flying Squirrels have ever played a regular-season game.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 15-21 since July 21 but have won nine of the last 13 games since August 18. They are in fourth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 13.0 games behind first-place Akron. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked tied for eighth in the league with a .239 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked third in the league with a 3.99 ERA for the season.

THE RUBBERDUCKS have won seven of the last nine games. They won the first five games of last week's series against Altoona before dropping Sunday's finale. The Akron offense is ranked third in the league with a .256 team batting average. The pitching staff is second with a 3.56 team ERA. Akron's roster includes nine of MLB.com's top-30 Cleveland prospects, including INF Tyler Freeman (No. 1 - on IL), OF George Valera (No. 2), C Bo Naylor (No. 6), INF Brayan Rocchio (No. 7), LHP Logan Allen (No. 10), RHP Peyton Battenfield (No. 17), RHP Ethan Hankins (No. 21 - on IL), RHP Carlos Vargas (No. 27 - on IL) and OF Will Brennan (No. 29).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Aaron Blair** makes his eighth start for the Flying Squirrels and his second against the RubberDucks. He last pitched on August 28 at Altoona and allowed two runs over 2.0 innings of work on 50 pitches in a 15-3 Richmond win. It was his shortest start since his Richmond debut at Akron on July 24, when he worked into the third but did not record an out in that inning, allowing three runs after departing the game. Blair began the season with the independent West Virginia Power and had his contract selected by the San Francisco Giants on July 23. He made his first start of the year on May 29 against Southern Maryland, picking up a win after allowing one run over 5.0 innings with six strikeouts. He began a start on June 3 against Long Island but left in the first inning with an injury before the game was suspended for rain. Blair was the 36th-overall pick in the 2013 MLB Draft by the Arizona Diamondbacks out of Marshall University, the highest draft pick in the school's history. He was traded to the Atlanta Braves in December 2015 along with Dansby Swanson and Ender Inciarte for pitchers Shelby Miller and Gabe Speier. Blair reached the majors for the first time in 2016 with the Braves. He missed most of the 2018 season and all of 2019 after undergoing shoulder surgery. He signed with the Arizona Diamondbacks in 2020 but was released in May after the MiLB season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. **For more on Blair, see page two.**

FOR AKRON: Left-hander Konnor Pilkington makes his sixth Double-A Northeast start and his seventh overall appearance for the team. Last time out, he picked up a win after working 5.2 scoreless innings in a combined shutout against the Curve last Saturday. Pilkington was drafted in the third round in 2018 by the Chicago White Sox out of Mississippi State. He began this season with the Birmingham Barons in the Double-A South, going 4-4 with a 3.48 ERA. He was traded to Cleveland on July 29 for 2B Cesar Hernandez. He has made one relief appearance this year, following a rehab start by Aaron Civale on August 22 at Canal Park with 5.0 scoreless innings. Pilkington has not allowed an earned run in his last three appearances dating back to August 22, spanning 15.2 innings.

BIG FLIES IN BUNCHES: The Flying Squirrels have hit 33 homers in the last 19 games since August 10. In that stretch, **David Villar** has eight homers, **Diego Rincones** has six home runs, **Sandro Fabian** has four, **Brandon Martorano**, **Andres Angulo**, **Will Wilson**, **Jacob Heyward** and **Heath Quinn** have two and **Vince Fernandez**, **Shane Matheny**, **Mitchell Tolman**, **Frankie Tostado** and **Simon Whiteman** each have one. All but two active Richmond position players have homered in that span.

POWER SURGE: This season, the Flying Squirrels rank sixth in the Double-A Northeast with 116 home runs. On August 24, **Andres Angulo** hit the team's 110th home run of the season, breaking the previous franchise record of 109 from 2013. This year, the team has combined for a .401 slugging percentage, which is seventh in the league but would be the highest in the franchise's history (Ahead of a .382 mark from 2013). The Flying Squirrels have hit 56 homers in home games at The Diamond this year, the most in franchise history.

LEAVING THE YARD: The 2021 Flying Squirrels have seven players who have reached double-digits in home runs this season, including **David Villar** (19), **Vince Fernandez** (14), **Sandro Fabian** (13), **Frankie Tostado** (11), **Heliot Ramos** (10), **Diego Rincones** (10) and **Jacob Heyward** (10). Seven players with 10 or more homers is a new franchise record, surpassing the 2013 season, which included **Jarrett Parker** (18 - tied for most in a season in team history), **Adam Duval** (17), **Javier Herrera** (16), **Andrew Susac** (12) and **Mark Minicozzi** (10).

BACK IN THE SWING OF THINGS: On August 12 at Bowie, Villar snapped a season-high stretch of 25 games without a homer. In his last 18 games since August 12, **David Villar** is batting .385 (25-for-65) with eight homers, eight doubles and 20 RBIs. On Wednesday, he hit his 19th home run on the season, surpassing **Jarrett Parker** (2013) and **Mario Lissou** (2014) for the most home runs in a season in franchise history. He is the first Giants' Double-A player to hit 19 home runs in a season since Brett Pill in 2009 with the Connecticut Defenders.

FABULOUS FABIAN: Over the last 20 games since August 10, **Sandro Fabian** is hitting .333 (26-for-78) with four homers and 21 RBIs. He has 13 home runs this year, which is a new career high. Fabian has picked up 17 RBIs over the last 16 games since August 14, with multiple RBIs in five of those contests. On Wednesday, he picked up three hits for the fifth time this year and the third time since August 12. He added two hits on Thursday night.

GO, DIEGO, GO!: Over his last 37 games since July 17, **Diego Rincones** is batting .333 (45-for-135) with 10 homers, seven doubles, one triple and 27 RBIs. Over his last 26 games since August 3, Rincones is batting .360 (36-for-100) with six homers, six doubles and 16 RBIs. He has 12 multi-hit performances in his last 26 games played. He added a walk-off single on August 20 to cap a three-run bottom of the ninth for the Flying Squirrels in a 7-6 win over the SeaWolves. On Tuesday, he hit his 15th overall homer of the season (10 with Richmond).

TAKE A WALK: In 2019, **Jacob Heyward** set the single-season franchise record with 80 walks, surpassing the previous mark held by **Mark Minicozzi**, who walked 62 times in 2013. Heyward has walked 31 times this season. For his career with the Flying Squirrels, Heyward has worked 111 walks, which sits him in second in the team's history in career walks. The franchise career walks record is held by **Ricky Dropesa**, who walked 113 times in his four seasons with Richmond from 2013-2016.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **David Villar** is ranked tied for seventh with 19 homers, seventh with a .372 OBP, fifth with a .506 SLG, seventh with an .878 OPS, tied for fifth with 98 hits, tied for seventh with 25 doubles, tied for 10th with 42 walks, fifth with 44 extra-base hits, fourth with 180 total bases and sixth with 64 runs scored. **Simon Whiteman** is ninth with 17 stolen bases. **Trenton Toplikar** is eighth with a 5.10 ERA and 10th with 84.2 IP. **Joey Marciano** (35/T-3rd), **Patrick Ruotolo** (35/T-3rd), **Frank Rubio** (34/8th) and **Matt Seelinger** (33/T-9th) are in the top-10 in the league in games pitched. **Patrick Ruotolo** is fifth with nine saves and **R.J. Dabovich** is tied for 10th with six saves.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have three players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Will Wilson** (10), **Diego Rincones** (23) and **R.J. Dabovich** (30). **Simon Whiteman** is rated by *Baseball America* as being the "Fastest Baserunner" in the Giants system and Rincones is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Wilson (15) is also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
