**Today:** Two teams riding five-game winning streaks meet up in the opener of a six-game series, as the Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, welcome in the Great Lakes Loons, High-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers, the 269th all-time meeting between the two teams. (The previous 268 have been split evenly, 134-134.) The Lugnuts are coming off winning five of six games at Dayton while Great Lakes won the final five games in a home series against Peoria.

**Off the Field:** Tonight is a Tacos and Tallboys Night, with \$4 tacos and \$4 cervezas!

**Starting Matchup:** Each team is expecting to use a tandem of right-handers, with Lansing sending 6-foot-9 right-hander **Jorge Juan**, coming off five strikeouts in three innings at Dayton, followed by 6-foot-6 right-hander **Grant Holman**, who struck out six in three innings against the Dragons, while Great Lakes counters with right-handers **Nick Frasso** (acquired via trade with Toronto) and **River Ryan** (acquired via trade with San Diego) making their second Loons appearances.

**Last Game:** Lugnuts 7, Dragons 5 (10 innings). Left fielder **Patrick McColl** rallied the Nuts from a 4-2 deficit with RBIs in the 6th and 8th innings, and **Joshwan Wright**, **Denzel Clarke** and **Sahid Valezuela** drilled RBI doubles in a three-run 10th inning, leading the Lugnuts' fifth consecutive triumph at Day Air Ballpark.

### LUG•NOTES

**Skipper for the Series:** Lugnuts manager **Phil Pohl** is away for this week; **Veronica Alvarez** steps in as interim Lugnuts manager through Sunday. Today, Alvarez becomes the first woman to manage the Lugnuts in team history. A standout at Villanova, Alvarez served as the starting catcher for Team USA Baseball Women's National Team, winning medals in 2008 (bronze), 2010 (bronze), 2012 (silver) and 2015 (gold). She joined the Team USA's coaching staff as assistant coach in 2018, rising to manager of the Women's National Team beginning in 2019, when she led Team USA to a 7-0 record and the gold medal at the Women's Baseball World Cup Qualifier in Mexico, earning her the honor of 2019 USA Baseball Rod DeDeaux Coach of the Year. Since 2019, she has worked as a coach in Spring Training for the Oakland Athletics. In her spare time, she has pursued her other passion, serving as a firefighter-paramedic back home in Hollywood, Florida.

**On the Subject of Streaks:** The Lugnuts' current five-game winning streak is the first time that the Nuts won five straight games since a five-game winning streak on August 9-14, 2019, when Lansing was in Single-A and affiliated with the Toronto Blue Jays. The last six-game Lugnuts winning streak was August 4-10, 2018. (The Nuts had previously won seven straight and nine straight games during that 2018 season.)

**Keep an Eye Out for Goose Eggs:** The last five games the Lugnuts have won against the Great Lakes Loons, the Nuts have outscored the Loons 23-2 with three of the team's seven shutouts this year. On the other hand, the Loons have not scored fewer than four runs in any of their 10 victories this year against the Nuts.

**Competitive Baseball:** Though the Nuts won five of six at Dayton, each game was been tight. Two games went to extra innings and five of the games were decided by two runs or fewer. The only game decided by more than two runs, Wednesday, went to extra innings tied at 2-2 before the Lugnuts scored four runs to grab a 6-2 win.

**Prospect Packed:** The Lugnuts have seven of the Athletics' Top 30 prospects according to MLB Pipeline; elsewhere in the organization, two A's prospects are in the Majors (**JP Sears** and **Jonah Bride**); four are in Triple-A, nine are in Double-A (including **Jeff Criswell**, **Brett Harris** and **Tyle Soderstrom** who were in Lansing earlier this year); one is in Single-A (**Gunnar Hoglund**); three are in Rookie ball and two are on the Injured List (**Mason Miller** and **Lawrence Butler**).

**Running Men:** OF **Lazaro Armenteros** successfully stole two bases on Sunday, giving the Lugnuts 19 steals in 23 attempts through 11 games in August. The increasingly aggressive Lugnuts had eight stolen bases in April, 14 in May, 18 in June and 31 in July.

**Amongst the League Leaders:** The Lugnuts are third in the Midwest League in team batting average (.245) and third in base hits (864). Reliever **Kumar Nambiar** is tied for first in the league with West Michigan's **Andrew Magno** with 38 appearances. Infielder **Euribiel Angeles** is sixth with 96 base hits.

- Phil briefly played for the independent Laredo Lemurs in 2015, managed by Pete Incaviglia, hitting .311/.407/.473 with three home runs in 23 games. Laredo finished 57-43 and won the American Association championship.
- Since Phil is a native of Cooperstown, the National Baseball Hall of Fame is following his career closely. His gameworn Lugnuts baseball cap from the season's first weekend was sent to the Hall of Fame, by request.

**Inside the Park and Out of This World:** On August 2-3, 2022, CF **Denzel Clarke** joined Fred Bello (Everett, July 2-3, 2010) as the only Minor Leaguers since 2005 to have inside-the-park home runs in back-to-back games. The feat has never occurred in the Major Leagues.

**Roster Crunch:** The Lugnuts have used 51 different players this year: 25 position players and 26 pitchers (plus two position players pitching), with 18 different starting pitchers.

**From Far and Wide:** The Lugnuts include players from 10 different countries: USA, Brazil, Canada, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, Mexico, Panama and Venezuela in addition to Puerto Rico and 11 different states: Arizona, California, Colorado, Connecticut, Hawaii, Idaho, New York, Pennsylvania, South Dakota, Texas and Washington.

**They Know Their Trade:** Lansing has five players acquired by the Athletics via trade: **Cooper Bowman** (New York Yankees, acquired 8/1/22); **Christian Fernandez** (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22); **Euribiel Angeles** (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22); **Joey Estes** (Atlanta Braves, 3/14/22); and **Alexander Campos** (Seattle Mariners, 11/15/17).

**To the Show:** Nine former Nuts have debuted in MLB in 2022, 170 all-time: A's pitchers **Zach Logue** (2018) and **Zach Jackson** (2017) and infielder **Christian Lopes** (2013); Blue Jays utilityman **Vinny Capra** (2018), catcher **Gabriel Moreno** (2019) and pitcher **Max Castillo** (2018); M's reliever **Danny Young** (2016); and Red Sox pitcher **Josh Winckowski** (2019) and Marlins pitcher **Jake Fishman** (2017).

### TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2013:** Emilio Guerrero went 6-for-6 to tie the team/league record, including a third-inning grand slam amid a nine-run rally, and the Lugnuts destroyed the West Michigan Whitecaps, 14-5.

**2019:** The Lugnuts set a new franchise record for margin of victory with a 19-1 victory over Fort Wayne at Cooley Law School Stadium. Griffin Conine, Ryan Gold and Rafael Lantigua each hit a two-run homer in the win. The TinCaps finished the game with two different position players, Tyler Benson and Kelvin Alarcon, combining to pitch the eighth. Benson recorded the first two outs, allowing five runs, before Alarcon recorded the final out.

**Welcome Back!** The 6'8 right-hander, the tallest player on the team, was reinstated from the Injured List in Single-A Stockton and promoted to the Lugnuts on August 4. Juan made two starts last year for the Lugnuts, at Lake County and at home vs. Dayton, before landing on the Injured List; he returned on August 5, tossing 1 1/3 innings vs. West Michigan in a no-decision, allowing two runs in the 1st inning and a run in the 2nd inning (inherited/scored against Jake Walkinshaw).

**Last Start: August 10 at Dayton.** Juan pitched a perfect 1st inning (with a strikeout of Jose Torres) and a perfect 2nd inning (with strikeouts of Noelvi Marte, Michel Triana and Quincy McAfee)... Tyler Callihan and Justice Thompson led off the 3rd inning with solo home runs, but Juan responded by setting down the next three Dragons (including a strikeout of Michael Trautwein) to conclude three innings with five K's... as it turned out, those were the Dragons' only hits and only runs of the game, a 6-2 10-inning Lugnuts victory.

**Prospecting:** Jorge is currently ranked MLB Pipeline's No. 24 prospect in the Oakland Athletics organization and No. 13 pitching prospect... ranked the A's No. 19 prospect entering the year by Baseball America ("Juan is built like a throwback NBA power forward"). His Pipeline grades: fastball - 65, curve - 55, change - 40, control - 50. Quoting MLB.com, "Juan was relatively unheralded when he signed out of the Dominican Republic with the A's for just \$10,000 in 2017 as an 18-year-old. Struggling through some command issues early in his professional career, he returned from the year off due to the pandemic and unexpectedly broke out in 2021, showcasing an uptick in velocity that really helped put himself on Oakland's radar as his power arm dominated hitters at Low-A Stockton before a flexor strain cut his season short."

**2017, Signing Day:** Juan signed with Oakland's Juan C. De La Cruz, who was also the signing scout for former Lugnuts pitchers Richard Guasch and Rafael Kelly.

**2018, Dominican Summer League:** Jorge spent the entire season in the DSL, beginning in a piggyback tandem with Carlos Leandro, alternating starts and relief appearances... the team also included future Lugnut Richard Guasch, traded last year to the Washington Nationals... struggled with his control, hitting ten batters in his first nine appearances but only one in his last six... opposing base stealers went 14-for-18 in effectiveness against him.... dominated left-handed batters (5-for-46, .109) compared to right-handers (27-for-111, 10 HBP, .243).... gave up only five extra-base hits, all doubles

**2019, Arizona League:** Started the third game of the season for A's Green, bursting out of the gates with an impressive 3 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 7 K... followed up with three scoreless innings in his second appearance but then hit a road block, allowing at least one run in every subsequent appearance, including three games with 4+ runs allowed and seven games with 3+ walks... opposing base stealers were 11-for-16... again handled lefties (11-for-52, .212, .364 OBP, .614 OPS) compared to right-handers (21-for-72, .292, .469 OBP, .886 OPS)... allowed eight extra-base hits (6 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run).

**2021, Low-A West:** Joined Stockton for the 44th game of the year, starting June 24 at Inland Empire and tossing two innings (4 H, 3 R, 2 BB, 2 K) before current Lugnut Jack Cushing relieved him and threw six dazzling innings (1 UER) of relief... followed up with a gem, four hitless innings vs. San Jose, July 1... opposing base stealers went 4-for-4... left-handed batters hit .214 (9-for-42, 2 BB, 2 HR), right-handers hit .188 (6-for-32, 1 BB).

**2021, Lansing:** Joined the Lugnuts and made two starts (August 4 at Lake County: 2 2/3 IP, 3 H, 3 R, 3 BB, 3 K; August 10 vs. Dayton: 3 IP, 4 H, 4 R, 2 HR, 3 BB, 6 K) before being shut down due to flexor strain.

**2022, The Present Day:** A tumultuous period of time saw Juan get added to the 40-man roster in November, removed from the 40-man on May 8 and given his release, and then sign back with the Athletics on a minor league contract on May 16, eight days later... he was placed on the Stockton Injured List, with a two-start rehab stint in the Arizona Complex League readying him for his return.

**Hometown:** Payita is located on the northern coast in the region of Maria Trinidad Sanchez, just north of the region's capital, Nagua, and northeast of San Francisco de Macoris... others from Maria Trinidad Sanchez include Diego Castillo (Cabrera), Ubaldo Jiménez (Nagua) and Emmanuel Clase (Rio San Juan).

Padres prospect Robert Hassell III also competed in the tournament as a member of the Southeast champ from Nashville.
