

CAREER NOTES

2025: Was a non-roster invite to Pirates Spring Training... Named to Spring Breakout Game Roster, where he tossed two innings and allowed one run with a strikeout... Has tossed 17.2 consecutive scoreless innings to begin the season...

2024: Tossed 2.0 scoreless innings in the Spring Breakout Game for the Pirates against the Orioles... Assigned to Greensboro to begin the season... Completed 5.0 innings six times in 14 starts with Greensboro... Struck out a career-high 9 batters in 5.0 hitless innings on 6/28 vs. Jersey Shore... Placed on Development List on 7/9 to limit his innings for the year... Struck out 5 in 3.0 scoreless innings in his Double-A debut on 7/21 at Somerset... Placed on 7-Day IL on 7/30 (retro 7/29) with a left leg injury and missed the rest of the season...

CURVE CUTS: Hunter Harkins Barco... Underwent Tommy John surgery in May of 2022 at Florida... Worked with Pirates rehab coordinator Vic Black during his recovery to smooth out his arm action... Went 17-5 with a 3.18 ERA (152.2ip/54er), 189 strikeouts and a .213 batting average against in 30 games (29 starts) during his career with the University of Florida... Went 5-2 with a 2.50 ERA (50.1ip/14er) and 69 strikeouts in nine starts before undergoing "Tommy John" surgery in May... Was ranked No. 75 on the Top 250 draft prospects list by MLB Pipeline... Was a member of the 2021 SEC All-Newcomer team and was on the roster for the 2021 USA Baseball Collegiate national team... Attended The Bolles School where he was named to the 2019 Florida Times-Union All-First Coast Team... Notable Bolles School Alums include Chipper Jones, Austin Slater (SFG/CIN), DJ Stewart, and Rick Wilkins (11-year professional career from 91-01)... Was initially committed to play at the University of Virginia, but decommitted prior to his senior year and settled on Florida... Played in the 2018 Under Armour All-American Game at Wrigley Field... Was in the mix to be drafted in the first round in the 2019 MLB draft, but a shoulder strain caused him to miss time and impacted his draft status... Had conversations with the Milwaukee Brewers, but, ultimately was not enticed by their offer... Was drafted by the Mets in the 24th round in 2019, but opted to honor his commitment to pitch at Florida... Shared a pitching staff with Cleveland Guardians pitchers Tommy Mace, Jack Leftwich and Franco Aleman at Florida...
