SPRINGDALE, AR — For the second night in a row, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals and Amarillo Sod Poodles traded runs back and forth, but the Sod Poodles came out on top, 9-6 over the Naturals.

- Eight different Naturals collected hits, including a 2-for-4 day from left fielder Tucker Bradley and a solo home run in the third inning from third baseman Jake Means, his first of the season.
- Means' homer gave the Naturals a 1-0 lead, then Nate Eaton singled, stole two bases and scored on an errant throw in the fourth, putting the Naturals back ahead 2-1.
- In the fifth, Michael Massey doubled home two runs to put the Naturals up 4-2.
- After Massey's double, 10 of the next 11 Naturals were set down, with Amarillo scoring runs in the sixth and seventh off Yefri Del Rosario to tie the score at 4-4.
- In the ninth, Amarillo tagged Zach Willeman for five runs on four hits and two walks to take a 9-5 lead, with **Holden Capps** coming on to secure the final two outs and stop the bleeding.
- Northwest Arkansas tried to fight back in the ninth, however, as Bradley and Maikel Garcia singled backto-back with two outs in the ninth, Bradley's scoring **Sebastian Rivero**, to bring the tying run on deck.
- Starting pitcher Angel Zerpa earned a no-decision, allowing two runs with three strikeouts across 5.0 innings. He started his outing with three scoreless innings, stretching his scoreless streak to 12.1 innings, the longest of any Naturals pitcher this year.

#### The Naturals are 4-6 all-time when playing on April 29

On April 29, 2010, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals beat the Springfield Cardinals, 9-2 at Hammons Field behind an 8.0-inning, six strikeout performance from **Aaron Crow**, earning his first win of the season. Clint Robinson went 2-for-5, while Ernesto Mejia went 2-for-5 with two home runs and four runs batted in. The Naturals entered the ninth inning tied 2-2 and struck for seven runs, capped by Mejia's second homer of the day.

#### THE CHAMPS ARE HERE!

Of the 28-man roster the Naturals rolled out for the Double-A Central Championship Series in 2021, six players are on the Naturals' 2022 active roster, with a total of 9 returning players with the Naturals this season.

- Pitchers Holden Capps, Yefri Del Rosario, Drew Parrish, Stephen Woods Jr. and Ángel Zerpa were all a part of the championship celebration last year, as was outfielder Seuly Matias.
- Additionally, catcher/infielder Gavin Stupienski and pitcher Alec Marsh both played for the Naturals in 2021, as did catcher Tyler Cropley, who is currently on the Injured List.

#### FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in *Advanced Rookie* Burlington (2019) and *High-A* Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 20 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 10 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas:
   Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Michael Massey, Jake Means, Drew Parrish, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter, John Rave and Ángel Zerpa.

#### STAR-STUDDED ROTATION

All five of the Naturals starting pitchers to open the season are consensus top prospects in the Royals' organization, with all five listed in MLB Pipeline's Top-30 rankings for Kansas City.

- LHP Drew Parrish started yesterday and will go again Sunday for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 29 in the system, while Baseball America had him at No. 38 in their preseason rankings.
- LHP Anthony Veneziano starts today for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 17 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 21.
- LHP Ángel Zerpa starts tomorrow for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 13 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 20.
- RHP Alec Marsh stars Friday for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 12 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 11.
- LHP Asa Lacy has made two starts for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him No. 72 overall in baseball, No. 4 in the system and the No. 5 lefthanded pitching prospect, while Baseball America has him at No. 4 in the Royals' minor league system, the No. 4 left-handed pitching prospect.

#### TOOLSY TEAM

Six active Naturals players were listed in *Baseball America*'s 2022 Best Tools Survey of the Kansas City Royals' organization.

- CF Nick Loftin is rated as having the "Best Strike-Zone Discipline" in the system.
- C Sebastian Rivero is rated as being the <u>"Best Defensive Catcher"</u> in the system
- SS **Maikel Garcia** is rated as having the <u>"Best Infield Arm"</u> in the system.
- RF **Seuly Matias** is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm" in the system.
- LHP **Asa Lacy** is rated as having the <u>"Best Slider"</u> in the system.
- LHP **Ángel Zerpa** is rated as having the <u>"Best Control"</u> in the system.

#### YO, YOU WANNA SEE SOME REAL SPEED?

Through 15 games, the Naturals have stolen <u>30 bases in 34 attempts</u> (average 1.67 steals/game) and *pulled off a double steal 5 times*.

- 30 steals ranks 2nd in the Texas League, while a 88.24% success rate on steals is 18th out of 120 Minor League teams and 9th among teams with at least 20 successful steals.
- Maikel Garcia's seven steals (in as many attempts) ranks tied for fourth in the league.

#### GAR-SEE YA ON BASE

Shortstop **Maikel Garcia** drew 10 walks through the season's first five games, and now has 17 on the season, which is tied for the Texas League lead and tied for third in Double-A.

- In 82 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 34 times, for a .415 on-base percentage (17 hits + 17 walks).
- Garcia ranks among the Texas League leaders, ranking tied for first in walks (17) and tied for fourth in steals (7).
- Despite his on-base prowess, Garcia endured a five-game hitless streak, where he went 0-for-23 between April 19 and 27, five four walks, a span in which his batting average has dropped over 100 points, entering 4/19 batting .406, but was at .241 after April 26.
- Garcia drew at least one walk in each of the first five games he played, while walking twice or more on four occasions. He collected his first threewalk game on 4/13 in the Naturals' 8-5 win over Wichita.

#### G'DAY ROBBIE!

Australian infielder **Robbie Glendinning** was a February free agent signing by the Kansas City Royals and has proven himself to be one of the best players on the 2022 Naturals.

- The native of Perth, Western Australia has reached base in all 14 games he's played started the season, hitting .289 (13-for-45) with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 2 home runs and 13 walks, giving him a .468 on-base percentage.
- Glendinning is the ONLY Natural that has reached base in every game played this season, his 14-game on-base streak is the longest on the team this year and is tied for fifth in the Texas League.
- Among nine qualified Naturals hitter, Glendinning is the Naturals' team leader in on-base percentage (.458), slugging percentage (.533) and OPS (.991), while ranking third on the team with 11 runs batted in, tied second in runs scored (12) and tied second in walks (12)... his .471 OBP ranks fourth in the Texas League, while his .991 OPS is 10th.

- Derrick Lewis is in his third season with the Royals' organization and second as pitching coach at Northwest Arkansas.
- He spent the previous 16 seasons in the Atlanta Braves' organization, the first 14 as a Minor League pitching coach and the last two as the Pitching Coordinator.

# **#6** ABRAHAM NÚÑEZ • HITTING COACH

- Abraham Núñez enters his fourth season as Northwest Arkansas' hitting coach after serving in the same capacity with High-A Wilmington (2015-2018), Class-A Lexington (2014), Rookie Advanced Burlington (2013) and the Dominican Royals (2012).
- Núñez played for parts of 12 seasons in the Majors with the Pirates (1997-2004), Cardinals (2005), Phillies (2006-2007) and Mets (2008). - Born in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic, he now resides in Hudson, Massachusetts.



# #27 CHRISTIAN COLON - Assistant HITTING COACH

- Christian Colón returns to the organization as the Naturals Assistant Hitting Coach in 2022, following a 12-year professional career.
- He was the Royals first-round pick in the 2010 MLB Draft, scored the winning run in the 2014 AL Wild Card game and had the game-winning hit in the title-clinching Game 5 of the 2015 World Series.
- After being drafted in 2010, Colón ascended to Northwest Arkansas by 2011 and between 2011, 2012 and 2014, played 202 games for the Naturals ... in 2011, Colón led the Texas League in sacrifices (21), while leading the team in at-bats (491) and hits (126). His 21 sacrifices that season are the most a Naturals player has ever recorded in a single season, while 28 overall are tied for the club record.
- During his playing career, he made stops in Miami (2017) and Cincinnati (2019-20) ... spent 2021 with the Rich Baseball-owned Buffalo Bisons (Triple-A, Toronto) before announcing his retirement.
- He also played in parts of four seasons in the Puerto Rican Winter League.
- · Christian lives in Cave Springs, Ark. (15 minutes North of Arvest Ballpark) with his wife, Kayla, and three daughters, Marley, Mia and Lucy.



# #23 MIKE JIRSCHLE • BENCH COACH

- Mike Jirschele enters his first season as the Bench Coach for Northwest Arkansas after spending last season in the same role for Manager Chris Widger in Quad Cities.
- He served as a Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020 and was on the Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015.

- Jirschele was originally selected by the Texas Rangers in the fifth round of the 1977 MLB Draft and played in 999 minor league games over 13-plus seasons in the Rangers and Royals systems.




# DANNY ACCOLA • CERTIFIED ATHLETIC TRAINER


