**TODAY'S GAME:** The Pensacola Blue Wahoos continue their series against the Columbus Clingstones, Double-A affiliate of the Atlanta Braves, on Thursday night.

**LAST TIME OUT:** The Blue Wahoos fell 6-5 to the Clingstones on Wednesday night...John Gil and Ethan Workinger each hit RBI singles with two outs in the top of the ninth inning to put the Clingstones ahead...it was just Pensacola's second loss in 51 games this year when leading after eight innings...the Clingstones scored a run in the top of the first inning, snapping a streak of 16 consecutive games for the Blue Wahoos scoring first...Cam Clayton was 2-for-3 with his first two Double-A hits...Emaarion Boyd was 4-for-4 with a double and a stolen base...Fenwick Trimble was 1-for-5 with a two-run homer, Pensacola's first home run since Trimble went deep September 1 against Chattanooga.

**CARP-E DIEM:** The High-A Beloit Sky Carp beat the Twins-affiliate Cedar Rapids Kernels 7-1 in game one of the best-of-three Midwest League Division Series on Tuesday...the series shifts to Cedar Rapids tonight, with a chance for Beloit to advance to the Midwest League Championship Series against either Lake County (CLE) or West Michigan (DET)...the Beloit franchise has won only one Midwest League title, claiming the crown in 1995 as the Brewers-affiliate Beloit Snappers...this marks their first playoff appearance since 2018...20 players currently on Pensacola's roster played for the Sky Carp at some point this season.

**GET 'EM NEXT YEAR:** The first half champion Biloxi Shuckers will face the second half champion Montgomery Biscuits in the Southern League Division Series starting on Tuesday, September 16...Montgomery has made the playoffs every year since 2015, though they have not won a Southern League title since 2007...the Biscuits will host Game One, and play in Biloxi for Game Two and Game Three (if necessary) on September 18 and 19...in the North Division, the defending champion Birmingham Barons clinched the second half on Saturday night and will meet the first half champion Chattanooga Lookouts in the playoffs.

**FALL STARS:** The Marlins announced rosters for the Arizona Fall League on Wednesday, with three Blue Wahoos players set to suit up for the Mesa Solar Sox: RHP Carson Milbrandt, OF Fenwick Trimble and RHP Xavier Meachem...the AFL season runs October 6- November 15.

**AWARDS SEASON:** Right-handed pitcher Will Schomberg was named Southern League Pitcher of the Week on Monday after his Friday start at Biloxi...in just his third Double-A appearance, Schomberg took a perfect game through 6.2 innings and finished a career-high 7.0 innings with one hit and 10 strikeouts...he is the fourth Pensacola pitcher to win SL Pitcher of the Week honors this season (Fitterer, Snelling x2, T. White).

**BELGRAVE AND EKNESSE SUCCESS:** Right-handed relievers Nigel Belgrave and Josh Eknese were both promoted to Triple-A Jacksonville on Tuesday...both had spent the entire season in Pensacola after joining the club late in 2024...Belgrave was 5-3 with a 2.71 ERA in 36 relief appearances, striking out 85 batters in 63.0 innings and going 5-for-8 in save opportunities...Eknese was 4-1 with a 2.73 ERA in a team-leading 43 relief appearances, striking out 66 batters in 52.2 innings and leading the team with 10 saves in 12 tries.

**MEACHEM? MEET 'EM:** Right-handed pitcher Xavier Meachem joined the Blue Wahoos from High-A Beloit on Tuesday, and made his Double-A debut on Wednesday...he took a blown save and a loss, allowing two ninth-inning runs in a 6-5 defeat...he had spent the entire season with the Sky Carp, going 1-2 with a 2.63 ERA in 34 relief appearances.

**CENTALA, SENT TO AA:** Right-handed pitcher Chase Centala joined the Blue Wahoos on Saturday for High-A Beloit, and worked a scoreless inning on Tuesday in his Double-A debut...he had become the closer for the Sky Carp, saving eight games including their second half playoff clincher on Friday night...he made 26 appearances for Sky Carp, going 0-2 with a 3.40 ERA.

**FIGHT FOR .500:** The Blue Wahoos are 66-68 with 4 games remaining in the regular season...they will need to go 4-0 to finish above .500...the Blue Wahoos were below .500 their first four seasons (2012-15), but have had a winning record eight consecutive seasons since 2016.

**NEW-LOOK 'HOOS:** 66 different players have suited up for the Blue Wahoos this season...only five players (Evan Fitterer, Jacob Miller, Orlando Ortiz-Mayr, Luis Palacios and Sam Praytor) remain from the Opening Day roster...the team record is 67 different players in the 2019 season, followed by 65 players in 2023, though in each case MLB rehab assignments (5 in 2019, 4 in 2023) inflated their totals.

**OFF AND RUNNING:** The Blue Wahoos have stolen 189 bases this season, second-most in the Southern League...they passed the 2022 team (168 SB) for the most in team history on August 21...Marlins affiliates are stealing bases at record paces, as High-A Beloit led MiLB with 334 steals, Triple-A Jacksonville is ninth with 289 and Single-A Jupiter finished with 276.

**20-26 VISION:** The Blue Wahoos announced their 2026 home schedule last Thursday...they will open the season at home on Friday, April 3 against the Montgomery Biscuits...they will be home for Easter weekend (April 3-5), Mother's Day weekend (May 8-10), Memorial Day weekend (May 22-24), Juneteenth, and Father's Day weekend (June 19-21).

**IN THE PIPELINE:** Pensacola has 2 players on MLB Pipeline's Marlins Top 30 Prospects list: RHP Karson Milbrandt (#18) and RHP Fenwick Trimble (#26).

**TODAY'S START:** Will Schomberg is scheduled to make his third career Double-A start on September 11 versus Columbus.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Schomberg last pitched on September 5 at Biloxi...earned win (7.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 10 K)...took perfect game through 6.2 IP before two-out Blake Burke single ended bid...tied career-high with 10 K, established new career-high with 7.0 IP...departed leading 5-0, Wahoos won by same score.

**AGAINST THE CLINGSTONES:** Schomberg has faced Columbus once this season...took no-decision in relief outing on August 22 (3.0 IP, 1 H, 1 ER, 1 BB, 3 K).

**BY WAY OF BELOIT:** Schomberg began the 2025 season with the High-A Beloit Sky Carp...posted 3.65 ERA across 20 appearances (10 starts) and 69.0 IP...allowed 51 H, 28 ER...walked 34, struck out 86...led Sky Carp in strikeouts at time of promotion (8/19).

**LAST YEAR:** Schomberg began the 2024 season with the Class-A Modesto Nuts in the Seattle Mariners' system...posted 2.69 ERA across 15 starts with Modesto; struck out 97 in 70.1 IP...earned California League Pitcher of the Week Honors on May 5 following 6.0 IP, 10-strikeout performance versus Rancho Cucamonga on May 2...earned California League Pitcher of the Month Honors for May after posting 4-0 record and 1.50 ERA across 6 starts with 43 strikeouts in 30.0 IP...named California League Post-Season All-Star...promoted to High-A Everett AquaSox on June 30...posted 3.27 ERA in 4 starts and 22.0 IP with Everett...acquired by Marlins from the Mariners on July 30, 2024 for RHP J.T. Chargeis...made Miami organization debut on August 3 with High-A Beloit...7.13 ERA in 6 starts with Sky Carp to close out season...accumulated combined 8-5 record with 3.71 ERA in 25 starts across three affiliates (MOD, EVE, BEL).

**YOUNG MAN AND THE SEA:** Schomberg was a Seattle Mariners farmhand from 2023-24...began pro career with ACL Mariners in 2023...pitched for Class-A Modesto and High-A Everett in the Seattle system in 2024 prior to trade...pitched 22 total games across three affiliates in Mariners' system.

**GET TO KNOW 'EM:** Full name is David William Schomberg...originally signed by Mariners as undrafted free agent out of Davidson College on July 22, 2023...spent four seasons (2020-23) at Davidson, selected as Atlantic 10 All-First Team member during senior season...career 4.55 ERA in 52 appearances (15 starts) and 154.1 IP with Wildcats.
