RIDERS COMEBACK ATTEMPT FALLS SHORT IN LOSS:

The Frisco RoughRiders defeated the Northwest Arkansas Naturals 10-8 on Friday evening from Riders Field. Northwest Arkansas (7-9, 42-43) grabbed an early lead in the top of the first inning against Frisco (10-6, 54-31) starter **Nick Krauth** (7-3) with an RBI single from Rodolfo Duran. Trailing 1-0 in the bottom of the first, the RoughRiders got to Steven Zobac (0-1) in his Double-A debut, sending eight to the plate on their way to four runs. **Liam Hicks** tied the game with an RBI double, scoring **Alejandro Osuna**. **Keyber Rodriguez** gave the Riders a 3-1 advantage with a two-run double before **Abimelec Ortiz** capped off the frame with an RBI single to give Frisco a 4-1 lead. In the home half of the second inning, **Josh Hatcher** gave the Riders a 5-1 advantage with an RBI single. The Naturals cut into the RoughRiders lead in the top of the third, making it a 5-3 game on a pair of RBI doubles from Duran and Peyton Wilson. The Riders then struck again in the bottom of the third on an RBI double by **Maximo Acosta** that propelled the Riders out in front, 6-3. Eight batters came to the plate in the bottom of the fourth for the Riders as they manufactured their second four-run inning of the contest. **Cody Freeman** started the scoring with an RBI double before Hatcher delivered his second RBI single of the evening. Hatcher and Freeman executed a double steal and as the throw went to second, Freeman came down to score from third. Ortiz then logged his second RBI of the night with a single to make it a 10-3 lead. In the top of the sixth, the Naturals loaded the bases against Krauth, prompting **Seth Clark** to enter the game for Frisco. Northwest Arkansas used four walks, a hit-by-pitch, an error and a pair of hits to push across five runs to cut the deficit to 10-8. Krauth was charged with three of the five runs in the sixth, finishing after 5.0 innings in which he allowed eight runs on eight hits and three walks with four punchouts. **Andy Rodriguez** earned his third save of the season by tossing 2.0 scoreless frames. Offensively, Frisco erupted for 13 hits as Hatcher paced the offense going 4-for-4 with two RBI and two runs scored. Ortiz notched the only other multi-hit night, snagging three hits. Osuna led the way with three runs scored.

HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 30-13 at Riders Field this season. Their 30 wins and .698 winning percentage at home are both first in Double-A and second among non-Triple-A teams in Minor League Baseball. At home this season, Frisco has a +70 run differential, a 3.64 ERA and is averaging 5.7 runs per game with a .749 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 24-19 with a 3.45 ERA, but a +18 run differential while averaging 4.0 runs per game and owning a .631 OPS. **Cody Freeman** is slashing .352/.400/.593/.993 at home this season with seven of his 10 home runs. His .352 batting average is the best in the Texas League play a player at their home stadium.

OSUNA FROM THE RIDERS:

Alejandro Osuna has been incredible for Frisco since joining them from High-A Hickory. In 12 games, he is hitting .354 (17-for-43)/.404/.698/1.102 with five doubles, two triples, two home runs and eight RBIs. Over his last seven games, he is batting .423 (11-for-48)/.415/.667/1.082 with five doubles, two triples, two home runs and 11 RBIs. Last Friday, he went 2-for-5 with a triple and a home run, tying his career-high with five RBIs. He set that career high in his final game in High-A this year, also hitting for the cycle in a 5-for-5 game. In the first inning, Osuna is hitting .455 (5-for-11) with three doubles for the Riders.

I WANT TO BREAK FREE(MAN):

Cody Freeman blasted a go-ahead home run in the seventh last Friday, giving him the team lead with 10 this year. While he slowed down slightly at the plate in June (batting .253/.298/.437/.735), he is on a season-best tying nine-game hitting streak. During the streak, he is batting .343 (12-for-35)/.385/.543/.928 with four doubles, a home run, nine RBIs and three runs scored. This season, he has a career highs in average (.281), slugging percentage (.467) and OPS (.800) while being on pace to set new career bests in RBIs (73) and home runs (18).

THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen has been the best in the Texas League this season, owning a 2.96 ERA, which is also the best in all of Minor League Baseball. In their series opener against Northwest Arkansas on Tuesday, the bullpen allowed six runs (all from normal starter **Josh Stephan**, who worked out of the bullpen because of rehabber **Tyler Mahle**). Those six runs were the most the the bullpen had allowed in a game since April 23rd against Amarillo. That tied for the second-most allowed, with nine runs allowed in the second game of the season (4/6 at Wichita) marking the most. In their last six series, spanning 42 games, Frisco's bullpen has a 2.25 ERA (40ER/160.0IP).

WE'RE GOING DANCING:

Tuesday marked the first day of the second half. The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

CAREER: The 29-year-old Dunning was named the Rangers' 2023 Pitcher of the Year by the Dallas-Fort Worth chapter of the Baseball Writers Association of America following a campaign in which he posted career highs in wins (12), innings (team-high 172.2), and strikeouts (140)...marked his 2nd time to win the team's Pitcher of the Year award (also 2021), as he is one of 7 pitchers in club history to receive the honor multiple times (6—Charlie Hough; 4—Kenny Rogers; 2—Yu Darvish, Rick Helling, Fergie Jenkins, C.J. Wilson, Dunning)...served in a dual role last season, splitting time between the bullpen and starting rotation...leads all Rangers in starts (80) and innings (443.2) since the beginning of 2021, well ahead of the next-closest pitchers in those categories: Jon Gray (53 starts) and Martín Pérez (338.0 innings)...is 21-25, 4.18 ERA with 391 strikeouts over 91 appearances/80 starts for Texas in 2021-23 since being acquired in a 3-player trade with CWS on 12/8/20...had 2022 campaign cut short by season-ending hip surgery and pitched on workload limitations for most of 2021...made MLB debut with Chicago-AL in the abbreviated 2020 campaign...traded to the White Sox on 12/7/16 after originally being selected by WAS in the 1st round (29th overall) of the 2016 MLB draft...pitched 3 seasons at the University of Florida, which went to the College World Series in both 2015 and 2016...is a native of the Jacksonville, Fla. area.

GROUND CONTROL: Since the start of 2021, Dunning ranks among the top-5 American League pitchers in both ground ball percentage (3rd, 50.9%) and opp. ground ball double plays induced (4th, 45)...per Statcast, his 7.9° opp. launch angle allowed over that span is the 3rd-lowest mark among A.L. qualifiers behind only HOU's Framber Valdez (-1.2°) and KC's Brad Keller (7.0°)...Dunning induced a career-high 20 opp. GIDPs in 2023, 4th-most in A.L. and T7th-most in MLB, while his 46.9% ground ball pct. ranked 6th in A.L. and 10th in MLB.

STARTER/RELIEVER: A majority of Dunning's Major League appearances (87 of 98) have come as starter... leads all Rangers in starts (80) and innings (443.2) since the start of 2021, and his 80 starts over that span are T10th-most in the A.L...is 21-25, 4.15 ERA (207 ER/449.0 IP) in 87 starts vs. 2-0, 4.40 ERA (14 ER/28.2 IP) in 11 relief outings in his career...opponents have batted .259/.332/.411/.743 with 53 HR in his starts against .252/.306/.423/.729 with 4 HR when he pitches out of the bullpen...owns a higher lifetime strikeouts per 9.0 innings figure as a starter (8.1) than as a reliever (6.3)...opened 2023 campaign in bullpen with each of his first 8 appearances coming in relief, but converted back to rotation in May and started 26 of his last 27 outings to finish the season.

HOME COOKING: Has produced far better results at home (17-7, 3.73 ERA in 49 G/43 GS) than on the road (6-18, 4.65 ERA in 49 G/44 GS) in his career...owns a lifetime 16-8 record and 3.78 ERA (99 ER/235.2 IP) in 48 G/39 GS at Globe Life Field, entering 2024 as the venue's all-time leader (incl. postseason) in wins, starts, innings, and strikeouts (212)...saw more success on the road (5-5, 3.10 ERA in 20 G/16 GS) than at home (7-2, 4.44 ERA in 15 G/10 GS) in 2023, but 7 home wins were T7th-most in A.L...was winless in 27 consecutive road starts from 9/21/20-5/5/23, going 0-13, 5.86 ERA (81 ER/124.1 IP) over that span...marked the 3rd-longest such stretch by a starting pitcher in MLB history behind only a pair of 29-start droughts by Zack Greinke (8/18/21-current) and Scott Elarton (5/12/01-6/2/05).

2023: Selected as Rangers' 2023 Pitcher of the Year by the DFW chapter of the BBWAA after compiling career highs in wins (12), innings (team-high 172.2), strikeouts (140), and quality starts (12) in his 4th Major League season (3rd with Texas)...went 12-6, 3.70 ERA (71 ER/172.2 IP) across 35 games/26 starts, ranking among A.L. qualifiers in opp. GIDP (4th, 20), fewest pitches-per-batter faced (4th, 3.74), ground ball pct. (6th, 46.9%), wins (T10th), and ERA (12th)...opened season in bullpen, but returned to rotation in early May and made team-high 25 starts from 5/1-end of season...saw far better ERA results on the road (5-5, 3.10 ERA in 20 G/16 GS) than at home (7-2, 4.44 ERA in 15 G/10 GS)...opponents batted .250/.316/.393/.708 (163-652), including splits of .270 BA/.782 OPS vs. LHB and .233 BA/.644 OPS vs. RHB...struck out 72 of 284 (25.4%) batters faced in 12 G/11 GS after the beg. of August, ranking among A.L. leaders over that span in SO (7th), SO/9 (10th, 9.87), and SO pct. (14th)...posted the 2 highest strikeout totals of his career over his first 3 starts in Aug. (12 SO, 8/13 at SF; 11 SO, 8/2 vs. CWS)...allowed no BB w/ career-high 12 SO on 8/13 at SF, becoming the 8th pitcher (11th instance) in WSH/TEX franchise history to post 12+ SO/0 BB in a game (also Jon Gray, 6/7/23 vs. STL)...logged career-high 8.2 IP in start on 6/28 vs. DET (W, 8.2 IP, 2 R-ER, 0 BB, 10 SO)...on MLB paternity leave list from 5/27-29.

POSTSEASON: Has made 6 appearances/one start in his postseason career, going 1-1 with a 4.70 ERA (4 ER/7.2 IP)... was 1-1, 5.14 ERA (4 ER/7.0 IP) with 5 BB/5 SO over 5 relief appearances during Texas' 2023 World Series championship run, including 3 scoreless outings (2.1 SHO IP) in the Fall Classic vs. Arizona...took loss in 3-10 Rangers defeat in 2023 ALCS G4 vs. HOU (L, 2.2 IP, 3 H, 3 R-ER, 3 BB, 4 SO)... pitched behind 'opener' Andrew Heaney and earned 1st career playoff win as part of Rangers' 3-2 victory in 2023 ALDS G2 at BAL (W, 2.0 IP, 1 R-ER), his 1st ever postseason action with TEX...made playoff debut in start for Chicago-AL in 2020 ALWC G3 at OAK (ND, 0.2 IP, 2 H, 0 R), a 6-4 White Sox loss.
