LHP JACK O'LOUGHLIN (1-2, 6.00) vs. LHP YU-MIN LIN (0-1, 2.40)

TODAY'S GAME: The Isotopes and Aces meet for the second of four series on the year and final set in Reno ... Jack O'Loughlin is slated to take the hill for the Isotopes while Yu-Min Lin is expected to start for the Aces.

LAST WEEK: Albuquerque is coming off a series split against Tacoma in the Duke City after the Isotopes set a franchise record with three-straight walk-off wins (May 15-17) ... In the last three games of the series, Albuquerque and Tacoma combined for 61 runs. 86 hits and 30 extra-base hits.

@ RENO: This is the first time since the 2019 season the Isotopes have played two series in Reno (April 9-11 and June 20-24) ... It's also the seventh time the clubs have met twice in Reno in the same season since Reno joined the PCL in 2009.

2025 @ RENO: The Aces claimed the first series between the clubs (4-2) from April 22-27 after Albuquerque won the first two games of the set ... The four-game skid is the Isotopes' longest losing streak of the season.

PITCHERS USED: Tacoma's nine pitchers used Sunday were the most by an opponent since El Paso sent nine to the mound on June 24, 2017, a game that lasted 14 innings and a franchise record five hours and 35 minutes.

SERIES FINALES: The Isotopes have lost six of their last seven series finales, only winning the last game at Oklahoma City on Mother's Day during this stretch.

TOPES STARTERS: Albuquerque right-hander Tanner Gordon relented nine hits and four runs in 5.1 innings Sunday. It marked the fifth time in six games an Isotopes starter allowed a minimum of nine knocks

TAKE YOUR BASE: The Isotopes drew nine walks Sunday, tied for their second-most in a game this season (also: May 8 at Oklahoma City) ... Most free passes: 10, April 15 vs. El Paso.

TIME OF GAME: Sunday's contest lasted 3:33, the Isotopes longest nine-inning game since Sept. 14, 2023 at El Paso (3:41).

VEEN: Since being sent back down to Albuquerque April 24 (16 games), Zac Veen is 17-for-68 with four doubles, one triple, one homer and eight RBI ... Has a hit in three-straight and four of last five

PCL LEADERBOARD: Ryan Ritter is 5th in walks (29) and T-5th in runs scored (31) ... Sam Hilliard is T-1st in triples (4), T-8th in

POTW: Ryan Ritter was named PCL Player of the Week Monday . He collected three game-tying or winning hits in the ninth inning against Tacoma last week (May 15-17) ... Albuquerque's first POTW since Elehuris Montero (August 5-11, 2024)

-Ritter went 10-for-22 with four doubles, two triples, a homer and nine RBI ... During week, led PCL in OPS (1.475) and slugging (.955) and tied for first in doubles (four) and second in RBI (nine)

RIT: Ryan Ritter tripled and doubled Sunday, the first Isotopes player to record an extra-base hit in four consecutive games since Elehuris Montero (July 28-Aug. 1, 2024) ... Finished with three total hits in a game Sunday for the second time this season (also: April 23 at Reno).

-Has a four-game multi-hit streak for the first time since June 29-July 2, 2023 ... Tallied two extra-base hits in a game for the fifth time this year (last: May 17, double and triple).

Has an RBI in five-straight games (nine total) for the third time in his career. Two shy of his longest streak of career: June 24-July 2. 2023. with Fresno.

KESTDADDY: Keston Hiura has a six-game hit streak and a hit in 12 of 13 games played in May ... During the month, is slashing ... 354/.446/.583 with a triple, three doubles, two homes and eight RBI after hitting .141 over his first 24 games ... Has a 13-game on-base streak

WARMING UP: Warming Bernabel went 2-for-4 Sunday and has picked up multiple hits in three-straight games for the second time in 2025 (also: April 22-24 at Reno). Is 7-for-14 over his last three games. Has a hit in four-straight after going 4-for-33 in previous 10 games.

YF: Yanguiel Fernández went 2-for-3 with a double Sunday and has tallied consecutive multi-hit performances for the second time this year (also: April 20-23, three-straight) ... Recorded first XBH Sunday since April 25 at Reno (double).

SAM I AM: Sam Hilliard has reached base in 32 of 33 games started on the year. Has an RBI in four-straight games for the first time since September 7-10, 2022.

-Hilliard's 24-game on-base streak from April 3-May 6 is the longest in the PCL.

NUCLEI NOTES

SKIPPER: Pedro Lopez enters his 21st year as a minor league manager and third guiding the Isotopes. He is the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1 ... Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his third season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five seasons with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his second year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... The former outfielder played in 33 games for the Isotopes and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

AARON MUNOZ: Takes over as Isotopes hitting coach after Jordan Pacheco was named one of two new hitting coaches for the Colorado Rockies on May 12 ... Began the 2025 season as the hitting coach for the ACL Rockies ... Spent nine seasons (2016-2024) as the Rockies bullpen catcher ... Was Isotopes bullpen catcher in 2015 ... Originally drafted by the Blue Jays in the 34th round of the MLB Draft ... Played parts of four seasons in the Minor Leagues (2011-14), making it to Double-A.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the third-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 22) will host the second half winner (beginning June 24) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, on September 27.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Challenge System, in it's third full year in the PCL, will be used exclusively for every game this season. Under this system, the home plate umpire will call balls or strikes while each team has the opportunity to challenge the umpire's call with two challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
