NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

The Storm Chasers opened the 2026 season 0-4, won 3 straight series and then lost back-to-back series, but are trending up, coming off a series win over Toledo.

After suffering a season-opening weekend sweep in Louisville, the Storm Chasers went 12-5 between April 1 and 21, with series wins over Buffalo, Iowa and Indianapolis ... Omaha proceeded to lose 7 straight games to open a stretch from April 22 to May 8 where the team went 3-11 ... however, the Chasers have won 6 of their last 8 and won 4 of 6 against Toledo last week.

Omaha had a winning April, with a 13-12 record on the month ... last year, the Chasers had just one winning month, going 15-11 in August.

COMEBACK KIDS

Yesterday was Omaha's 11th comeback win of the season and the Storm Chasers' 4th comeback win of their series with Toledo

The Chasers have trailed in each of their 4 wins this week over the Mud Hens ... Omaha did not have a lead in the series until Wednesday's walk-off win, then overcame brief Toledo leads in Thursday, Saturday and Sunday's wins.

Wednesday and Thursday's walk-off wins marked the 5th time in Werner Park history (since 2011) that the Chasers walked off back-to-back games and the first time since March 2024 ... it was also the 5th time Omaha had two straight walk-off wins come courtesy of the same player, with **Kameron Misner** delivering both game-winners ... however, it was the first time in Werner Park history the same player has had the walk-off hit in consecutive games.

Omaha's 11 comeback wins rank tied for the 10th-most at the Triple-A level, however 5 of the 11 have only been brief deficits (1 inning or less) ... in Sunday's game Toledo scored in the top of the 1st before Omaha took the lead in the bottom of the 1st, then the Mud Hens tied it in the 2nd and the Storm Chasers took the lead for good in the 3rd.

In total, the Storm Chasers' 95 comeback wins since 2024 rank 2nd-most in the International League and tied 4th-most at the Triple-A level in that span.

CATCH ME IF YOU CAN

Stealing bases has been one of the strongest areas for the Storm Chasers this season, led by a quartet of baserunning threats.

Omaha's 82.8% success rate (48-for-58) ranks 5th in the International League and 10th at the Triple-A level.

John Rave leads Omaha in steals (11) ... **Gavin Cross** has 9 steals in as many tries while **Tyler Tolbert** has swiped 8 bags and **Kameron Misner** has 7 stolen bases ... Cross and Tolbert are 2 of 4 Storm Chasers who have stolen multiple bases without being caught this year.

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE

A constant in 2026 has been Omaha's ability to go deep in plate appearances.

The Storm Chasers are seeing 3.986 pitches per plate appearance, 6th-most in the International League and 10th at the Triple-A level.

Among 119 Triple-A players with 150+ plate appearances this year, **Kameron Misner** is 9th in pitches seen/PA (4.376) while **John Rave** ranks 10th (4.335).

CAUGHT CLEAN-HANDED

Omaha is tied for the 7th-best fielding percentage in the International League with a .981 mark, committing just 29 errors in 44 games.

The clean play extends throughout the roster - 5 of the Storm Chasers' 16 qualified fielders (min. 60.0 inn.) have a perfect 1.000 fielding percentage, while another 6 of those 16 have committed just 1 error on the season.

Omaha's 39 double plays turned are tied for the 10th-most of any Minor League team ... 4 Storm Chasers infielders have participated in 10 or more double plays, led by **Abraham Toro**'s 25, tied for the 11th-most of any Minor League player ... after turning 34 double plays in the first 30 games between March and April, Omaha has turned 5 double plays in 15 May games.

ST. PAUL SLUGGERS

A pair of Storm Chasers hitters have seen some of their best success on the road at CHS Field.

John Rave has a career .348 average (24-for-69) with a .925 OPS in 16 games at CHS Field, his best of any road venue in the IL since his debut in 2022 ... his 24 hits in St. Paul are tied for the 2nd-most of any Omaha hitter in a road ballpark ... between 2024 and 2025, Rave's 36 total bases at CHS Field were the 2nd-most of any visiting player.

Drew Waters is a career .343 hitter (12-for-35) with a .939 OPS in 8 games at CHS Field, his 2nd-best numbers at a road venue in the IL since 2021.

- Ryan Ramsey is making his **8th start** with the Storm Chasers this year and his **9th appearance** of the season with Omaha.
- Playing his **5th professional season** this year, all in the Royals organization.
- This is Ramsey's 1st career start against the Saints ... he has previously appeared in 7 games against Twins affiliates, 3 against Wichita in Double-A and 4 against Cedar Rapids in High-A

RAMSEY RUNDOWN

- STARTER'S ORDERS:** Ramsey made just two spot starts last year for Omaha, but cracked the Storm Chasers' Opening Day roster ... in **2025**, just 8 of his first 13 appearances were starts, while he has been in Omaha's rotation all of 2026, outside of one bulk relief/piggyback outing in his 2nd game of the year.
- DOUBLE THE TROUBLE:** Ramsey has had 12 double plays turned behind him this season, the most of any pitcher between the Majors and Minor Leagues ... he's had 3 starts without a single double play turned behind him, but 4 appearances with 2+ double plays turned on the ground, including 3 double plays on April 5 vs. Buffalo, April 17 vs. Indianapolis and April 30 vs. Louisville.

LAST OUTING: TUESDAY, MAY 12 vs. TOLEDO

- Allowed a career-worst 10 hits and tied a career-worst with 8 runs allowed, tied a career-high with 26 batters faced ... allowed runs in each of his innings ... an error and RBI single scored 2 runs in the 1st inning ... allowed a 3-run homer to **Ben Malgeri** in the 2nd inning ... a fielder's choice plated a run in the 3rd inning ... allowed a 2-run homer to **Jace Jung** in the 4th inning ... didn't retire more than 3 straight hitters.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- Appeared in 1 Cactus League game with the Royals while up from Minor League camp, working 1.0 scoreless inning ... opened the 2026 season on the Storm Chasers' roster.
- Worked 5.0 innings of 1-run relief on April 5 vs. Buffalo (TOR), 1 out shy of tying his longest career relief appearance.

CAREER NOTES

- 2025**
- Began the season with Northwest Arkansas (AA) and spent most of the year in Double-A, also making a pair of spot starts for Omaha ... posted a 5.54 ERA (65 ER in 105.2 IP) in 25 appearances (18 starts) at Double-A ... his 114 total strikeouts ranked tied with **Shane Panzini** for the Royals organization lead.
 - Pitched to a 3.73 ERA (17 ER in 41.0 IP) over his first 9 appearances (7 starts) from April 9 to May 31 which included a 5.2-inning, 5 strikeout, scoreless performance May 18 @ Tulsa (LAD).
 - Made his first Double-A start on April 15 @ San Antonio (SD), throwing 5.2 innings of no-hit ball to start what became the fourth no-hitter in Nationals history ... relievers **Chazz Martinez**, **Ryan Brady** & **Brandon Johnson** finished it off ... was NWA's third combined no-no, the club's first no-hitter since 2013.
 - Was transferred to Omaha on April 30 and made his Triple-A debut on May 1 vs. Indianapolis (PIT) ... returned to the Nationals on May 2 and returned to Omaha for a start on September 19 @ Columbus (CLE).

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER

- Spent the entire **2024** season with Quad Cities (A+), splitting time between the bullpen and as a starter ... appeared in 22 games (11 starts) with a 2.43 ERA (24 ER in 89.0 IP) and 97 strikeouts to 30 walks (3.23 K/BB) at High-A ... had a career-high 25.2-inning scoreless streak from July 25 to August 27, the River Bandits' longest scoreless streak in their Royals-affiliate era (since 2021).
- Largely split **2023** between Columbia (A) and Quad Cities (A+), but also made 2 rehab appearances (1 start) with the ACL Royals (R) ... pitched to a 0.54 ERA (2 ER in 33.1 IP) with 38 strikeouts across 7 starts with Columbia before earning a promotion to Quad Cities ... made 5 appearances (2 starts) at High-A with 22 strikeouts in 14.1 innings (13.8 K/9) ... set a Fireflies record with a 24.0-inning scoreless streak from April 21 to July 29, spanning 5 outings and stints on the Development List and Injured List.
- Made his professional debut in **2022** with the ACL Royals (Rk) after Kansas City drafted him in the 13th round of the **2022** MLB Draft ... pitched in 1 game in the ACL that season.

MISCELLANEOUS

- Pitched 3 seasons (**2020-22**) for the University of Maryland (Big Ten), working a career 17-2 record with a 3.13 ERA (47 ER in 135.0 IP) and 140 strikeouts to 58 walks (2.41 K/BB) for the Terrapins ... named **2022** First Team All-Big Ten and **2021** Second Team All-Big Ten ... in **2022**, went 11-1 with a 3.22 ERA (33 ER in 92.1 IP) and 90 strikeouts to 41 walks (2.20 K/BB) across 16 appearances (15 starts).
- Threw a 9.0-inning perfect game for the University of Maryland on April 29, **2022** against Northwestern.
- Was drafted by Cleveland in the 36th round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Pascack Hills High School but elected not to sign and instead attend the University of Maryland.
