RIDERS HANG ON LATE TO TAKE FOURTH STRAIGHT:

The Frisco RoughRiders topped the Midland RockHounds 4-3 on Saturday night from Riders Field, snatching their fourth-straight win. In the top of the ninth, Midland's Drew Swift clipped a three-run triple off RoughRiders (26-17) reliever Bryan Magdaleno. With the tying run 90 feet away, Gavin Collyer entered the game and retired the next two batters to garner the save. Frisco struck first when Sebastian Walcott laced an RBI double and Keyber Rodriguez smashed an RBI single, lifting the Riders to a 2-0 lead. Midland (24-20) then threatened in the top of the third, but Walcott, Theo Hardy, Abimelec Ortiz and lan Moller turned a fielder's choice double play to cut down Swift at home. Frisco then expanded its lead when Cam Cauley demolished a solo home run in the bottom of the fourth, extending the lead to 3-0. Walcott then bashed a solo shot in the bottom of the sixth to grab a 4-0 advantage. Frisco starter Mitch Bratt (3-1) earned the victory, pitching five shutout innings while fanning four. Riders relievers Ryan Lobus, Avery Weems and Skylar Hales all spun scoreless innings. Midland starter Chen Zhong-Ao Zhuang (3-4) picked up the loss, allowing all four Frisco runs.

SAVE TONIGHT:

On Friday night, Travis MacGregor became the 10th different Riders pitcher to record a save in 2025. Frisco is the only team in Minor League Baseball to accomplish the feat this season. Current Triple-A Round Rock pitcher Robby Ahlstrom leads the Riders with four saves while Gavin Collyer has three saves and Skylar Hales has recorded two saves. Frisco leads the Texas League and is tied for second in MiLB with 16 saves.

PITCHING, PITCHING AND MORE PITCHING:
Over this four-game winning streak, the RoughRiders pitching staff has been incredible. Frisco's 1.50 ERA is the best in the Texas League over the last four games and tied for third in Minor League Baseball. The Riders have recorded a save in each of the last four games, the most in the minors.

OFF THE WALL-COTT:
Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has been displaying the power as of late. In his last nine games, he has blasted four home runs while slashing .275/.326/.650/.976 with three doubles, eight RBIs and eight runs scored. His six home runs for a 19-year-old in Double-A are tied for the sixth-most since 2005 through 43 team games, trailing Oscar Taveras (10), Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (8), Fernando Tatis Jr. (8), Delmon Young (8) and Samuel Basallo (8).

RISP-ECT THIS:
The RoughRiders overall are hitting .234 with runners in scoring position, but have struggled over their last 26 games. In that stretch, the Riders are 14-12, batting .185 (40-for-216)/.262/.282/.544 with RISP. Their .185 batting average is ninth in the Texas League and 27th among 30 Double-A teams.

ABIM-ELECTRIC ORTIZ:
Abimelec Ortiz has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. In his last 14 games, Ortiz is hitting .333 (18-for-54)/.429/.574/1.003 with four doubles, three home runs and 14 RBIs. Last Wednesday, he clubbed the first walk-off grand slam in franchise history while driving in six runs. His six RBIs were the most in a game since 2022 (Josh Stowers). On Friday, he hammered a game-tying home run in the bottom of the ninth before the Riders eventually won 6-5 in 11 innings on a Josh Hatcher RBI single. He is 13th in the Texas League in May average (.290), second in RBIs (17), tied for seventh in home runs (four) and ninth in OPS (.902). For his efforts and three home runs, Ortiz was named Texas League Player of the Week.

MAY FLOWERS AND HOMERS:
The RoughRiders have both hit and given up their fair share of long balls this month. They have hit 17 this month, which is seventh in the league and have allowed 24, which is the most. Frisco's 4.16 ERA is fourth in the league during the month while they are 12-8

### **DOUBLE-A DOUBL-A RON:**

Aron Zavala has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. After a dreadful start, batting just .077 (2-for-26) through 10 games, he is hitting .306 (26-for-85)/.439/.482/.921 over his last 25 games. He leads the Texas League in walks (34) and is second in OBP (.428) while leading the league in walk rate (23.4 percent), a mark which also ranks 3rd in Minor League Baseball (min. 140 PA). His 14-game on-base streak ended Thursday, batting .367 (18-for-49)/.516/.551/1.067 with 15 runs scored, a double, a triple, two home runs, 11 RBIs and 15 walks. During the streak, he reached multiple times in 11 of the 14 games. In May, he is hitting .323/.450/.462/.912, ranking fifth in average, second in OBP and eighth in OPS in the Texas League.

HOUND HUNTING:
The Riders struggled against the Midland RockHounds a season ago. On top of being knocked out the postseason by Midland last year, they went just 6-12 during the regular season against the A's affiliate. Frisco was held to a .219/.291/.305/.596 slashline against the RockHounds. Since 2015, the Riders have had just one winning season against Midland, going 99-126 (.434) against the A's affiliate.

BRATT SUMMER IS BACK:
Mitch Bratt has been one of the stronger arms for Frisco to start the year. Through his first eight starts, his 1.94 ERA is first in the Texas League. He has the best start to a season through eight starts in recorded franchise histroy by ERA. His 3.6 percent walk rate, 8.5 K/BB and 91.9 percent left on base rate are the best in the Texas League. His 51 strikeouts are the second most in the Texas Rangers organization and his 41.2 innings are the most thrown among Rangers farmhands.

### **ABOUT TREY**

-Pronounced SHOE-pock. Full name is Treyson Thomas Supak. Was named Treyson because he was the third child and "trey" stood for "three".

-Born in Bryan, Texas, but grew up in La Grange, Texas (La Grange didn't have a hospital). At La Grange High School, he starred in football, basketball and baseball and became the first player drafted from LGHS since **Homer Bailey** in 2004.

-Committed to University of Houston before signing with Pittsburgh. His uncle Jody was an All-American at Houston and was drafted by Detroit in 1987.

-Was drafted by the Pirates in the CB-B round of 2014.

### **2025 SEASON**

-Allowed just three run through first three 5.0-inning starts.

-Made spot start with Triple-A Round Rock on May 3rd, allowing just two runs over five innings while striking out four and walking one.

### **2024 SEASON**

-Spent time between Double-A Tennessee and Triple-A Iowa.

### **2023 SEASON**

-Split time between Double-A Midland and Triple-A Las Vegas. Against Frisco in 2023, he made three appearances out of the bullpen (3.1 IP, 5 H, 4 R, 2 ER, 3 BB, 3 K), allowing a home run to Dustin Harris.

### 2021-2022 SEASON

-After electing free agency in Nov. of 2020, signed with the A's organization 18 days later.

-Missed the entire season and most of 2022 with "Tommy John" Surgery. Returned to make three starts with Midland that season.

### **2020 SEASON**

-Was called up from the Taxi Squad to the MLB roster in 2020 for three days and was sent back down without making an appearance.
