DESPITE 11 HITS, FRISCO DROPS OPENER IN AMARILLO:

The Frisco RoughRiders could not overcome an early 7-0 deficit in a 7-4 loss to the Amarillo Sod Poodles from HODGETOWN on Tuesday night. **Trey Hair** homered and doubled and **Kellen Strahm** reached three times to pace the Frisco offense. Amarillo (25-27) jumped out in front of the RoughRiders (27-25) in the second inning when Andy Yerzy hammered a grand slam against Frisco starter Jack Leiter (2-5). Leiter ceded seven runs, all earned, in the defeat while striking out five and walking four. Entering the game, Leiter had allowed one home run all season, but he gave up his second of the game to Drew Stankiewicz, a two-run shot, in the bottom of the fourth, springboarding the lead to 6-0. The Sod Poodles tacked on with a sacrifice fly from Nick Dalesandro in the bottom of the fifth to make it 7-0. All seven runs were driven in by the bottom three men in the Amarillo order. Frisco started their comeback attempt in the top of the seventh when Jonathan Ornelas drove Strahm home on an RBI fielder's choice to cut the deficit to 7-1. Hair then rammed a solo shot, his seventh of the year, in the eighth and **Jax Biggers** later added an RBI single in the frame, shortening the score to 7-3. **Sandro Fabian** doubled in a run in the ninth, but **Josh Stowers** struck out to end the game with two runners aboard. Out of the Riders bullpen, **Tim Brennan** was brilliant, throwing three shutout innings, allowing just one baserunner on a double, while striking out three.

SENDIN' IN BRENNAN:

Riders reliever **Tim Brennan** has been lights out since coming to the RoughRiders from Extended Spring Training. After joining the team in mid May, Brennan is 1-0 with a 0.79 ERA over 11.1 innings. In his five outings, Brennan has allowed just one run on six hits with 12 strikeouts. Opponents are hitting just .158 against him while a ridiculously high 70.4 percent of balls put in play against him have been on the ground, leading to a .222 BABIP.

IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

Riders outfielder **Kellen Strahm** started off slowly, but he has started to turn his offensive game around. Over his last nine games, Strahm is hitting .500 (12-for-24)/.613/.583 with two doubles, seven walks, five runs, two RBIs and just one strikeout. In that stretch, Strahm has raised his average from .148 to .229 and his OPS from .528 to .679. In his last 15 games, he is batting .348/.464/.391/.855. Among those with at least 130 PA in the Texas League, Strahm is fourth in walk rate (18.1 percent).

THREE IS A MAGIC NUMBER:

Frisco has played a lot of close games this season and when scoring or allowing three runs, the Riders have seen a pretty predictable result. This season, the Riders are 2-16 when scoring three runs or fewer and 14-2 when allowing three runs or fewer.

Over the Riders last seven games, Frisco is just hitting .214 (15-for-70) with runners in scoring position and have stranded 68 on the basepaths (9.7 per game). During this stretch, the Riders are eighth in the 10-team Texas League with a .238 batting average and a .701 OPS. Frisco is 2-5 over those games. On the bright side, the Riders are playing a series in Amarillo, which has been one of the most offensive-friendly ballparks in Minor League Baseball this season. During this three-game skid, Frisco has outhit their opponents in every game, but has lost all three.

NO ONE MAN SHOULD HAVE ALL THAT POWER:

The RoughRiders have relied heavily on the home run ball this season. Through 52 games, Frisco has hit 69 long balls (1.3 per game) which is third in the Texas League. At this rate, the RoughRiders would finish the season with 183 home runs, a mark which would be which is third in the leads teague. At this rate, the RoughRidders would his his the season with 133 home runs, a mark which would be the most in franchise history (beating 2007 when Frisco hit 176 home runs). In May, the RoughRiders hit 44 home runs in 26 games, the second-best total in Minor League Baseball (and averaging 1.7 per game). Out of their 52 total games, the Riders have hit home runs in 36 games, which means that when they hit them run, they are averaging 1.9 home runs per game when they hit them. In the 16 games that the Riders have not hit a home run, Frisco is just 7-9. **Blaine Crim** leads the Riders with 10 long balls - and is ninth in the league - while **Dustin Harris** is tied for 10th with his nine homers. So far in June, Frisco has hit just five home runs in six game, ninth in the 10-team Texas League.

CRIM CRUSH:

Blaine Crim has heated up as the season has shifted into early June. Over his last 31 games, Crim is hitting .308 (36-for-117)/.387/.607 with eight doubles, nine home runs and 26 RBIs. Crim had a season-best 17-game on-base streak snapped on Sunday, hitting .323/.429/.554 with six doubles, three home runs, 11 RBIs and 14 runs. Crim led the Rangers organization in 2021 with 29 home runs and he is atop the org again this season with 10 so far in 2022. His eight homers in May were tied for the most in the Texas League. Overall, Crim was sixth in the league with a 1.096 May OPS.

JONNY ON THE SPOT:

Riders infielder Jonny Ornelas has been tearing the cover off of the baseball in recent days. Ornelas has batted .329 (28-for-\$5)/374/471/845 in his last 19 games. He has eight games with at least three hits this season to lead the club and also leads the team with 21 multi-hit games. Ornelas owns a .388 average on the season, which is fourth in the Texas League, the best in the Texas Rangers organization and 14th in MiLB. Ornelas owns 66 hits, the most in the Texas League and third in MiLB.

- -Originally commited to Florida State University before being drafted, Ragans was ranked as the 12thbest high school pitcher in the draft and the 6th-best left hander by Baseball America.
- -At North Florida Christian High School, was 9-2 as a senior with a 0.90 ERA. He struck out 104 batters over 90.0 innings while holding opponents to a .122 batting average.
- -Ragans studied and modeled his game after Cole Hamels. After being drafted by the Rangers, -ragans studied and modeled his game after Cole names. After being draited by the kangers, Hamels, who was a member of the Rangers at the time, took Ragans under his wing. He shadowed him for an entire day, following him around during 2017 Spring Training and learned everything he could from him. Most of all, he learned about what it took on the mental side to be a starting pitcher. When he was first promoted to Frisco in July of 2021, Hamels happened to be throwing a bullpen for scouts at Riders Field and Ragans had the opportunity to reconnect with the veteran lefty.
- -Ragans was selected to play in the 2021 All-Star Futures Game in Denver, along with teammate RHP Cole Winn. After receiving that news, he was informed a few days later that he would join the RoughRiders and be promoted to Double-A right after the game. He called it, "an unbelievable moment given what he had been through." He enjoyed the emotional moment with his wife over the phone.

2022 SEASON

-Struck out seven over 3.1 innings in 2022 debut on April 10th.

Curveball

- -Became first Riders starter to record an out in the sixth inning on May 1st, going 5.1 IP against Midland in his first victory of the year.
- -Threw first quality start of the season on May 8th against Arkansas, striking out a season-best nine over his six shutout innings. It was his first six-inning shutout performance since 2017 and his 96 pitches were the most in the Rangers minors to that point in the season.

2021 SEASON

-Started the season with High-A Hickory, going 1-1 with a 2.50 ERA over his last four starts (18.0 IP, 14 H, 5 R, 5 ER, 6 BB, 21 K) before being promoted to Double-A Frisco

-Made Double-A debut in relief on July 18th against Springfield, allowing three runs over two innings of work.

2020 SEASON

-Made return from injury in Fall Developmental League, throwing 13.0 innings, striking out 20 while walking eight. Owned a 38 percent strikeout rate.

2019 SEASON

-Missed season due to second 'Tommy John' surgery.

-Missed season due to first 'Tommy John' surgery
