Off the Field: Tonight is the 75th birthday of the Peanuts comic strip with a special Woodstock bobblehead and LAFCU postgame fireworks!

Last Night: Lugnuts 9, Dragons 7. The Nuts knocked out Dayton starter Nestor Lorant nine batters into the first inning, scoring six runs (including a two-run homer from Jared Dickey) and going on to hold off the Dragons for their first win of the series.

On Deck: Tomorrow is Marvel Super Heroes Day with a pregame Comic Book Giveaway and postgame LAFCU Fireworks!

Lug•Notes

Welcome to the Show: Six Lugnuts have made a name for themselves in MLB this season, from first-time manager Clayton McCullough (2008-2009) with the Miami Marlins to debuting players Max Muncy (March 27), Gunnar Hoglund (May 2), Denzel Clarke (May 23), Jack Winkler (May 31), and, this past Sunday, Jack Perkins for the A's. Overall, 198 Lugnuts players have reached the Majors. In addition, Nuts broadcaster Adam Jaksa made his MLB debut calling the second and third innings of the A's/Tigers series finale yesterday at Comerica Park.

Offensive Minded: The first three games of this series have seen a combined 50 runs and 70 hits, an average of 17 runs and 23 hits per game between the two teams. Even so, none of the games has reached the three-hour mark and yesterday's 9-7 Lugnuts win was completed in two hours and 37 minutes.

All-Star Voting Update: The voting has advanced to phase 2, with three former Lugnuts (Toronto first baseman Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., A's shortstop Jacob Wilson and Toronto catcher Alejandro Kirk) each making the final two at his position. A run-off vote will determine the starter between Guerrero and the Yankees' Paul Goldschmidt, Wilson and the Royals' Bobby Witt, Jr., and Kirk and the Mariners' Cal Raleigh.

Willy's a Wonder: The credentials are clear for Jacob Wilson, who played 23 games for the Lugnuts in 2023. Wilson ranks 2nd in the Majors to Aaron Judge in both batting average (.345) and base hits (105). The A's open a three-game series tonight at Judge's Yankees.

Dazzling First Impression: 19-year-old lefty **Wei-En Lin** made his Lugnuts debut yesterday with 2 2/3 hitless innings, striking out three batters before departing two outs into the ninth. Lin, the A's No. 30 prospect, became the 969th player all-time to take part in a game for the Lugnuts and the 39th different player used this season.

Prospecting: In total, the Lugnuts have eight of MLB Pipeline's Top 30 A's prospects: No. 6 Tommy White, No. 9 Joshua Kuroda-Grauer, No. 11 Steven Echavarria, No. 15 Ryan Lasko, No. 16 Rodney Green, Jr., No. 26 Nate Nankil, No. 29 Tzu-Chen Sha and No. 30 Wei-En Lin.

Among the Best in the Minors: Lansing first baseman T.J. Schofield-Sam ranks 2nd in all of Minor League Baseball with 22 HBPs; closer Mark Adamiak is tied for 1st in MiLB in saves (12); 2025 Opening Day starter Gage Jump is tied for 1st with 2021 Lugnut Jack Cushing in wins (8); and 2023 Lugnut Colby Thomas (currently with Triple-A Las Vegas) is 1st in MiLB in total bases (165) and runs batted in (70). Thomas led MiLB in extra-base hits last year with 80.

A Little More on T.J.: Schofield-Sam leads all of High-A in batting average (.340) and tops the Midwest League in base hits (84). He also ranks 3rd in OBP (.419), 2nd in OPS (.917), 2nd in total bases (123), 3rd in slugging (.498) and 5th in runs scored (46).

Big Nate: Nate Nankil (.314 batting average, 2nd in the Midwest League), who went 2-for-4 with a double yesterday, is hitting .370 (30-for-81) in June and .467 (21-for-45) in his last 11 games, with one four-hit game, two three-hit games and three two-hit games.

The Men in the Pen: The Nuts have four of the most heavily used relievers in the MWL. Blaze Pontes leads the league with 25 appearances, Mark Adamiak is tied for 2nd with 24, and Yehizon Sanchez and Hunter Breault are tied for 5th with 23 appearances.

At the Plate: The Lugnuts rank 1st in the Midwest League in fewest strikeouts (496), 2nd in batting average (.261), 2nd in base hits (629), tied for 1st in doubles (138), 4th in on-base percentage (.354), 3rd in total bases (924) and 4th in OPS (.737).

JUNE 27TH IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2010: Lugnuts starter Ryan Shopshire brought a 4-0 lead over Dayton to the 9th at Cooley Law School Stadium, looking for a CG shutout. After two hit-by-pitches and a single loaded the bases with one out, Shopshire struck out Josh Gartón... and then gave up a two-out game-tying grand slam to Cameron Satterwhite! Shopshire was taken out, having pitched 8 2/3 innings to a no-decision. In the bottom of the 11th, though, Mike Konstanty walked Chris Hopkins with the bases loaded to force in the winning run, giving the Lugnuts a 5-4 victory.

2015: Tim Locastro hit his second inside-the-park home run of the season, a solo shot down the third-base line in the third inning (aided by LF Ross Kivett slipping), and Shane Dawson struck out nine West Michigan Whitecaps in 7 2/3 innings in a 5-1 win on Saturday night at Cooley Law School Stadium. Locastro was also hit by a pitch for the 20th time, tying the franchise single-season record. He broke the record the next day (though it has since been surpassed by Nick "Ball Magnet" Sinay's 39 HBPs in 2017).



Starting Out: Corey Avant's first start of the season came due to unusual circumstances; April 25 vs. Fort Wayne, the start time was pushed back an hour due to worry of inclement weather; Avant pitched two innings, allowing one run, before yielding to the scheduled starter, Gage Jump, who struck out 13 batters in 6 2/3 dominant scoreless innings in a 3-1 Lugnuts win.

Last Start: Avant set career highs for most innings (7.0) and most strikeouts (8) in a terrific start at Quad Cities on June 21, allowing four hits, three walks and one run... 97 pitches, 58 strikes... departed with the game tied 1-1... the Nuts scored two runs in the top of the 10th, but Blaze Pontes allowed three runs in the bottom of the 10th to fall, 4-3.

High School: Avant attended Sun Valley H.S., the Spartans, whose fight song is the Michigan State University fight song, Victory for MSU... the school's colors are maroon and gold, a la Central Michigan University... Sun Valley also produced NFL QB Sam Howell... Avant graduated Class of 2020.

College: Onward to Wingate University (named for Washington Manly Wingate, the fourth president at Wake Forest), the Bulldogs, colors: navy and gold... Avant majored in Math Business... redshirted the 2021 season, in which Wingate went 39-13, earned the No. 1 seed, and won the Division II National Championship in Cary, North Carolina, at the USA Baseball National Training Complex... in 2022, the Bulldogs set a program record for wins, going 48-10 with a 29-3 home record (first in the nation in both wins and winning percentage), but lost in the Southeast Regionals; redshirt freshman Avant went 3-1 with a 3.41 ERA in 26 relief appearances / 29 IP: 1 HR, 15 BB, 51 K... followed up in 2023 as a redshirt sophomore, striking out 57 batters in 39 innings (5.31, 23 G, 2 GS, 27 BB), as the Bulldogs finished 32-18, 18-6 in conference, but were eliminated in the SAC Tourney... excelled off the field with a 4.00 GPA, named two-time Academic All-America and served as Commencement Marshal at 2023 graduation
