Jared Jones: Right-hander Jared Jones will make his third rehab appearance of the season with Indianapolis and his second away start, today vs. the Columbus Clippers at Huntington Park at 6:15 PM ET.

**Last Outing:** Jones took the no-decision on July 14 vs. St. Paul. He surrendered five runs (four earned) and one walk with three punchouts.

**Against the Clippers:** Jones made two starts vs. Columbus in 2023, and fanned a combined nine hitters across 10.2 innings while picking up one loss.

**2023:** Selected as an MiLB.com Organization All-Star after splitting the season between Double-A Altoona and Triple-A Indianapolis, where he went 5-9 with a 3.85 ERA (54er/126.1ip) and 146 strikeouts in 26 games (25 starts).

**Miscellaneous:** Selected by PIT in the second round (44th overall) in the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of La Mirada (Whittier, Calif.) High School ... Was rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 21 draft prospect (No. 55 by MLB Pipeline) in 2020 ... Was a three-time member of USA Baseball's junior national teams ...
