YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Curve, 11-2. Carter Williams opened the scoring with an RBI double in the second. Later in the inning, Marco Luciano extended the lead to 5-0 with a grand slam. Altoona closed the score to 5-2 with a homer by Liover Peguero and an RBI HBP by Jacob Gonzalez in the eighth. In the eighth, Simon Whiteman and Wade Meckler hit RBI doubles and Luciano clubbed a two-run homer to push the lead to 11-2. Ryan Murphy worked his first scoreless start of the year, holding the Curve to four hits over four innings. Evan Gates worked around a pair of hits for a scoreless ninth.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh. Today is the 12th of 18 head-to-head games this year. The Flying Squirrels went 3-3 against the Curve at The Diamond from May 2-7. Along with this week's series, the Flying Squirrels will head to Altoona for six games from August 1-6. The Flying Squirrels are looking for their first series win since taking four-of-five in Bowie from April 25-29.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won three-of-four since Wednesday. The Flying Squirrels were 14-7 through their first 21 games but have lost 23-of-their-last-34. Their 11-23 record since May 3 is the worst in the Eastern League. Richmond starters have thrown 193.2 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 281.1 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.20 ERA, which is the second-lowest in Double-A and the fifth-lowest of the 120 teams in the minors.

THE CURVE are in first place in the Southwest Division, one game ahead of Erie. The Altoona offense has struck out 438 times this year, the fewest in the Eastern League, but have struck out 45 times the last four games. Altoona's roster includes five of Baseball America's top-30 Pirates prospects, including INF Liover Peguero (No. 7), RHP Jared Jones (No. 11), RHP Kyle Nicolas (No. 14) OF Matt Gorski (No. 16) and INF Andres Alvarez (No. 30). Nicholas Dombkowski is rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Pirates organization and Sanchez is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline. MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects list includes Peguero (No. 6), Jones (No. 11), Gorski (No. 16), RHP Kyle Nicolas (No. 19) and OF Matt Fraizer (No. 22).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Landen Roupp makes his seventh start of the season and the second of the series against the Curve. He started the series-opener on Tuesday night and threw four scoreless innings, his longest outing of the year to date. In his first full professional season in 2022, Roupp climbed three levels in the Giants system. He began the year working primarily as a reliever with Low-A San Jose, going 5-2 with a 2.59 ERA in 14 outings. Roupp moved to High-A Eugene in late-June for seven starts, going 3-0 with a 1.67 ERA. He was promoted to Richmond on August 18 for the remainder of the season and went 2-1 with a 3.76 ERA in five starts. Roupp made one start against the SeaWolves last year, allowing two runs over five innings in his final outing of the year on September 15 at The Diamond. Roupp was selected by the Giants in the 12th round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of UNC Wilmington, where he was the 2021 CAA Pitcher of the Year. For more on Roupp, see page two.

FOR ALTOUNA: Right-hander Kyle Nicolas makes his 12th start of the season and his fourth against the Flying Squirrels. He started on Tuesday at The Diamond and allowed three runs over three innings, his first runs allowed since May 19 after back-to-back scoreless starts. Nicolas faced the Flying Squirrels on May 2 at The Diamond and tied a season high with five earned runs allowed over five innings in a loss. He pitched in Richmond again on May 7 and surrendered three runs over three innings in a loss. Nicolas made his Pirates organization debut in Richmond on April 12, 2022 and worked 3.2 scoreless innings. In his eight career starts against the Flying Squirrels, Nicolas is 0-2 with a 5.79 ERA (18 ER/28.0 IP). Nicolas was selected by the Marlins with the 61st pick in the 2020 MLB Draft out of Ball State University. He was traded along with outfielder Connor Scott to the Pirates on November 29, 2021 for catcher Jacob Stallings. Nicolas is rated by Baseball America as the No. 14 Pirates prospect and is currently tied for ninth in the Eastern League with 59 strikeouts.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all of Double-A in total attendance (406,560) and average attendance (6,160) for the first time in franchise history. This year, they are again leading the level in average attendance (6,712) and total attendance (208,060). The Flying Squirrels are ranked 11th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance.

LLDVE LUCI: On Saturday night, **Marco Luciano** hit a grand slam and a two-run homer in the Flying Squirrels' 11-2 win. It was the fourth multi-homer game of his career. He went deep twice in the ACL on July 2, 2019. He also had a pair of two-homer games with Low-A San Jose on May 19 and June 29, 2021. His six RBIs was a new career high. The second-inning grand slam was the third of his professional career, with the others coming with High-A Eugene on August 19 and August 30, 2022. Since he began his season with his Double-A debut on May 3, his seven home runs are tied for the eighth-most in the Eastern League.

WELCOME BACK, WADE: Wade Meckler was reinstated from the injured list on Saturday after missing 12 games. In his first game back, he reached base three times with two walks and a two-run double. For the year, Meckler leads all minor league hitters (min. 100 PA) in batting average (.425) and ranks seventh in OBP (.479). He has picked up nine hits and five walks in his seven Double-A games since being promoted from High-A Eugene on May 17.

MARTY PARTY: After missing 39 games with a hand injury, Brandon Martorano was reinstated from the injured list on Thursday and played his first game for the Flying Squirrels since April 20. In his third at-bat leading off the bottom of the seventh, he broke the shutout and the no-hit bid with a solo home run. He added a hit on Friday night and played center field for the first time in his career. Martorano is playing his third season with Richmond. He first joined the team mid-way through the 2021 season and spent all of 2022 in the Eastern League. In his 141 Double-A games, Martorano has homered 17 times and has 69 RBIs.

MAHAN MASHING: Riley Mahan has hit two home runs in his last three games. He hit a solo homer on Wednesday and added a two-run homer on Friday. For the season, Mahan leads the Flying Squirrels with eight homers and 28 RBIs. He's also tied for the team lead with 17 extra-base hits and ranks second with 65 total bases. Last season, he set a career high with 12 home runs while playing at three levels in his first year with the Giants organization, including three with the Flying Squirrels.

BLDW SHDW: Infielder **Jimmy Glowenke** was assigned to Double-A Richmond last week and made his Double-A debut last Wednesday against Erie. He was selected in the second round (68th overall) by the Giants in the 2020 MLB Draft out of Dallas Baptist. Glowenke started the season with High-A Eugene. Among Northwest League hitters (min. 100 PA) this year, Glowenke ranked sixth in OPS (.956), sixth in batting average (.313), sixth in wRC+ (146), seventh in OBP (.413), tied for seventh in doubles (10) and eighth in SLG (.542) at the time of his promotion. He also had the fourth-lowest strikeouts percentage (14.3) in the league. After going 0-for-4 in his Double-A debut last Wednesday, he had hit safely in five straight games before going 0-for-3 on Thursday, but he picked up three hits over his last two games since.

WHERE THERE'S A WILLIAMS THERE'S A WAY: Carter Williams has hit safely in each of his last 10 games since May 27. During that stretch, he is batting .368 (14-for-38) with two homers, three doubles, three RBIs and 10 runs scored. His 10-game hit streak is the longest active streak in the Eastern League. It is also the longest by a Richmond player this year, ahead of a nine-game streak by Carter Aldrete from May 19-28. Last year in his first full professional season, Williams hit .336 over 80 games between Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene, which ranked second among Giants minor league hitters (min. 300 PA).

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Tyler Fitzgerald is tied for second in triples (3). Hayden Cantrelle is tied for ninth in walks (34). Evan Gates is tied for ninth in saves (4). Kai-Wei Teng is tied for fourth in strikeouts (63).

WHERE THE CURVE RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Mason Martin is ranked tied for eighth in homers (10) and tied for seventh in walks (37). Liover Peguero is ninth in hits (56), fourth in doubles (14), eighth in extra-base hits (21) and tied for eighth in runs scored (36). Connor Scott is first in triples (4). Oliver Garcia is tied for second in wins (5) and tied for sixth in games pitched (19). Kyle Nicolas is tied for ninth in strikeouts (59). Cameron Junker and Juan Minaya are tied for first in games pitched (20).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have nine players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 1), Vaun Brown (No. 6), Carson Whisenhunt (No. 8), Mason Black (No. 9), Carson Seymour (No. 12), Landen Roupp (No. 13), Ryan Murphy (No. 20), Wade Meckler (No. 23) and Randy Rodriguez (No. 30). Luciano is also rated as the No. 63 prospect on Baseball America's Top 100. In Baseball America's "Best Tools" list, Luciano is rated as the best power hitter, Brown is rated as the best thitter for average and best athlete, Meckler is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline, Roupp is rated as having the best curveball and José Cruz is rated as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list includes 10 Richmond players, including Luciano (No. 2, No. 18 overall), Brown (No. 5), Whisenhunt (No. 8), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 25), Murphy (No. 26), Cruz (No. 29) and Meckler (No. 30).
