LAST GAME

The Baysox dropped their second consecutive game to the Harrisburg Senators by a 3-2 final on Wednesday night. Right-hander Justin Armbruster put in another effective start for Bowie. Despite surrendering a solo home run to Blake Rutherford in the bottom of the first to give the Senators a 1-0 lead, Armbruster allowed no further damage, and struck out a season-high 7 batters through his five frames. Bowie would tie the game in the top of the second off a Jacob Teter RBI double, before Harrisburg struck for a pair in the top of the sixth off rehabbing right-hander Mychal Givens. JT Arruda walked to lead off the frame, before he stole second and Rutherford singled him home. Rutherford would eventually be plated on a sacrifice fly by Leonel Valera to make it 3-1 Senators. The Baysox got a run back in the seventh, when Billy Cook led off the frame with a double before scoring on a single from Erison Placencia in his Double-A debut, but the Baysox would get no closer, stranding the tying run in the eighth and ninth inning in the defeat.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Harrisburg Senators enter tonight at a record of 13-15. The Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, the Senators currently occupy 5th place in the Southwest division, but are just three games behind first place Richmond. Harrisburg has a .210 team average and has hit the fewest home runs (17) of any team in the Eastern League, but has also allowed the second-fewest (16) to go along with a 4.00 staff ERA. The Senators' roster is highlighted by the No. 2 Nationals prospect and No. 30 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, Robert Hassell III, who recently returned from the injured list. He is one of five Top 30 Nationals prospects on the Harrisburg roster, including right-handed pitchers Jackson Rutledge (No. 11 WSH) and Gerrardo Carrillo (No. 28 WSH), along with left-hander Mitchell Parker (No. 24 WSH) and catcher Drew Millas (No. 30 WSH). The Senators are led by first-year manager Delino DeShields, who has prior coaching and management experience through the various levels of the Reds' organization, in addition to be a former player for the Orioles' organization and playing for the Baysox in 1999.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Southpaw Alex Troop is projected to get the start for the Senators this morning. Troop has spent portions of each of the last three seasons in Harrisburg, with him most notably throwing 112.1 innings for the Senators last season with a 4.81 ERA, while allowing 21 home runs. So far in 2023, Troop has only allowed nine earned runs in 24.1 innings, with only two long balls and 22 strikeouts. Troop is coming off six innings out shutout ball on Saturday in New Hampshire, where he yielded just three hits and struck out a season-high seven. Troop pitched to an 8.59 ERA (14 ER in 14.2 IP) against Bowie last season in four appearances (three starts), but did manage three shutout innings in his lone appearance against the Baysox at FNB Field. A 9th round pick of the Nationals back in 2017 out of Michigan State, Troop features a fastball, curveball, and changeup.

MOUND REBOUND?

After getting off to a strong start, walks and home runs have haunted the Baysox pitching staff in recent games. Bowie arms have allowed the most home runs in the Eastern League this season at 35, with 15 of them allowed in the past eight games. The Baysox have yielded home runs in the opening two innings of four straight contests. In addition, Bowie has become susceptible to walks in recent contests as well. The Baysox have lost four of their last five games, and in those five games, they have allowed a combined 27 walks, after having the second-lowest walk total in Double-A (84) entering that stretch.

HESTON IS BESTON

OF/1B Heston Kjerstad has shown out as one of the top bats in the Eastern League so far this season. Kjerstad launched his seventh and eighth home runs of the season last week, as he currently sits second in the Eastern League in that category. Beyond the home runs, the Orioles' No. 5 prospect has also demonstrated plenty offensive consistency - sitting fourth in the Eastern League in slugging percentage (.619) and OPS (.997) among qualifiers, while also ranking second in extra-base hits (14) and total bases (60). Kjerstad has the second-most home runs and the most extra-base hits throughout the Orioles' system, while his OPS is third best and his slugging percentage is second. Kjerstad's standout start to the season earned him Orioles Minor League Player of the Month honors for April.

HAIL CESAR

INF Cesar Prieto continues to pace the Eastern League with his 41 hits and a .380 batting average - 42 points above the next-highest average. Prieto is currently riding a eight game hitting streak, while registering multiple hits in his past five starts and 13 multi-hit contests in his first 27 games of 2023. Prieto's 11-game hitting streak last month is the second-longest in the Eastern League this season and is also the longest streak for any Orioles minor leaguer. Prieto's leads the Baltimore farm in both average and hits as well.

TANDEM TROUBLES

Bowie's abundance of starting pitching experience is leading to a statistical split based on when each pitcher enters the game. Bowie has had eight different pitchers start multiple games this season, and those pitchers sport a 3.26 ERA with 130 strikeouts in 116 innings when they start their respective games. When those same pitchers enter games as relievers, they sport a collective 6.49 ERA, with only 38 strikeouts in 43 innings.

CAREER NOTES

- Went 2-2 with a 6.94 ERA in 6 appearances (5 starts) for the Baysox last season.
- Had a sensational start to his time in the Orioles' system, winning the organization's Pitcher of the Month honors after 4-0 with a 2.57 ERA with 34 strikeouts to just 7 walks across 28 innings, between Aberdeen and Bowie
- Struggled in September, as he allowed 10 ER in 7.1 IP in the month, including allowing 4 in 1.2 innings against Akron in the season's final game on 9/18, in what would be a loss to eliminate the Baysox from postseason contention.
- Had a 4.08 ERA in 20 appearances (19 starts) for the Twins' organization across two seasons.
- Spent parts of two seasons with the Nebraska Cornhuskers, only full season was 2021, where he finished 6-1 with a 3.11 ERA in 81 innings.

NOTES BY OUTING

- 4/8 Allowed two early baserunners in the first with none out, but stranded both. Got two quick ground outs in the second inning, but allowed the next four batters to reach, including three hits, needing 28 pitches in the inning. Faced the minimum in the third.
- 4/15 Struck out five of the first eight batters faced. Allowed two baserunners in the third, only inning to allow multiple runners.
- 4/21 Allowed three runs in the first inning on two walks and two hits, needing 32 pitches for the frame. Two more runs in the third inning on a single, triple, and passed ball.
- 4/29 Front end of a doubleheader, struck out seven batters in his first trip through the order. Only hit allowed was a two-out double in the third.
- 5/5 Struck out three batters over first two innings, but allowed two runs in the third including a solo home run. Struck out four more batters, but back-to-back two-out base hits in the fifth forced his exit.

Johnson had a brief stint in the major leagues with the Los Angeles Angels back in 2018 and spent parts of nine minor league seasons across the Angels, Reds and Minnesota Twins organizations. Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.	Forrest Herrmann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen IronBirds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Herrmann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts. Prior to joining the Orioles organization, Herrmann spent two seasons as a pitching coach within the Cincinnati Reds organization. Herrmann also served as a pitching strategist in 2019 for the Seattle Mariners organization at their facility in Peoria.
